St. Norbert faces a pair of pivotal games in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association race when it travels to Adrian. The Green Knights, who have two games in hand on the Bulldogs, trail Adrian by five points in the NCHA standings.

#### The Series:

Adrian leads St. Norbert 6-5 in an all-time series that began during the 2009-10 season. The Bulldogs have won six of the last eight meetings in the series.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 519-134-52 in his 24th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 374-64-35 in the last 16-plus seasons. Coghlin's eight NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Adrian coach Adam Krug (Adrian, 2012) is 60-11-6 in his third season in Adrian.

#### Last Season:

St. Norbert and Adrian split its two regular-season games against each other on Jan. 22-23, 2016 at the Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. Adrian then won the NCHA Harris Cup title game 4-1 on March 5, 2016 at Arrington Ice Arena in Adrian, Mich.

Adrian won the first game 5-4 on a goal by Chris Leone with 2:17 remaining. Michael Hill scored two power-play goals for the Green Knights. Tyler Parks made 27 saves for the Bulldogs while Tony Kujava made 24 stops for the Green Knights.

St. Norbert countered with a 2-1 win the next day with Ross Pavek scoring the game-winning goal shorthanded with 13:39 remaining. Hill also scored for St. Norbert while Daniel Lisi scored for Adrian. T.J. Black made 31 saves for St. Norbert and Parks made 13 stops for the Bulldogs.

In the Harris Cup title game, Adrian took a 2-0 lead into the third period. Tanner Froese's shorthanded goal at 12:14 of the third period cut it to 2-1 but the Bulldogs salted the game away late. Black made 31 saves for St. Norbert while Kevin Entmaa and Parks combined for 38 saves for the Bulldogs.

#### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series 12-2-1 overall and 8-1-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights are ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com polls. St. Norbert is coming off a sweep of Finlandia by scores of 7-1 and 3-0 this past weekend in Hancock, Mich.

Junior forward Tanner Froese leads the Green Knights in scoring with 10 goals and six assists for 16 points. Senior forward Jeremy Olinyk has five goals and eight assists for 13 points, while senior forward Pijus Rulevicius has four goals and nine assists for 13 points. Sophomore forward Roman Uchyn has seven goals and five assists for 12 points.

Sophomore goaltender T.J. Black is 8-0-1 with a 0.88 goals against average and .949 save percentage. Senior goaltender Tony Kujava is 4-2 with a 1.86 goals against average and .909 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 17-for-105 (16.2 percent) on the power play and is 77for-81 (95.1 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

#### About the Bulldogs:

Adrian enters the series 12-3-2 overall and 11-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Bulldogs, ranked No. 7 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, swept a road series at Lake Forest 5-1 and 5-2 this past weekend.

Sophomore forward Trevor Boyd leads the Bulldogs in scoring with 12 goals and 13 assists for 25 points. Sophomore defenseman Cory Dunn has five goals and 20 assists for 25 points. Freshman forward Vincent Paquette has scored 11 goals and 11 assists for 22 points, while junior forward Kyle Brothers has six goals and 16 assists for 22 points. Sophomore forward Bryan Yim has 11 goals and 10 assists for 21 points.

Sophomore goaltender Kevin Entmaa has an 8-3-2 record with a 2.29 goals against average and .912 save percentage. Junior Dillon Kelley is 4-0 with a 2.02 goals against average and .909 save percentage.

Adrian is 26-for-104 (25.0 percent)

on the power play and is 70-for-87 (80.5 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

#### January Joy:

Since Tim Coghlin took over the reins of the St. Norbert hockey program in the 1993-94 season, the Green Knights have enjoyed strong success in the first month of a new year.

The Green Knights are 139-31-17 all-time under Coghlin in the month of January, working out to a winning percentage of .789.

St. Norbert went 5-1 last season in the month of January, the only loss coming in a NCHA series split at home with Adrian.

The Green Knights had an anomalous month of January in 2015, going 4-4-1 in the nine games played that month. It accounted for two-thirds of St. Norbert's loss total that season.

The Green Knights last had an unbeaten January en route to their fourth national championship in 2014. St. Norbert went 7-0-1 in January 2014.

#### D is for Defense:

St. Norbert currently owns the No. 1 scoring defense in Division III at 1.33 goals allowed per game. The Green Knights have yielded 20 goals in 15 games.

St. Norbert also owns Division III's top penalty-killing unit at 95.1 percent. The Green Knights have killed 77 of their opponent's 81 power-play chances this season.

The Green Knights are the only team in Division III to have scored more shorthanded goals than power-play goals allowed. St. Norbert has registered five shorthanded markers this season against four power-play goals allowed for a net gain of one.

#### **Coghlin Count:**

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 519-134-52 in his 24th season. Coghlin is tied for 21st place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches in all divisions.

Coghlin is tied with current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin, who currently has a record of 519-380-81.

Retired Minnesota State-Mankato coach Don Brose is 20th all-time with a career record of 536-335-79 from 1970-2000. Retired Army coach Jack Riley and retired Bowdoin coach Terry Meagher are tied for 18th all-time with 542 wins apiece.

Coghlin earned his 500 career wins in just 680 games. That mark is the third-fastest to 500 wins in NCAA hockey history. Only UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli (658 games) and Bemidji State's Bob Peters (677 games) have reached 500 games more quickly. According to research by the St. Norbert sports information office, no other NCAA hockey coaches have ever reached 500 wins in less than 700 games.

#### **Poll Position:**

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 276 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 314 of 320 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 276-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 85 weeks - surpassing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 112-21-8 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 125-51-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin, including 2-0 this year. The Green Knights are 4-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 7-7-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

#### **Tough After Two:**

St. Norbert was 21-0 in 2015-16 when leading after two periods, and is off to a 9-0-1 start in 2016-17 when setting the pace after 40 minutes.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 290-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

#### **Gimme Five:**

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 19-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 285-1-7 over their last 293 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007, a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008 and a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 27 times in their last 449 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 705-game tenure.
