The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 485-129-49 in his 23rd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 340-59-32 in the last 15-plus seasons. Coghlin's 475 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 105 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Aurora coach Ryan Buchanan (Benedictine, 2003) is 2-17-2 in his second season in Aurora.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series 3-1 overall and in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights swept Lake Forest last weekend, winning 3-1 Friday in De Pere before claiming an 8-2 win on Saturday in Lake Forest, Ill. The Green Knights are ranked No. 9 in the current USCHO.com Division III Poll.

Senior forward Erik Cooper moved into the St. Norbert scoring lead with two goals and three assists for five points. Senior forward Tyler Zepeda has two goals and two assists for four points. Senior forward Michael Hill and junior forwards Pijus Rulevicius and Noah Nelson all have two goals and one assist for three points apiece.

Junior goaltender Tony Kujava is 3-0 with a 1.21 goals against average and .925 save percentage. Freshman T.J. Black is 0-1 with a 6.00 goals against average and .750 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 2-for-12 (16.7 percent) on the power play and is 9-for-11 (81.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Spartans:

Aurora enters the series 1-2-1 overall and 1-0-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The

Spartans earned three points in a league series at Finlandia last weekend, winning the opener 4-1 and tying the second game 2-2. Aurora is in its first season as a full NCHA member after competing last year as an independent in its first year at varsity status.

Senior forwards Mike Mikulan and Tom Greene both have two goals and one assist for three points. Sophomore defenseman Tony Pnewski and sophomore forward Tim Santopalo both have one goal and two assists for three points.

Junior goaltender Jared Rutledge has a 1-2-1 record with a 4.78 goals against average and .882 save percentage. Sophomore Griffin Strain is 0-0 with a 9.40 goals against average and .800 save percentage.

Aurora is 2-for-21 (9.5 percent) on the power play and is 18-for-24 (75.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Schedule Snippets:

Only two of St. Norbert's first 11 games this season will be played at the friendly confines of Cornerstone Community Center. St. Norbert has an eight-game road trip scheduled from Nov. 7 through Dec. 4. That is the longest continuous time spent away from home for the Green Knights since Tim Coghlin's first 11 games as head coach in 1993-94. St. Norbert's last road trip of at least seven games came on Nov. 21, 2003 to Jan. 9, 2004.

St. Norbert is also playing six consecutive league games to start the season for the second straight year. It is the only two times since the Green Knights joined the NCHA in 1994-95 they have played six straight "counters" to open the season.

Just Four Fun:

St. Norbert bolted out to a rare 4-0 lead after the first period on the road in Saturday's 8-2 at Lake Forest.

It marked the first time since Feb. 9, 2001 St. Norbert held a four-goal

lead after 20 minutes, when it led 4-0 in a 9-3 win at St. Scholastica. Ryan Wempe, Patrick Gruber, Wempe and Maris Ziedins scored the four first-period markers to build the lead.

St. Norbert last scored four goals in the first period on the road on Nov. 10, 2006 when it led 4-1 after one period en route to a 7-1 win at St. Thomas. Marc Belanger, Jeffrey Hazelwood, Troy Boisjoli and Ryan Petersen's shorthanded goal were the four goals.

The Green Knights also scored four goals in the first period of a 6-3 win at UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 1, 2003. Jon Schultz, Jason Deitsch, Jeremy Mitchell and Kyle Peterson scored as St. Norbert led 4-1 after one.

St. Norbert build a 4-2 first period lead at UW-Stout on Nov. 22, 2002 on its way to a 10-4 win. Mike Costley, Lennie Rampone, Faron Duthie and Ziedins all scored for the Green Knights in the opening period.

The Green Knights last scored at least four goals in the first period of a game when they scored five in a 12-0 win over Finlandia on Nov. 8, 2014 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Eight is Enough:

St. Norbert's 8-2 win at Lake Forest this past Saturday marked the third consecutive season the Green Knights have scored at least eight goals in a road win. It was also just the ninth time in the last 13 seasons St. Norbert scored at least eight goals in a road game.

The Green Knights last scored eight goals on the road in a 9-0 win at Lawrence on Dec. 6, 2014. St. Norbert defeated UW-Eau Claire 8-2 on Nov. 27, 2013.

St. Norbert also claimed an 8-3 win at UW-River Falls on Nov. 21, 2009, an 8-1 triumph at Lawrence on Oct. 28, 2008, an 8-1 victory at Buffalo State on Oct. 27, 2006, 8-5 shootout at UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, an 11-2 blasting at Marian on Dec. 8, 2004 and a 9-0 blanking of

UW-Stevens Point at K.B. Willett Arena on Jan. 24, 2004.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 485-129-49 in his 23rd season into this weekend. Coghlin is currently 25th all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches.

Coghlin moved past Joe Marsh for 25th on the all-time list with a 4-1 win over Marian on Oct. 30. Marsh compiled a 482-417-76 mark in 27 seasons at St. Lawrence from 1986 to 2012.

Current Fitchburg State coach Dean Fuller is 24th with a career mark of 498-285-49 in 31 seasons. Current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin is 23rd on the list with a 500-357-76 mark in 28 seasons.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 249 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 287 of 293 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 249-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 71 weeks - trailing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 98-18-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 114-48-17 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 2-0 this season when leading after two periods, and was 17-0-1 last season when leading after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 260-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 278-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-26-6 in its last 37 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 23 times in their last 409 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 663-game tenure.
