The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 514-133-51 in his 24th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 369-63-34 in the last 16-plus seasons. Coghlin's eight NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Manhattanville coach Arlen Marshall (Manhattanville, 2010) is 52-52-11 in his fifth season in Purchase.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series 7-1 overall after posting a weekend sweep over Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foes. The Green Knights, who are ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com Division III polls, beat UW-Superior 4-0 this past Friday and then knocked off previous No. 1 UW-Stevens Point 5-3 on Saturday.

Junior forward Tanner Froese tops the Green Knights in scoring with five goals and four assists for nine points. Senior forward Pijus Rulevicius has two goals and seven assists for nine points. Senior forward Noah Nelson and sophomore forward Brad Pung each have four goals and four assists for eight points. Sophomore forward Roman Uchyn has five goals and two assists for seven points.

Sophomore goaltender T.J. Black is 5-0 with a 0.60 goals against average and .959 save percentage. Senior goaltender Tony Kujava is 2-1 with a 2.36 goals against average and .885 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 11-for-72 (15.3 percent) on the power play and is 48-for-51 (94.1 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Valiants:

Manhattanville enters the series with a 5-3 overall record. The Valiants have won four consecutive games - all ECAC West contests - after beating Lebanon Valley 4-3 last

Friday and Stevenson 5-1 last Saturday.

Sophomore defenseman Marco Ferraro leads the Valiants in scoring with four goals and seven assists for 11 points. Sophomore forward Matt Lippa has five goals and five assists for 10 points. Senior forward Adam Platt has six goals and two assists for eight points. Senior defenseman Tanner Hicks and sophomore forward Eric Berglund each have two goals and six assists for eight points.

Sophomore goaltender Tyler Feaver is 4-3 with a 3.15 goals against average and .886 save percentage. Junior Kyle Redmond is 1-0 with a 2.00 goals against average and .905 save percentage.

Manhattanville is 11-for-55 (20.0 percent) on the power play and is 47-for-53 (88.7 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 514-133-51 in his 24th season. Coghlin is tied for 22nd place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches in all divisions.

Coghlin is tied with current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin for 22nd place. Gotkin currently has a record of 514-374-80. Gustavus Adolphus coach Don Roberts (1965-96) is in 21st place with a record of 515-278-25.

Coghlin earned his 500 career wins in just 680 games. That mark is the third-fastest to 500 wins in NCAA hockey history. Only UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli (658 games) and Bemidji State's Bob Peters (677 games) have reached 500 games more quickly. According to research by the St. Norbert sports information office, no other NCAA hockey coaches have ever reached 500 wins in less than 700 games.

Power Play Possibilities:

St. Norbert has enjoyed more time on the power play this season than any other team in Division III.

The Green Knights have had 72 power-play opportunities this sea-

son, five more than the second most in Division III - Marian's 67. Nazareth's 61 is the only other total currently over 60.

St. Norbert had 12 power-play chances in a 5-3 win over then-No. 1 UW-Stevens Point this past Saturday, the third time this season it has had at least 10 power-play advantages in a game.

Eastern Eavesdroppings:

St. Norbert is 30-17-5 all-time against East Region opponents. The Green Knights played at least one game a season against an eastern foe for 18 years before not facing one in 2012-13 as well as 2013-14 until beating Geneseo State 6-2 on March 21, 2014 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four. St. Norbert then resumed facing an East Region foe with home-and-home series with Buffalo State in 2014-15 and 2015-16 and continues with a home-and-home series with Manhattanville in 2016-17 and 2017-18.

St. Norbert is 20-9-4 all-time on East Region ice, which includes four neutral-site visits to the Frozen Four in 2008, 2010, 2012 and 2016 in Lake Placid, N.Y., and in 2014 to Lewiston, Maine.

The Green Knights are 14-3-2 all-time against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Plattsburgh State, 1-0 against Geneseo State and a 2-2 ledger against Oswego State. St. Norbert is 4-1-1 all-time against Fredonia State and 5-0-1 against Buffalo State.

St. Norbert is 6-5-3 all-time against ECAC West opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 3-5 all-time against the NESCAC.

The Green Knights are 2-0 all-time against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season.

St. Norbert is 5-3 against the conference formerly known as ECAC East, going 3-3 against Norwich and 1-0 against UMass-Boston and Southern Maine.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 270 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 308 of 314 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 269-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 82 weeks - surpassing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 109-20-8 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 124-51-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin, including 2-0 this year. The Green Knights are 4-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 7-7-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert was 21-0 in 2015-16 when leading after two periods, and is off to a 6-0 start in 2016-17 when setting the pace after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 272-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 290-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji

The Green Knights are 18-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 284-1-7 over their last 292 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007, a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008 and a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 27 times in their last 442 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 698-game tenure.

Ice Chips:

* - Manhattanville is 2-1 all-time against NCAA Division III West Region foes. The Valiants' last such game was an impressive 6-2 win over eventual national runner-up Adrian on Dec. 31, 2010 at the Norwich Tournament. Manhattanville also lost to St. Thomas 4-2 on Dec. 30, 2005 and beat Lake Forest 3-2 on Dec. 30, 2004 - also both at the Norwich Tournament.

* - St. Norbert has allowed just three power-play goals this season while scoring five shorthanded goals. The Green Knights plus-2 margin while shorthanded is the only positive mark currently in Division III. Utica and Oswego State are both even, the only other two teams in Division III to be level shorthanded.

* - Sophomore goaltender T.J. Black's consecutive scoreless sequence ended Saturday at 266 minutes 37 seconds, the third-longest streak in Division III history.

* - Saturday's game will be St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin's 700th leading the Green Knights.
