St. Norbert continues play in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association when it faces its oldest rival Lake Forest in a home-and-home series. Saturday's game marks the start of a five-game homestand for the Green Knights.

St. Norbert has played Lake Forest 71 times, and holds a 47-20-4 advantage in a series begun in the 1988-89 season. Lake Forest won the first 14 games in the series, with St. Norbert posting a 47-6-5 ledger since.

Stevens Point. The Green Knights have met the Pointers 72 times.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 509-132-51 in his 24th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 364-62-34 in the last 16-plus seasons. Coghlin's eight NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Lake Forest coach Patrick Kelliher (St. Lawrence, 2010) is 27-22-5 in his third season in Lake Forest.

Last Season:

St. Norbert swept Lake Forest last season, winning 3-1 on Nov. 6, 2015 in De Pere before claiming an 8-2 decision the next night in Lake Forest, Ill.

Pijus Rulevicius and Roman Uchyn scored third-period goals to snap a 1-1 tie in the opener. Tony Kujava made 13 saves for St. Norbert while Billy Cooper made 35 stops for the Foresters.

St. Norbert scored four first-period goals the next night to take control early. Eight different skaters scored goals for the Green Knights. Kujava made 16 saves while Leo Podolsky and Cooper combined for 30 saves for the Foresters.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series 2-0 overall and in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association after sweeping Marian 6-0 and 7-0 this past weekend. The Green Knights are ranked No. 2 in the USCHO.com Division III and D3hockey.com polls.

Junior forward Tanner Froese and sophomore forward Roman Uchyn both have two goals and one assist for three points. Senior forward Noah Nelson and sophomore defenseman Clay Van Diets both have one goal and two assists for three points. Senior forward Pijus Rulevicius has three assists for three points.

Senior goaltender Tony Kujava is 1-0 with a 0.00 goals against average and 1.000 save percentage after making 26 saves in last Saturday's win.

Sophomore goaltender T.J. Black is 1-0 with a 0.00 goals against average and 1.000 save percentage after turning away 15 shots in last Friday's win.

St. Norbert is 4-for-22 (18.2 percent) on the power play and is 16-for-16 (100.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters the series 2-0 overall and in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Foresters swept Concordia-Wisconsin 5-3 and 3-2 in a homeand-home series this past weekend.

Senior forward Jack Lewis has three goals and one assists for four points, while sophomore forward Bron Loiselle has one goal and three assists for four points. Senior defenseman Mark Esshaki has three assists for three points. Junior forwards Charlie Izaguirre and Billy Kent each have two goals for two points.

Senior goaltender Billy Cooper is 2-0 with a 2.50 goals against average and .923 save percentage.

Lake Forest is 4-for-17 (23.5 percent) on the power play and is 13-for-17 (76.5 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Shutout Stuff:

St. Norbert opened the season with consecutive shutouts for the second time in school history after sweeping Marian by 6-0 and 7-0 scores this past weekend.

The Green Knights also opened the 2012-13 season with consecutive shutouts. St. Norbert actually began that season with three straight shutouts. The Green Knights beat Concordia-Wisconsin 4-0 in the season opener on Oct. 23, and then swept UW-Stevens Point 7-0 and 4-0 in a home-and-home series on Oct. 26-27.

Power Play Patter:

St. Norbert had 12 power-play opportunities in this past Friday's 6-0 win over Marian. The Green Knights scored on one power-play chance.

The game marked the first time in almost seven years the Green Knights have had at least 12 powerplay opportunities in a game. The last time St. Norbert had at least that many came in a 7-1 win over UW-Stevens Point in a NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs semifinal on Feb. 27, 2010.

The Green Knights parlayed 27 Pointers penalties for 92 minutes into 15 power plays, scoring four times.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 216-28-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01

St. Norbert is 196-20-9 in its last 225 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 15-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 207-23-11 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 295-50-18 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Only two visiting teams have won at least two games at the Cornerstone Community Center in the same season. Superior won three times in 2001-02 and UW-Eau Claire won twice in 2012-13. Both of those teams went on to win the NCAA Division III national championship.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 509-132-51 in his 24th season. Coghlin is in 23rd place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches in all divisions.

Coghlin is three wins behind current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin for 22nd place. Gotkin currently has a record of 512-369-80. Gustavus Adolphus coach Don Roberts (1965-96) is in 21st place with a record of 515-278-25.

Coghlin earned his 500 career wins in just 680 games. That mark is the

third-fastest to 500 wins in NCAA hockey history. Only UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli (658 games) and Bemidji State's Bob Peters (677 games) have reached 500 games more quickly. According to research by the St. Norbert sports information office, no other NCAA hockey coaches have ever reached 500 wins in less than 700 games.

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 20 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such record in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped in 2015-16 with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 267 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 305 of 311 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 267-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 81 weeks - surpassing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 109-20-8 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 123-51-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin, including 2-0 this year. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 7-7-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert was 21-0 in 2015-16 when leading after two periods, and is off to a 2-0 start in 2016-17 when setting the pace after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 269-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 287-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 17-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 283-1-7 over their last 291 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-28-6 in its last 40 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007, a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008 and a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 26 times in their last 437 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 692-game tenure.
