8 against Superior since a 2002 loss in the NCAA Tournament quarterfinals at the Cornerstone Community Center. St. Norbert is 11-8-9 all-time at Wessman Arena.

Fierce rivals for the last two decades, St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stevens Point by a 45-20-6 margin in a series begun in the 1991-92 season. St. Norbert is 45-12-3 in the last 60 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 27-4-2 in the last 33 games in the series.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 487-129-49 in his 23rd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 342-59-32 in the last 15-plus seasons. Coghlin's 477 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 107 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

UW-Superior coach Dan Stauber (UW-Superior, 1988) is 252-135-56 in his 16th season in Superior.

UW-Stevens Point coach Chris Brooks (Western Michigan, 1996) is 80-35-8 in his fifth season in Stevens Point.

#### Last Meetings:

St. Norbert beat UW-Superior 4-1 on Feb. 2, 2013 at Cornerstone Community Center. Cody Keefer scored two goals while Brandon Hoogenboom and Kyle Stroh added markers for St. Norbert. David Jacobson made 27 saves for the Green Knights. Pat Dalbec scored for the Yellowjackets while Drew Strandberg made 15 saves.

UW-Stevens Point beat St. Norbert in a wild 6-5 affair on Jan. 3, 2015 at Cornerstone Community Center. The Pointers led 4-2 after two periods before St. Norbert tied the game 4-4, but Stevens Point scored the next two goals. Michael Hill scored twice for St. Norbert while Joe Kalisz had two goals for the Pointers, including the gamewinner. Brandon Jaeger made 34 saves for Stevens Point, which was outshot by St. Norbert 39-23.

#### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend 5-1 overall. The Green Knights swept Aurora in a Northern Collegiate Hockey Association series last weekend, winning by scores of 4-1 and 7-1. The Green Knights are ranked No. 9 in the current USCHO.com Division III Poll.

Senior forward Erik Cooper holds the St. Norbert scoring lead with three goals and four assists for seven points. Senior forward Michael Hill has four goals and two assists for six points. Junior forwards Pijus Rulevicius and Noah Nelson both have three goals and one assist for four points.

Junior goaltender Tony Kujava is 4-0 with a 1.16 goals against average and .929 save percentage. Freshman T.J. Black is 1-1 with a 3.00 goals against average and .891 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 3-for-22 (13.6 percent) on the power play and is 21for-23 (91.3 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

#### About the Yellowjackets:

UW-Superior enters the weekend with a 3-2-1 overall record. The Yellowjackets are 0-2-1 in their last three games, including a 4-3 loss at St. Olaf last Friday and a 5-4 overtime loss at Hamline last Saturday.

Sophomore forward Ian Ecklund leads the Yellowjackets in scoring with three goals and seven assists for 10 points. Freshman forward Daniel Litchke has one goal and seven assists for eight points. Junior forward Anton Svensson has five goals and two assists for seven points, while junior defenseman Eric Shand has three goals and two assists for five points.

Sophomore goaltender Bryce Fink is 1-1-1 with a 1.96 goals against average and .900 save percentage. Junior Cory Simons is 2-1 with a 2.95 goals against average and .909 save percentage.

Superior is 5-for-18 (27.8 percent)

on the power play and is 24-for-29 (82.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

#### About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters Friday's game with Marian at 6-0 overall. The Pointers, ranked No. 2 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, are coming off road wins of 5-0 at Concordia-Moorhead on Friday and 3-2 at St. John's on Saturday.

Senior forward Joe Kalisz leads the Pointers in scoring with six goals and five assists for 11 points. Senior forward Logan Lemirande has two goals and six assists for eight points. Junior forward Eliot Grauer has five goals and two assists for seven points, while junior forward Kyle Sharkey has six goals for six points.

Freshman goaltender Jesse Gordichuk is 3-0 with a 1.96 goals against average and .926 save percentage. Sophomore Max Milosek is 3-0 with a 1.33 goals against average and .938 save percentage.

Stevens Point is 10-for-30 (33.3 percent) on the power play and is 18-for-18 (100.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

#### WIAC Wisdom:

St. Norbert faces its only two Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foes of the regular season with its trip to UW-Superior and UW-Stevens Point this weekend.

Since the 2002-03 season, the first year the Green Knights advanced to the NCAA Division III Frozen Four, St. Norbert is 133-23-17 against the WIAC schools. In program history, St. Norbert is 208-76-29 all-time against the WIAC.

Since 2002-03, St. Norbert is 30-4-2 against UW-Stevens Point, 33-4-2 against UW-Eau Claire, 26-5-1 against UW-River Falls, 22-5-3 against UW-Stout and 21-5-8 against UW-Superior.

#### **Schedule Snippets:**

Only two of St. Norbert's first 11 games this season will be played at the friendly confines of Cornerstone Community Center. St. Norbert has an eight-game road trip scheduled from Nov. 7 through Dec. 4. That is the longest continuous time spent away from home for the Green Knights since Tim Coghlin's first 11 games as head coach in 1993-94. St. Norbert's last road trip of at least seven games came on Nov. 21, 2003 to Jan. 9, 2004.

St. Norbert is also playing six consecutive league games to start the season for the second straight year. It is the only two times since the Green Knights joined the NCHA in 1994-95 they have played six straight "counters" to open the season.

#### **Coghlin Count:**

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 487-129-49 in his 23rd season into this weekend. Coghlin is currently 25th alltime in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches.

Coghlin moved past Joe Marsh for 25th on the all-time list with a 4-1 win over Marian on Oct. 30. Marsh compiled a 482-417-76 mark in 27 seasons at St. Lawrence from 1986 to 2012.

Current Fitchburg State coach Dean Fuller is 24th with a career mark of 499-286-49 in 31 seasons. Current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin is 23rd on the list with a 500-357-76 mark in 28 seasons.

#### **Poll Position:**

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 250 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 288 of 294 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 250-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 71 weeks - trailing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 98-18-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 114-48-17 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com

#### **Tough After Two:**

St. Norbert is 3-0 this season when leading after two periods, and was 17-0-1 last season when leading after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 260-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 278-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

#### **Gimme Five:**

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-26-6 in its last 37 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 23 times in their last 411 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 665-game tenure.
