The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 529-138-52 in his 25th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 384-68-35 in the last 17 seasons. Coghlin's eight NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Concordia coach Jasen Wise (St. Thomas, 1996) is 51-73-8 in his sixth season in Mequon. Wise went 119-88-14 coaching at Marian for eight seasons for an overall record of 170-162-22 in 14 seasons.

MSOE coach Mark Ostapina (Wisconsin, 1979) is 240-179-21 in his 17th season in Milwaukee. Including six seasons at New England College, Ostapina is 303-263-29 in 23 seasons.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the new season coming off a 22-6-1 campaign that saw the Green Knights advance to their 11th NCAA Division III Frozen Four.

Senior forward Tanner Froese is the leading returning scorer with 13 goals and nine assists for 22 points last season. Junior forward Riley Christensen scored 11 goals and 10 assists for 21 points a year ago, while junior forward Roman Uchyn had 11 goals and nine assists for 20 points. Junior forward Steven Phillips had nine goals and 10 assists for 19 points, while junior forward Brad Pung finished with seven goals and 11 assists for 18 points.

Junior goaltender T.J. Black was 17-3-1 with a 1.31 goals against average and .939 save percentage a year ago.

St. Norbert was 27-for-178 (15.2 percent) on the power play and was 121-for-137 (88.3 percent) on the penalty kill last season.

About the Falcons:

Concordia enters the weekend at 2-0 overall. The Falcons topped UW-River Falls 4-3 on Friday and UW-Superior 4-2 on Saturday, both in Mequon.

Junior forward Stefen Seel has two goals and two assists for four points. Sophomore forward Josh Adkins has one goal and two assists for three points. Junior forward Adam Fauchoux, junior forward Taylor Gauld and freshman defenseman Brett Garvey all have one goal and one assist for two points.

Junior goaltender Nick Malvin was between the pipes in both games, going 2-0 with a 2.50 goals against average and .904 save percentage.

Concordia is 3-for-12 (25.0 percent) on the power play and is 7-for-9 (77.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Raiders:

MSOE enters Friday's game at Finlandia 2-0 overall. The Raiders tipped UW-Eau Claire 2-0 last Friday and UW-River Falls 3-1 last Saturday, both in Milwaukee.

Senior forward James Ring and sophomore defenseman Nick Redmon both have two assists for two points. Senior defensemen Chris Hinrichs and Zach Simpson, senior forwards Jerad Tafoya and Brett Wagner and freshman forward Garrett Gintoli all have one goal for one point.

Senior goaltender Zach Woodman played in both games, fashioning a 2-0 record with a 0.50 goals against average and .983 save percentage.

MSOE is 2-for-14 (14.3 percent) on the power play and is 15-for-16 (93.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Season Openers:

St. Norbert is 20-9 in its season openers, having won its last 17 season lidlifters (over UW-Eau Claire in 2000 and three straight over Marian from 2001 to 2003, RIT and

2004, Marian in 2005-06, Lawrence in 2007-08, Lake Forest in 2009, UW-Stout in 2010, Concordia-Wis. in 2011-2012 and Marian in 2013-2016).

The Green Knights are 19-5 all-time in season openers under Tim Coghlin.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 529-137-52 in his 24th season. Coghlin is in 21st place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches in all divisions.

Coghlin is two wins ahead of current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin, who currently has a record of 527-389-86.

Retired Minnesota State-Mankato coach Don Brose is 20th all-time with a career record of 536-335-79 from 1970-2000. Retired Army coach Jack Riley and retired Bowdoin coach Terry Meagher are tied for 18th all-time with 542 wins apiece.

Coghlin earned his 500 career wins in just 680 games. That mark is the third-fastest to 500 wins in NCAA hockey history. Only UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli (658 games) and Bemidji State's Bob Peters (677 games) have reached 500 games more quickly. According to research by the St. Norbert sports information office, no other NCAA hockey coaches have ever reached 500 wins in less than 700 games.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 229-30-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 209-22-9 in its last 240 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the

NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 16 seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 220-25-11 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 308-52-18 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Only two visiting teams have won at least two games at the Cornerstone Community Center in the same season. Superior won three times in 2001-02 and UW-Eau Claire won twice in 2012-13. Both of those teams went on to win the NCAA Division III national championship.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 286 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 324 of 330 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 286-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 87 weeks - surpassing Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 114-23-8 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 129-52-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 4-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 7-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert was 21-0 in 2015-16 when leading after two periods, and followed with a 16-0-1 mark in 2016-17 when setting the pace after

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 276-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 294-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 23-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 289-1-7 over their last 297 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007, a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008 and a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 27 times in their last 463 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 719-game tenure.
