The Series:

St. Norbert leads St. Thomas 7-3-2 in a series that dates back to the 1999-2000 season. The Green Knights are 6-1 in the last seven games in the series, with the only loss coming in their last trip to Mendota Heights in a 3-2 loss on Jan. 9, 2009.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 492-129-50 in his 23rd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 347-59-33 in the last 15-plus seasons. Coghlin's 482 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 110 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

St. Thomas coach Jeff Boeser (St. Thomas, 1975) is 89-41-14 in his sixth season in St. Paul.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated St. Thomas 5-3 on Jan. 4, 2014 at the Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. The Green Knights pulled away from a 2-2 tie after the first period with two goals in the second period and one in the third period.

Joe Perry and Cullen Bradshaw scored two goals apiece for the Green Knights, while Michael Hill added the other marker. David Jacobson made 13 saves for the Green Knights, who outshot the Tommies 35-16.

Michael Krieg scored two goals for St. Thomas and Alex Niestrom added the other for the Tommies. Drew Fielding made 30 saves for St. Thomas, which was outshot 8-1 in the decisive second period.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game at St. Thomas at 10-1-1 overall. The Green Knights, who are 8-0-1 in their last nine games, swept Lawrence last

weekend in a Northern Collegiate Hockey Association series by scores of 4-2 and 9-1. The Green Knights are ranked No. 1 in both the USCHO.com Division III and D3hockey.com polls.

Senior forward Erik Cooper leads the Green Knights in scoring with four goals and eight assists for 12 points. Junior forwards Pijus Rulevicius and Noah Nelson and senior forward Michael Hill all have six goals and three assists for nine points. Freshman forward Roman Uchyn has seven goals and one assist for eight points, while freshman forward Brad Pung has four goals and four assists for eight points.

Junior goaltender Tony Kujava is 8-0 with a 1.08 goals against average and .943 save percentage. Freshman T.J. Black is 2-1-1 with a 2.13 goals against average and .901 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 11-for-62 (17.7 percent) on the power play and is 49-for-56 (87.5 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Tommies:

St. Thomas enters the game with a 7-3-2 overall record. The Tommies, who are 5-1 in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, are coming off a sweep of Hamline this past weekend by scores of 4-2 and 5-3.

Senior forward Connor McBride leads the Tommies with five goals and four assists for nine points. Junior forward Michael Dockry has four goals and five assists for nine points, while senior forward Jordan Lovick has four goals and four assists for eight points. Senior forward Willie Faust has three goals and three assists for six points.

Senior goaltender Joe Morris has played exclusively in net for the Tommies this season, posting a 7-3-2 record with a 2.06 goals against average and a .928 save percentage.

St. Thomas is 9-for-37 (24.3 percent) on the power play and is 38-for-44 (86.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

MIAC Minutiae:

St. Norbert has a solid 83-11-7 record against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference competition since Tim Coghlin took over the Green Knights' helm in 1993. Two of the losses came in a sweep at St. Mary's in Coghlin's first year of 1993-94.

Since then, the Green Knights are 83-9-7 against the MIAC. St. Norbert is 7-1-1 in its last nine games against the MIAC, with the only loss coming in a 2-1 setback at Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 2, 2012.

At home under Coghlin, St. Norbert is a remarkable 47-2-3 against MIAC foes. The losses came in a 3-2 defeat to St. Thomas in the 2005 NCAA Division III Tournament and to Gustavus Adolphus 4-2 on Nov. 3, 2007.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 492-129-50 in his 23rd season into this weekend. Coghlin is currently 25th all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches.

Coghlin moved past Joe Marsh for 25th on the all-time list with a 4-1 win over Marian on Oct. 30. Marsh compiled a 482-417-76 mark in 27 seasons at St. Lawrence from 1986 to 2012.

Current Fitchburg State coach Dean Fuller is 24th with a career mark of 500-288-50 in 31 seasons. Current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin is tied for 22nd on the list with a 501-360-76 mark in 28 seasons while Boston College coach John "Snooks" Kelley was 501-249-15 in 36 seasons.

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 19 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such mark in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Only five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least

11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek currently has a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins going from 2004 to the present. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

Kujava Comments:

St. Norbert junior goaltender Tony Kujava has enjoyed a strong start to the 2015-16 season, opening the campaign 8-0.

Kujava is sporting a 1.08 goals against average in nine games, which is currently third in Division III. He has allowed nine goals in just shy of 498 minutes.

A pair of Williams goaltenders hold the top two spots nationally in goals against average. Michael Pinios has a 0.67 goals against average in two games, while Noah Klag has a 1.00 goals against average in three games.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 253 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 291 of 297 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 253-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 72 weeks - trailing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 98-18-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 115-48-17 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the

No. 1-ranked team and are 6-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 8-0 this season when leading after two periods, and was 17-0-1 last season when leading after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 261-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 279-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-26-6 in its last 37 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 23 times in their last 417 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 671-game tenure.
