St. Norbert College Green Knights Hockey Preview NCAA DIVISION III FROZEN FOUR

Historic Utica Memorial Auditorium hosts the Frozen Four as four teams converge on the Mohawk Valley to determine the 2017 NCAA Division III champion. St. Norbert is aiming for its fifth national title in 10 years, capturing the crown at Lake Placid in 2008 and 2012, in 2011 at Minneapolis and in 2014 at Lewiston, Maine. Norwich won the last of its three national titles in 2010, while Trinity won it all in 2015. Adrian is seeking its first national championship.

The Series:

St. Norbert meets Trinity in men's ice hockey for the first time.

St. Norbert and Norwich are tied 3-3 in an all-time series that has perhaps become the Green Knights' best rivalry against an East Region foe. The winners of the last five meetings have all gone on to claim the national championship. The Green Knights' first win in the series came in a 3-0 triumph in the 2008 NCAA national semifinals at Herb Brooks Arena in Lake Placid, N.Y. St. Norbert also picked up a national semifinal win over the Cadets in 2011 by a 3-2 score at Ridder Arena in Minneapolis, with all the goals coming in the third period. The Green Knights also beat the Cadets 4-1 in a 2012 national semifinal in Lake Placid.

St. Norbert leads Adrian 8-6 in an all-time series that began during the 2009-10 season. The Bulldogs have won six of the last 11 meetings in the series after the Green Knights won the first three games. St. Norbert has won all three meetings with Adrian this season, with all three games played in Adrian, Mich.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 529-137-52 in his 24th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 384-67-35 in the last 16-plus seasons. Coghlin's eight NCAA championship game

appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989

Trinity coach Matt Greason (Trinity, 2003) is 111-40-10 in his sixth season in Hartford. His 2015 team won the NCAA Division III championship.

Norwich coach Mike McShane (New Hampshire, 1971) is 476-123-36 in his 22nd season in Northfield. In 36 years of collegiate coaching he is 720-341-73 overall. He spent six years at St. Lawrence with two NCAA Division I tournament berths and was at Providence for nine years with three NCAA tournament bids. His 2000, 2003 and 2010 teams won NCAA Division III championships.

Adrian coach Adam Krug (Adrian, 2012) is 68-14-6 in his third season in Adrian.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 17th overall NCAA Division III Tournament appearance, all coming within in the last 21 years. The Green Knights are 28-12-1 all-time in NCAA competition, have reached 11 Frozen Fours, and have won 19 of their last 22 NCAA Tournament games. St. Norbert won national championships in 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 and was

St. Norbert vs. Ranked Teams in 2016-2017

St. Norbert is 8-0 against ranked teams this season - going 3-0 against Adrian, 2-0 against Marian and 1-0 against Augsburg, UW-Stevens Point and St. Thomas. St. Norbert is 129-51-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 4-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 7-7-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

the national runner-up in 2004, 2006, 2010 and 2016. The Green Knights are just one of three programs in NCAA Division III history to have won consecutive national championships (UW-Stevens Point 1989-91 and Middlebury 1995-99 and 2004-06).

Trinity is playing in its sixth NCAA Division III Tournament and playing in its third Frozen Four. The Bantams are 9-4 all-time in the tournament and won the national championship in 2015.

Norwich is making its 17th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its 12th trip to the Frozen Four. Norwich is 27-14-2 all-time in the NCAA Tournament. The Cadets won national championships in 2000, 2003 and 2010.

Adrian is making its seventh NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and third Frozen Four trip. The Bulldogs, national runner-up in 2011, are 4-6 all-time in the tournament.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Frozen Four at 22-5-1 overall. The Green Knights advanced to their 11th NCAA Division III Frozen Four with a 4-3 overtime win over Augsburg this past Saturday in De Pere.

Senior forward Noah Nelson leads the Green Knights in scoring with eight goals and 19 assists for 27 points. Senior forward Pijus Rulevicius has six goals and 18 assists for 22 points, while junior forward Tanner Froese has 13 goals and nine assists for 22 points. Sophomore forward Rilev Christensen has 11 goals and 10 assists for 21 points, while sophomore forward Roman Uchyn has 11 goals and nine assists for 20 points. Sophomore forwards Steven Phillips has nine goals and 10 assists for 19 points.

Sophomore goaltender T.J. Black is 17-2-1 with a 1.22 goals against average and .941 save percentage. Senior goaltender Tony Kujava is 5-3 with a 2.01 goals against average and .901 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 26-for-177 (14.7 percent) on the power play and is 119-for-134 (88.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Bantams:

Trinity enters the Frozen Four 20-6-3 overall. The Bantams have won a pair of NCAA Tournament games to reach Utica, topping Plattsburgh State 4-1 in a first-round game on March 11 before ousting Endicott 2-1 in double overtime this past Saturday.

Senior forward Sean Orlando has 18 goals and 18 assists for 36 points to lead the Bantams in scoring. Junior forward Tyler Whitney has 12 goals and 22 assists for 34 points, while junior forward Anthony Sabitsky has 17 goals and 16 assists

NCAA Championship Coaching Appearances

Only nine coaches in NCAA Division III history have coached in at least three NCAA Division III championship games/series since the start of the NCAA Division III Tournament in 1984. St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin ranks second all-time on the list with eight title game appearances, going 4-4 overall with two of the losses coming in overtime.

for 33 points. Senior forward Ryan Cole has 13 goals and 19 assists for 32 points.

Junior goaltender Alex Morin is 18-6-3 with a 1.72 goals against average and .935 save percentage. Freshman Tedy Loughborough is 2-0 with a 0.91 goals against average and .913 save percentage.

Trinity is 29-for-140 (20.7 percent) on the power play and is 113-for-126 (89.7 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Cadets:

Norwich enters the Frozen Four with a 25-1-3 overall record. The Cadets have won two NCAA Tournament games, beating Salem State 3-1 in a first-round game on March 11 before topping Hamilton 6-2 in a quarterfinal game this past Saturday.

Senior forward William Pelletier leads Norwich in scoring with 16 goals and 27 assists for 43 points. Junior forward Kevin Salvucci has 20 goals and 16 assists for 36 points, while senior defenseman Cody Smith has two goals and 31 assists for 33 points. Senior forward Anthony Flaherty has 11 goals and 19 assists for 30 points.

Junior goaltender Braeden Ostepchuk is 15-0 with a 1.71 goals against average and .927 save percentage. Senior Ty Reichenbach is 10-1-3 with a 1.67 goals against average and .933 save percentage.

Norwich is 38-for-141 (27.0 percent) on the power play and is 88-for-106 (83.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Bulldogs:

Adrian enters the Frozen Four 20-6-2 overall. The Bulldogs advanced by eliminating defending national champion UW-Stevens Point 6-3 this past Saturday in Stevens Point.

Sophomore forward Trevor Boyd has 18 goals and 17 assists for 35 points. Sophomore defenseman Cory Dunn has nine goals and 26 assists for 35 points, while junior forward Kyle Brothers has eight goals and 27 assists for 35 points.

Freshman forward Vincent Paquette has 14 goals and 15 assists for 29 points.

Sophomore goaltender Kevin Entmaa is 15-6-2 with a 2.18 goals against average and .915 save percentage. Junior Dillon Kelley is 5-0 with a 2.22 goals against average and .897 save percentage.

Adrian is 42-for-164 (25.6 percent) on the power play and is 131-for-153 (85.6 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert currently owns the No. 1 scoring defense in Division III at 1.61 goals allowed per game. The Green Knights have yielded 45 goals in 28 games. Norwich is currently the No. 2 scoring defense at 1.69 goals per game. Trinity is third nationally at 1.79 goals per game. All three teams are competing at the Frozen Four this weekend.

The Green Knights have led Division III in scoring defense four times - in 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2014.

St. Norbert claimed the NCAA Division III national championship the last three times it has led the country in scoring defense.

St. Norbert owns the Division III record for scoring defense in a season at a paltry 1.34 goals per game in 2008. The Green Knights yielded just 43 goals in 32 games.

St. Norbert also owns Division III's fourth-best penalty-killing unit at 88.8 percent. The Green Knights have killed 119 of their opponent's 134 power-play chances this season.

Wesleyan had the nation's top penalty kill this season at 91.6 percent, while Trinity is second at 89.7 percent.

Tourney Tidbits:

St. Norbert enters this year's Frozen Four with a glittering 19-3 record in its last 22 NCAA Tournament games. The stretch covers its last seven NCAA Tournament appearances dating back to 2008.

2008, 2011 and 2014 en route to winning NCAA Division III national championships all three years. St. Norbert was 3-1 during the 2010 tournament, losing 2-1 in double overtime to Norwich in the national title game. St. Norbert went 4-0 in 2012 to win its third national title.

St. Norbert, 28-12-1 all-time in the tournament, has suffered overtime losses in two of its last four NCAA Tournament eliminations. Including the aforementioned Norwich game, St. Norbert lost to Oswego State 4-3 in overtime in a national semifinal game in the 2007 Frozen Four at UW-Superior.

St. Norbert's 28 NCAA Tournament wins are second-most all-time in the 34-year history of the tournament. Middlebury is 34-7-2 all-time in 14 appearances for the most wins in tournament annals.

Goalie Gossip:

St. Norbert sophomore goaltender T.J. Black has enjoyed a banner season that has seen him lead Division III in goals against average for most of the year.

Black is currently No. 1 in the statistic with a 1.22 goals against average. Black is also tops nationally in shutouts with six.

Black is also No. 2 nationally in winning percentage at .875 and is third in Division III in save percentage at .941.

Four of Division III's top five

goaltenders in goals against average are on Frozen Four rosters. Norwich's Ty Reichenbach (1.67) and Braeden Ostepchuk (1.71) are third and fourth nationally, respectively. Trinity's Alex Morin is fifth at 1.72

Experience Examples:

St. Norbert is one of two teams at the Frozen Four with five players who have played in at least 100 collegiate games.

Senior forward Pijus Rulevicius leads the Green Knights with 115 career games. Senior forward Noah Nelson has 112 career games, while senior defenseman Blake Thompson has played in 111 career games. Senior forward Ross Pavek played in his 100th career game this past Saturday against Augsburg.

Senior forward Jeremy Olinyk has played in 102 career games, with 21 coming this season and 81 in his first three collegiate seasons at Adrian.

Norwich also has five players who have played at least 100 career games. Trinity has four, while Adrian does not have any.

Sophomore Soliloquy:

St. Norbert has three double-digit goal scorers this season. Junior forward Tanner Froese has a teamhigh 13, while sophomore forwards Riley Christensen and Roman Uchyn have 11 apiece.

Christensen and Uchyn also both reached double-digit goal totals as freshmen. Christensen and Uchyn both had 13 markers a year ago. They were among seven skaters nationally to have scored at least 13 goals as freshman last season.

The pair were the first freshmen tandem to reach double digits in goals at St. Norbert since 2003-04.

Eastern Eavesdroppings:

St. Norbert is 31-18-5 all-time against East Region opponents. The Green Knights played at least one game a season against an eastern foe for 18 years before not facing one in 2012-13 as well as 2013-14 until beating Geneseo State 6-2 on March 21, 2014 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four. St. Norbert then resumed facing an East Region foe with home-and-home series with Buffalo State in 2014-15 and 2015-16. The Green Knights are currently in a home-and-home series with Manhattanville in 2016-17 and 2017-18.

St. Norbert is 21-10-4 all-time on East Region ice, which includes four neutral-site visits to the Frozen Four in 2008, 2010 and 2012 in Lake Placid, N.Y., and in 2014 to Lewiston, Maine.

The Green Knights are 15-8-3 alltime in the State of New York. The record includes four visits to the Frozen Four at Herb Brooks Arena in Lake Placid and one Frozen Four trip to First Arena in Elmira.

The Green Knights are 14-3-2 alltime against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Plattsburgh State, 1-0 against Geneseo State and a 2-2 ledger against Oswego State. St. Norbert is 4-1-1 all-time against Fredonia State and 5-0-1 against Buffalo State.

St. Norbert is 7-6-3 all-time against ECAC West opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 3-5 all-time against the NESCAC.

The Green Knights are 2-0 all-time against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season

St. Norbert is 5-3 against the New England Hockey Conference (formerly known as ECAC East), going 3-3 against Norwich and 1-0 against UMass-Boston and Southern Maine.

Winner Wisdom:

Although on occasion a somewhat misleading statistic, it is interesting to note that 14 different St. Norbert skaters have recorded a game-winning goal this season.

Sophomore forward Roman Uchyn is the only Green Knights with three game-winning goals, and scored the overtime marker to lift his team to a 4-3 win over Augsburg in a national quarterfinal this past Saturday.

Senior forward Noah Nelson, junior forward Tanner Froese, sophomore forward Brad Pung, freshman forward Dominick Sacco, freshman forward Kurt Black and senior forward Ross Pavek all have two game-winning goals this season.

Senior forward Pijus Rulevicius, sophomore forward Steven Phillips, senior forward Jeremy Olinyk, junior defenseman Sean Campbell, senior defenseman Blake Thompson, junior defenseman Alfred Johansson and junior defenseman Chris Rygus all have one game-winning goal apiece.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 529-137-52 in his 24th season. Coghlin is in 21st place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches in all divisions.

Coghlin is four wins ahead of current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin, who currently has a record of 525-387-84.

Retired Minnesota State-Mankato coach Don Brose is 20th all-time with a career record of 536-335-79 from 1970-2000. Retired Army coach Jack Riley and retired Bowdoin coach Terry Meagher are tied for 18th all-time with 542 wins apiece.

Coghlin earned his 500 career wins in just 680 games. That mark is the third-fastest to 500 wins in NCAA hockey history. Only UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli (658 games) and Bemidji State's Bob Peters (677 games) have reached 500 games more quickly. According to research by the St. Norbert sports information office, no other NCAA hockey coaches have ever reached 500 wins in less than 700 games.

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 21 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dat-

Most NCAA Division III Frozen Four Appearances

Only nine programs have skated in at least six NCAA Division III Frozen Fours since the start of the NCAA Division III Tournament in 1984. Two of those nine will be participating this weekend in the 2017 Frozen Four in Utica, N.Y., with St. Norbert (11) and Norwich (12) playing in the tournament. Those two schools have accounted for seven national championships, with St. Norbert winning four and Norwich three.

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped in 2016 with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 283 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 321 of 327 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 283-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 86 weeks - surpassing Norwich's 83 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 114-23-8 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 129-51-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin, including 5-0 this year. The Green Knights are 4-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 7-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert was 21-0 in 2015-16 when leading after two periods, and is off to an 16-0-1 start in 2016-17 when setting the pace after 40 minutes of play.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 276-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green

Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 294-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 23-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 289-1-7 over their last 297 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007, a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008 and a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 27 times in their last 462 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 718-game tenure.

Western Wonders:

The Northern Collegiate Hockey Association placed a representative in the NCAA Division III championship game 22 out of a possible 33 times. St. Norbert has made eight title game appearances, coming in 2004, 2006, 2008, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2016.

Bemidji State did it twice (1985-86), UW-River Falls three times (1988, '93, '94), UW-Stevens Point six times (1989-93, '98), Mankato State once (1991), UW-Superior four times (1994, '97, '99, 2002) and UW-Eau Claire once (2013). NCHA teams have squared off for the national championship three times (1991 - Stevens Point vs. Mankato State, 1993 - Stevens Point vs. River Falls, 1994 - River Falls vs. Superior).

UW-Stevens Point (1989, '90, '91, '93), UW-River Falls (1988, '94), Bemidji State (1986), UW-Superior (2002), St. Norbert (2008, '11, '12, '14) and UW-Eau Claire (2013) have all won Division III national titles while playing under the NCHA banner.

In 34 NCAA Division III Frozen Fours, the NCHA has placed a team among the final four 32 years - the most of any league. The NCHA did not advance a team through to the Frozen Four in 1984 and 2005. River Falls lost to Union in the 1984 quarterfinals and St. Norbert lost to St. Thomas in the 2005 quarterfinals.

St. Norbert's 4-3 win over Adrian in the 2011 national championship game marked the first All-West Region final since 1994, when UW-River Falls beat UW-Superior 6-4 for the title. St. Norbert also defeated UW-Stevens Point 3-1 for the 2014 national title before the Pointers returned the favor with a 5-1 win over the Green Knights in 2016.

Ice Chips:

- * St. Norbert is 18-2-1 this season when scoring first. The Green Knights are 4-3 when their opponent scores first.
- * St. Norbert's 3.82 goals per game is its lowest total since scoring 3.81 goals per game in 2011-12. The Green Knights scored 3.43 goals per game in 2010-11. However, St. Norbert captured national championships in each of those seasons.
- * St. Norbert is outscoring its opponents 39-11 in the first period.
- * St. Norbert is 6-2 this season when tied after two periods and is 0-3 when trailing after 40 minutes.
- * St. Norbert's eight shutouts this season are tied for the second most in program history (2003-04, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2016-17). The Green Knights totaled a school-record 10 in 2007-08.



Why the Green Knights?

The Green Knights...

They were once known as the "Juggernaut" or, sometimes, the "Green Juggernaut."


That was back in the early years of St. Norbert sports - the 1920s and before, when the sports program was a combination of high school and college teams and games.

Later, into the early 1930s, St. Norbert teams were know as the "Green and Gold Wave," then, sometimes, just the "Green Wave," or the "Goldmen."

In 1933, the college yearbook, the Des Peres, was built on a medieval theme with lots of references to gallant Knights.

And in 1934, the name "Green Knights" was pinned to the college varsity teams.

The late Rev. Dennis M. Burke, O. Praem., former president of St. Norbert College, said the Knights idea was promoted largely by the Rev. L.A.V. De Cleene, O. Praem., a mathematics professor at St. Norbert in those years.



Father DeCleene had been a cadet at the U.S. Military Academy at West Point before joining the Norbertine Order and was quite taken with the West Point nickname of "Black Knights of the Hudson."

Perhaps St. Norbert's location on the banks of the Fox River contributed to this memory and fondness for the nickname. While St. Norbert's athletes never did become Green Knights of the Fox, they did evolve into Green Knights.

But why "Green?"

When the Norbertines, the Founding Fathers of St. Norbert College, originally from Berne Abbey in Holland, came to De Pere, they brought with them the Norbertine traditions that included a coat of arms primarily in red, white and blue. But being a descendant of the original abbey, the Norbertines in America kept the design but changed the colors to Dartmouth green and white with gold. The colors are said to have been suggested by an English professor originally from Dartmouth and seconded by the Rev. John A. Van Heertem, O. Praem., who had visited Dartmouth and came away favorably impressed.

In 1931, to differentiate between the high school and college departments, it was decided that the high school would retain the green and white colors while the college would adopt "Dartmouth green and light old gold" as its colors.

And that remains the official colors of today's Green Knights.

P.S. - Many out-of-town observers note the similarity between St. Norbert colors and those of the Green Bay Packers. The Packers donned blue and gold as their colors through the mid-1950s, and then switched to the current green and gold scheme shortly before the Lombardi era.
