The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 493-129-50 in his 23rd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 348-59-33 in the last 15-plus seasons. Coghlin's 483 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 113 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Finlandia coach Dane Litke (North Dakota, 1997) is 6-30-4 in his second season in Hancock.

Last Season:

St. Norbert swept Finlandia by scores of 7-1 and 12-0 in a two-game NCHA series on Nov. 7-8, 2014 at Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights scored three goals in each of the last two periods in the opener. Chris Rial scored twice for St. Norbert, while David Jacobson made 15 saves.

St. Norbert led 11-0 after two periods in the second game. Michael Hill and Noah Nelson both had two goals and Tony Kujava made eight saves for the Green Knights.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series with Finlandia at 11-1-1 overall and 7-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights have been idle since a 4-1 win at St. Thomas on Dec. 12. St. Norbert is ranked No. 1 in both the USCHO.com Division III and D3hockey.com polls.

Senior forward Erik Cooper leads the Green Knights in scoring with four goals and nine assists for 13 points. Senior forward Michael Hill has seven goals and three assists for 10 points. Junior forwards Pijus Rulevicius and Noah Nelson both have six goals and four assists for 10 points. Freshman forward Roman Uchyn owns a team-high eight goals with one assist for nine points.

Junior goaltender Tony Kujava is 9-0 with a 1.08 goals against average and .945 save percentage. Freshman T.J. Black is 2-1-1 with a 2.13 goals against average and .901 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 12-for-67 (17.9 percent) on the power play and is 52-for-59 (88.1 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Lions:

Finlandia enters the series 1-11-3 overall and 1-7-2 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Lions have lost eight consecutive games since a 1-3-3 start. Finlandia was swept at home this past weekend by St. Scholastica by scores of 7-0 and 6-2.

A total of 32 different skaters have seen action for Finlandia so far this season. Sophomore forward Thomas Malkmus and freshman Francois Cote share the team lead in scoring, with both holding numbers of four goals and three assists for seven points. Freshman forward Alex Rezansoff has one goal and four assists for five points. Freshman forward Cam Wirick has two goals and two assists for four points.

Sophomore goaltender Walker Enstad is 1-5 with a 5.36 goals against average and .858 save percentage. Freshman Matt Young is 0-2-1 with a 4.94 goals against average and .846 save percentage.

Finlandia is 9-for-60 (15.0 percent) on the power play and is 44-for-63 (69.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Kujava Komments:

St. Norbert junior goaltender Tony Kujava has enjoyed a strong start to the 2015-16 season, opening the campaign 9-0.

Kujava is sporting a 1.08 goals against average in 10 games, which is currently second in Division III. He has allowed 10 goals in just shy of 558 minutes.

Williams freshman Michael

Pinios has a 1.00 goals against average in seven games to currently leads Division III in goals against average.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 493-129-50 in his 23rd season into this weekend. Coghlin is currently 25th all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches.

Coghlin moved past Joe Marsh for 25th on the all-time list with a 4-1 win over Marian on Oct. 30. Marsh compiled a 482-417-76 mark in 27 seasons at St. Lawrence from 1986 to 2012.

Current Fitchburg State coach Dean Fuller is tied for 23rd with a career mark of 501-290-50 in 31 seasons. Longtime Boston College coach John "Snooks" Kelley was 501-249-15 in 36 seasons (1933-42, 1947-72)

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 19 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such mark in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Only five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek currently has a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins going from 2004 to the present. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 256 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 294 of

300 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 256-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 75 weeks - trailing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 99-18-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 115-48-17 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 6-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 207-27-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 187-19-9 in its last 215 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 14-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 198-22-11 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 286-49-18 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Only two visiting teams have won at least two games at the Cornerstone Community Center in the same season. Superior won three times in 2001-02 and UW-Eau Claire won twice in 2012-13. Both of those teams went on to win the

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 9-0 this season when leading after two periods, and was 17-0-1 last season when leading after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 261-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 279-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-26-6 in its last 37 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 23 times in their last 418 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 672-game tenure.
