The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 551-142-53 in his 25th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 406-72-36 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's eight NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Marian coach Zach Gaynor (Marian, 2008) is 20-6-1 in his first season in Fond du Lac.

This Season:

St. Norbert beat Marian 4-1 on Dec. 2, 2017 at Blue Line Family Ice Center in Fond du Lac. Roman Uchyn, Kurt Black, Dominick Sacco and Tanner Froese all scored for the Green Knights, while Curtis Lewington scored for the Sabres. T.J. Black made 27 saves for the Green Knights, who were 3-for-10 on the power play. Hunter Vorva made 31 stops for Marian.

St. Norbert defeated Marian 7-2 on Jan. 12, 2018 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. Kurt Black scored two goals for the Green Knights, while Timmy Nicksic added one goal and two assists. Brock Weston and Jake Howie scored for the Sabres. T.J. Black made 17 saves for St. Norbert, which was 3-for-7 on the power play. Hunter Vorva made 27 stops for the Sabres.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 22-4-1 overall and ranked No. 2 in the USCHO.com Division III and D3hockey.com polls. The Green Knights swept Lawrence by a pair of 3-1 scores last weekend in a NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs quarterfinal series.

Senior forward Tanner Froese has 10 goals and 17 assists for a team-best 27 points. Freshman forward Keegan Milligan has a teamhigh 11 goals with 12 assists for 23 points. Freshman Peter Bates has 10 goals and 13 assists for 23 points, while sophomore forward Dominick Sacco has 10 goals and 12 assists for 22 points. Junior forward Riley Christensen has five goals and 14 assists for 19 points.

Junior goaltender T.J. Black is 22-3-1 with a 1.44 goals against average and .938 save percentage. Freshman Ryan Bontorin is 0-1 with a 1.63 goals against average and .917 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 33-for-142 (23.2 percent) on the power play and is 101-for-111 (91.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Sabres:

Marian enters the series 20-6-1 overall. The Sabres, who have won their last nine games, won their NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs quarterfinals series over St. Scholastica by scores of 4-1 and 3-2. Marian is ranked No. 13 in the USCHO.com Poll and No. 12 in the D3hockey.com Poll.

Senior forward Hunter Stewart leads the Sabres in scoring with 12 goals and 24 assists for 36 points. Senior Derek Thorogood has 15 goals and 19 assists for 34 points. Junior forward Nick Monfils has five goals and 18 assists for 23 points, while senior defenseman Gianni Mangone has nine goals and eight assists for 17 points.

Sophomore goaltender Hunter Vorva is 20-6-1 with a 1.89 goals against average and .924 save percentage.

Marian is 25-for-114 (21.9 percent) on the power play and is 105for-121 (86.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Cup Clamor:

St. Norbert aims to continue toward its 14th NCHA Playoffs championship when it hosts Marian in a Harris Cup Playoffs semifinal game.

The Green Knights are 69-14-1 alltime in the NCHA Playoffs, and are 66-7 at home all-time in the tournament. St. Norbert is 3-7-1 on the road.

St. Norbert has won its last 22 rounds at home in the NCHA Playoffs, which includes 34 consecutive wins. The Green Knights' last loss in the league post-season was a 3-2 overtime loss to UW-Superior in the 2006 NCHA Peters Cup Championship.

Since the 1996-97 season, St. Norbert has played just six of its last 55 NCHA Playoff series/rounds on the road. The Green Knights, after a third-place finish in the NCHA in 2000-01, played at UW-River Falls in the semifinal round and were eliminated 1-0 in an overtime mini-game. St. Norbert's 3-0 loss at UW-Superior in the NCHA

Semifinals in 2009. St. Norbert won the final Peters Cup Playoffs championship with a 3-0 win at UW-Eau Claire in 2013. The Green Knights lost in the Harris Cup championship at Adrian in 2015 and 2016 before winning there in 2017.

St. Norbert finished second in 1999-2000 but was eliminated in the semifinals at the De Pere Ice Arena in a mini-game of a two-game series by UW-Superior. The Green Knights were seeded second in 2007 but hosted the championship after top-seeded River Falls lost in the semifinals.

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 22 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such record in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped in 2016 with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 243-30-13 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 223-22-10 in its last 255 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 16-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 234-25-12 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior

during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 322-52-19 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 300 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 338 of 344 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 300-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 96 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 129-26-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 135-53-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 4-6 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2ranked team.

St. Norbert is 6-1 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll this season.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 551-142-53 in his 25th season. Coghlin is in 18th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Coghlin's 551 wins is now four wins shy of 17th place, trailing legendary Michigan Tech coach John MacInnes' 555-295-39 mark from 1957-82.

Coghlin is also only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert had an 83-game unbeaten streak when leading after two periods snapped in a 3-2 overtime loss to Adrian on Jan. 26. The

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 304-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 32-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 298-1-7 over their last 306 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007, a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008 and a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 28 times in their last 488 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 742-game tenure.
