The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 521-134-52 in his 24th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 376-64-35 in the last 16-plus seasons. Coghlin's eight NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Concordia coach Jasen Wise (St. Thomas, 1996) is 45-69-8 in his fifth season in Mequon. Wise went 119-88-14 coaching at Marian for eight seasons for an overall record of 164-157-22 in 13 seasons.

Last Season:

St. Norbert swept Concordia-Wisconsin in a home-and-home series on Jan. 29-30, 2016.

The Green Knights won the opener 8-1 at Ozaukee Ice Center in Mequon. Roman Uchyn had two goals and Riley Christensen three points while T.J. Black made 14 saves for the Green Knights. Two goaltenders made 34 saves for the Falcons.

St. Norbert then won the second game 3-0 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. Christensen had one goal and one assist and Uchyn two assists for St. Norbert. Black made 13 saves while Jack Romanuik made 34 stops for Concordia.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series 14-2-1 overall and 10-1-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights are ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com polls. St. Norbert swept Adrian 3-1 and 4-2 this past weekend, the first time the Bulldogs had been swept at home in a weekend series by the same opponent in their 10-year history.

Junior forward Tanner Froese leads the Green Knights in scoring with 11 goals and six assists for 17 points. Senior forward Noah

Nelson has six goals and 10 assists for 16 points. Senior forward Jeremy Olinyk has six goals and nine assists for 15 points, while senior forward Pijus Rulevicius has four goals and 10 assists for 14 points.

Sophomore goaltender T.J. Black is 10-0-1 with a 0.99 goals against average and .953 save percentage. Black is first nationally in goals against average and is third in save percentage. Senior goaltender Tony Kujava is 4-2 with a 1.86 goals against average and .909 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 17-for-119 (14.3 percent) on the power play and is 84-for-89 (94.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Falcons:

Concordia enters the weekend 9-7-1 overall and 6-5-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Falcons have lost their last three games, including a 3-1 setback at UW-Stout last Friday.

Freshman forward Jim Pearson leads the Falcons with nine goals and four assists for 13 points. Sophomore forward Stefan Seel has two goals and 11 assists for 13 points, while freshman forward Dante Hahn has one goal and 12 assists for 13 points.

Sophomore goaltender Jack Romanuik is 8-4-1 with a 2.92 goals against average and .901 save percentage. Senior Chase Hollander is 1-1 with a 1.01 goals against average and .956 save percentage.

Concordia is 12-for-93 (12.9 percent) on the power play and is 80-for-97 (82.5 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

The Puck Stops Here:

St. Norbert sophomore goaltender T.J. Black turned in a virtuoso performance in this past Saturday's 4-2 win over Adrian.

Black made a whopping 45 saves in the win. Coupled with his 27 saves in Friday's 3-1 win, Black's aggregate total of 72 saves led to his NCHA Defensive Player of the

Week honors.

The 45-save effort was the second-highest total in a win in St. Norbert history and only the third 40-plus save performance in a winning effort.

Roby Gropp holds the St. Norbert record for most saves in a win with 46 in a 4-1 win over UW-River Falls on Feb. 7, 1997. Mike Szkodzinski made 40 saves in a 5-3 win over UW-Superior on Jan. 7, 1999.

January Joy:

Since Tim Coghlin took over the reins of the St. Norbert hockey program in the 1993-94 season, the Green Knights have enjoyed strong success in the first month of a new year.

The Green Knights are 141-31-17 all-time under Coghlin in the month of January, working out to a winning percentage of .791. St. Norbert is 4-0 this January.

St. Norbert went 5-1 last season in the month of January, the only loss coming in a NCHA series split at home with Adrian.

The Green Knights had an anomalous month of January in 2015, going 4-4-1 in the nine games played that month. It accounted for two-thirds of St. Norbert's loss total that season.

The Green Knights last had an unbeaten January en route to their fourth national championship in 2014. St. Norbert went 7-0-1 in January 2014.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert currently owns the No. 1 scoring defense in Division III at 1.35 goals allowed per game. The Green Knights have yielded 23 goals in 17 games.

St. Norbert also owns Division III's top penalty-killing unit at 94.4 percent. The Green Knights have killed 84 of their opponent's 89 power-play chances this season.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 521-134-52 in his 24th season. Coghlin is in

21st place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches in all divisions.

This past weekend Coghlin moved ahead current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin, who currently has a record of 519-380-83.

Retired Minnesota State-Mankato coach Don Brose is 20th all-time with a career record of 536-335-79 from 1970-2000. Retired Army coach Jack Riley and retired Bowdoin coach Terry Meagher are tied for 18th all-time with 542 wins apiece.

Coghlin earned his 500 career wins in just 680 games. That mark is the third-fastest to 500 wins in NCAA hockey history. Only UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli (658 games) and Bemidji State's Bob Peters (677 games) have reached 500 games more quickly. According to research by the St. Norbert sports information office, no other NCAA hockey coaches have ever reached 500 wins in less than 700 games.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 277 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 315 of 321 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 277-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 86 weeks - surpassing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 114-21-8 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 127-51-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin, including 2-0 this year. The Green Knights are 4-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 7-7-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

when leading after two periods, and is off to an 11-0-1 start in 2016-17 when setting the pace after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 272-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 290-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 19-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 285-1-7 over their last 293 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007, a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008 and a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 27 times in their last 451 games.
