#### The Series:

UW-Stevens Point by a 46-21-6 margin in a series begun in the 1991-92 season. St. Norbert is 46-13-3 in the last 62 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 28-5-2 in the last 35 games in the series.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 510-133-51 in his 24th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 365-63-34 in the last 16-plus seasons. Coghlin's eight NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

UW-Superior coach Rich McKenna (Castleton State, 2007) is 3-3 in his first season in Superior.

UW-Stevens Point coach Chris Brooks (Western Michigan, 1996) is 103-40-11 in his sixth season in Stevens Point.

#### **Last Season:**

St. Norbert beat UW-Superior 4-0 on Nov. 20, 2015 at Wessman Arena in Superior. The Green Knights led 2-0 after one period and Tony Kujava made 22 saves in the shutout. Superior's Bryce Fink made 42 saves.

St. Norbert and UW-Stevens Point split two meetings last season. The Green Knights won 5-2 on Nov. 21, 2015 at K.B. Willett Arena in Stevens Point. The Pointers turned the tables with a 5-1 win on March 26, 2016 in the NCAA Division III

championship game in Lake Placid, N.Y.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert enters the weekend 5-1 overall and in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association after sweeping Aurora this past weekend, winning 2-0 and 4-3. The Green Knights are ranked No. 2 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll.

Junior forward Tanner Froese leads the Green Knights in scoring with five goals and four assists for nine points. Senior forward Pijus Rulevicius has one goal and seven assists for eight points. Freshman forward Dominick Sacco has three goals and three assists for five points. Senior forward Noah Nelson, sophomore forward Roman Uchyn and sophomore forward Brad Pung all have three goals and two assists for five points.

Sophomore goaltender T.J. Black is 3-0 with a 0.00 goals against average and 1.000 save percentage. Senior goaltender Tony Kujava is 2-1 with a 2.36 goals against average and .885 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 7-for-55 (12.7 percent) on the power play and is 35-for-37 (94.6 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

#### **About the Yellowjackets:**

UW-Superior enters the weekend with a 3-3 overall record. The Yellowjackets were swept at home last weekend in a 6-0 loss to St. Olaf and a 5-1 loss to Hamline.

points to lead the Yellowjackets in scoring. Senior defenseman Eric Shand has one goal and eight assists for nine points. Junior forward Ian Ecklund and senior forward Anton Svensson each have two goals and six assists for eight points.

Junior goaltender Ethan Wood is 3-2 with a 3.58 goals against average and .879 save percentage. Junior Bryce Fink is 0-1 with a 4.68 goals against average and .851 save percentage.

Superior is 9-for-37 (24.3 percent) on the power play and is 29-for-36 (80.6 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

#### **About the Pointers:**

UW-Stevens Point enters Friday's game at Marian with a 5-0-1 overall record and ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll. The Pointers swept a home weekend by beating Concordia-Moorhead 6-3 and St. John's 5-2.

Senior forward Jacob Barber leads the Pointers in scoring with six goals and five assists for 11 points. Senior forward Lawrence Cornellier has four goals and five assists for nine points. Junior defenseman Nathan Harris and sophomore defenseman Stephan Beauvais each have two goals and six assists for eight points.

Junior goaltender Max Milosek is 2-0-1 with a 2.28 goals against average and .841 save percentage. Sophomore Jesse Gordichuk is 3-0 with a 1.96 goals against average and .902 save percentage.

Stevens Point is 9-for-34 (26.5 percent) on the power play and is 27-for-36 (75.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

#### **Shutout Streak:**

St. Norbert sophomore goaltender T.J. Black brings a consecutive shutout sequence of 204 minutes 47 seconds into this weekend, the ninth longest such streak in NCAA Division III history.

Black has recorded shutouts in each of his three starts this season. He also just over 25 minutes of shutout time to close out his last game in 2015-16, a double-overtime win over UMass-Boston in the Frozen Four.

St. Norbert now has five of the top nine longest shutout sequences in NCAA Division III history. Kyle Jones holds the NCAA Division III record with a mark of 337:22 set Jan. 13-28, 2006. David Jacobson is fourth with a mark of 243:38 set March 17-Nov. 2, 2012. Current St. Norbert senior Tony Kujava has the fifth-longest streak in Division III history at 239:42 set Feb. 13-28, 2015. Jones also has the sixth-best mark of 234:49 set Feb. 16-March 8, 2008.

With a shutout in his next start, Black would be the third goaltender in NCAA Division III history with four consecutive shutouts. Jones did it in 2006 and St. John's Adam Hanna accomplished the feat in 2004.

#### WIAC Wisdom:

St. Norbert will face its only two Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference opponents of the regular season this weekend when it hosts UW-Superior and UW-Stevens Point.

Since the 2002-03 season, the first year the Green Knights advanced to the NCAA Division III Frozen Four, St. Norbert is 135-24-17 against the WIAC schools. In program history, St. Norbert is 210-77-29 all-time against the WIAC.

Since 2002-03, St. Norbert is 31-5-2 against UW-Stevens Point, 33-4-2 against UW-Eau Claire, 26-5-1 against UW-River Falls, 22-5-3 against UW-Stout and 22-5-8 against UW-Superior.

#### **Home Sweet Cornerstone:**

St. Norbert is 218-29-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 198-21-9 in its last 228 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 15-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 209-24-11 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

297-51-18 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Only two visiting teams have won at least two games at the Cornerstone Community Center in the same season. Superior won three times in 2001-02 and UW-Eau Claire won twice in 2012-13. Both of those teams went on to win the NCAA Division III national championship.

#### **Coghlin Count:**

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 512-133-51 in his 24th season. Coghlin is in 23rd place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches in all divisions.

Coghlin is one win behind current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin for 22nd place. Gotkin currently has a record of 513-372-80. Gustavus Adolphus coach Don Roberts (1965-96) is in 21st place with a record of 515-278-25.

Coghlin earned his 500 career wins in just 680 games. That mark is the third-fastest to 500 wins in NCAA hockey history. Only UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli (658 games) and Bemidji State's Bob Peters (677 games) have reached 500 games more quickly. According to research by the St. Norbert sports information office, no other NCAA hockey coaches have ever reached 500 wins in less than 700 games.

#### **Poll Position:**

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 269 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 307 of 313 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 268-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 81 weeks - surpassing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 109-20-8 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 123-51-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin, including 2-0 this year. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 7-7-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.
