The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 489-129-49 in his 23rd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 344-59-32 in the last 15-plus seasons. Coghlin's 479 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 109 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Buffalo State coach Steve Murphy (St. Mary's, 2011) is 4-2-2 in his first season in Buffalo.

Last Season:

St. Norbert swept Buffalo State 7-0 and 8-0 in a two-game series on Nov. 28-29, 2014 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere.

Cullen Bradshaw and Mason Baptista both scored two goals in the opener. The Green Knights were 3-for-5 on the power play. Tony Kujava made 12 saves for St. Norbert and Ian Sylves made 31 stops for the Bengals.

The Green Knights broke open the second game with five secondperiod goals to lead 6-0 after 40 minutes. Erik Cooper scored two goals for St. Norbert, which was 4for-6 on the power play. David Jacobson had 17 saves for the Green Knights, while Sylves had 37 saves for Buffalo State.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters its series against Buffalo State at 7-1 overall. The Green Knights claimed wins in the first two non-conference games they played this season with a 4-0 win at UW-Superior on Friday and a 5-2 triumph at then-No. 2-ranked UW-Stevens Point on Saturday. The Green Knights are ranked No. 5 in the current USCHO.com Division III Poll.

Junior forward Noah Nelson has a team-high five goals with three assists for eight points. Senior forward Erik Cooper has four goals and four assists for eight points. Senior forward Michael Hill has four goals and two assists for six points, while junior forward Pijus Rulevicius has three goals and two assists for five points.

Junior goaltender Tony Kujava is 6-0 with a 1.11 goals against average and .938 save percentage. Freshman T.J. Black is 1-1 with a 3.00 goals against average and .891 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 6-for-33 (18.2 percent) on the power play and is 29for-32 (90.6 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Bengals:

Buffalo State enters the series 4-2-2 overall. The Bengals are currently riding a four-game winning streak. Buffalo State won a pair of SUNY-AC games this past weekend, topping Geneseo State 7-4 Friday on the road before returning home to beat Brockport State 6-4 on Saturday. The Bengals have scored 28 goals in their last four games.

Junior forward Taylor Pryce leads the Bengals in scoring with six goals and seven assists for 13 points. Sophomore forward Zach Nieminen has three goals and five assists for eight points, while senior forward Brett Hope has two goals and six assists for eight points. Junior forward Anthony Beaumont had four goals and three assists for seven points.

Junior goaltender Mike DeLaVergne has played all but one period in goal this season for the Bengals. DeLaVergne is 4-2-2 with a 2.70 goals against average and .911 save percentage.

Buffalo State is 5-for-42 (11.9 percent) on the power play and is 35for-43 (81.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Eastern Eavesdroppings:

St. Norbert is 28-17-4 all-time against East Region opponents. The Green Knights played at least one game a season against an eastern foe for 18 years before not facing one in 2012-13 as well as 2013-14 until beating Geneseo State 6-2 on March 21, 2014 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four. St. Norbert then resumed facing an East Region foe with home-and-home series with Buffalo State in 2014-15 and 2015-16.

St. Norbert is 18-8-3 all-time on East Region ice, which includes three neutral-site visits to the Frozen Four in 2008, 2010 and 2012 in Lake Placid, N.Y., and in 2014 to Lewiston, Maine.

The Green Knights are 13-3-1 alltime against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Plattsburgh State, 1-0 against Geneseo State and a 2-2 ledger against Oswego State. St. Norbert is 4-1-1 all-time against Fredonia State and 4-0 against Buffalo State.

St. Norbert is 6-5-3 all-time against ECAC West opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 3-5 all-time against the NESCAC.

The Green Knights are 2-0 alltime against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season.

St. Norbert is 4-3 against the ECAC East, going 3-3 against Norwich and 1-0 against Southern Maine.

Schedule Snippets:

Only two of St. Norbert's first 11 games this season will be played at the friendly confines of Cornerstone Community Center. St. Norbert has an eight-game road trip scheduled from Nov. 7 through Dec. 4. That is the longest continuous time spent away from home for the Green Knights since Tim Coghlin's first 11 games as head coach in 1993-94. St. Norbert's last road trip of at least seven games came on Nov. 21, 2003 to Jan. 9, 2004.

St. Norbert, currently 5-0 on its eight-game road trip, also played six consecutive league games to start the season for the second straight year. It is the only two times since the Green Knights joined the NCHA in 1994-95 they have played six straight "counters" to open the season.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 489-129-49 in his 23rd season into this weekend. Coghlin is currently 25th alltime in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches.

Coghlin moved past Joe Marsh for 25th on the all-time list with a 4-1 win over Marian on Oct. 30. Marsh compiled a 482-417-76 mark in 27 seasons at St. Lawrence from 1986 to 2012.

Current Fitchburg State coach Dean Fuller is 24th with a career mark of 499-288-49 in 31 seasons. Current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin is 23rd on the list with a 501-358-76 mark in 28 seasons.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 251 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 289 of 295 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 251-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 71 weeks - trailing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 98-18-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 115-48-17 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 6-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 5-0 this season when leading after two periods, and was 17-0-1 last season when leading after 40 minutes.

an astounding 260-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 278-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-26-6 in its last 37 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 23 times in their last 413 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 667-game tenure.

* - St. Norbert is currently third in Division III in scoring margin at plus-3.12 goals per game. Only Plattsburgh State and Babson are higher, with both standing at plus-3.50 goals per game.
