St. Norbert College Green Knights Hockey Preview NCAA DIVISION III FROZEN FOUR

Game Overview:

Historic Herb Brooks Arena hosts the Frozen Four as four teams converge in Lake Placid to determine the 2018 NCAA Division III champion. St. Norbert is aiming for its fifth national title in 11 years, capturing the crown at Lake Placid in 2008 and 2012, in 2011 at Minneapolis and in 2014 at Lewiston, Maine. UW-Stevens Point is hunting for its sixth national title, with its last coming in 2016. Salve Regina and Colby are both making its first Frozen Four appearances.

The Series:

St. Norbert has never faced Colby or Salve Regina in men's ice hockey.

Fierce rivals for more than two decades, St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stevens Point by a 48-21-6 margin in a series begun in the 1991-92 season. St. Norbert is 48-13-3 in the last 64 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 30-5-2 in the last 37 games in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 553-142-53 in his 25th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 408-72-36 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's eight NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Colby coach Blaise MacDonald (RIT, 1985) is 62-70-20 in his sixth season in Waterville. MacDonald was 150-178-42 in 10 seasons at UMass-Lowell and 91-58-17 in five seasons at Niagara for an overall record of 303-306-79 in 21 seasons.

Salve Regina coach Zech Klann (UMass Amherst, 2007) is 21-5-2 in his first season in Newport.

UW-Stevens Point coach Tyler

Krueger (UW-Stevens Point, 2014) is 21-5-3 in his first season in Stevens Point.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 18th overall NCAA Division III Tournament appearance, all coming within in the last 22 seasons. The Green Knights are 29-13-1 all-time in NCAA competition, have reached 12 Frozen Fours, and have won 20 of their last 24 NCAA Tournament games. St. Norbert won national championships in 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 and was the national runner-up in 2004, 2006, 2010 and 2016. The Green Knights are just one of three programs in NCAA Division III history to have won consecutive national championships (UW-Stevens Point 1989-91 and Middlebury 1995-99 and 2004-06).

Colby is making its second NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and is paying its first visit to the Frozen Four. The Mules are 2-2 all-time in the tournament. Colby's only other NCAA Tournament appearance was 1996, when it was swept by Middlebury in a two-game quarterfinal series.

Like Colby, Salve Regina is making its second NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and first trip to the Frozen Four. The

St. Norbert vs. Ranked Teams in 2017-2018

St. Norbert is 9-1 against ranked teams this season - going 3-0 against Augsburg, 2-1 against Adrian and 1-0 against MSOE, UW-Eau Claire, UW-Stevens Point and Marian. St. Norbert is 138-53-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 5-6 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team. The Green Knights are 17-2 against nationally ranked foes over the last two seasons.

Seahawks are 1-1 all-time in the NCAA Tournament. Salve Regina also qualified for the tournament in 2016.

UW-Stevens Point is making its 14th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its 10th visit to the Frozen Four. The Pointers, who are 27-15-3 all-time in the tournament, won national titles in 1989, 1990, 1991, 1993 and 2016. Stevens Point is 9-0 all-time in national semifinal rounds.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Frozen Four 25-4-1 overall and ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Division III and D3hockey.com polls. The Green Knights advanced to their 12th NCAA Division III Frozen Four with a 5-2 win over Augsburg this past Saturday.

Senior forward Tanner Froese has 12 goals and 17 assists for a team-high 29 points. Sophomore forward Dominick Sacco has 10 goals and 16 assists for 26 points. Freshman forward Keegan Milligan has 12 goals along with 13 assists for 25 points, while freshman forward Peter Bates has 11 goals and 14 assists for 25 points. Junior forward Steven Phillips has nine goals and 11 assists for 20 points, while junior forward Riley Christensen has six goals and 14 assists for 20 points.

Junior goaltender T.J. Black is 25-3-1 with a 1.39 goals against average and .940 save percentage. Freshman

Ryan Bontorin is 0-1 with a 1.63 goals against average and .917 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 35-for-160 (21.9 percent) on the power play and is 112-for-122 (91.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Mules:

Colby enters the Frozen Four with a 17-10-2 overall record. The Mules, who were the No. 6 seeding in the NESCAC playoffs after finishing league play 9-7-2, have won six consecutive games. Colby also topped the University of New England 4-2 in a NCAA first-round game on March 10 and followed up with a pulsating 2-1 win over SUNY-Geneseo in a national quarterfinal this past Saturday.

The Mules, who haven't played a home game since Feb. 11, are led in scoring by sophomore forward Kienan Scott's 11 goals and 15 assists for 26 points. Senior forward Phil Klitirinos has eight goals and 18 assists for 26 points, while senior forward Cam MacDonald has a team-high 15 goals with 10 assists for 25 points. Junior forward Nick O'Connor has 11 goals and 13 assists for 24 points. Freshman forward Justin Grillo, who scored the game-winning goal against Geneseo with 1.6 seconds remaining, has 11 goals and 13 assists for 24 points.

Senior goaltender Sean Lawrence is 16-7-2 with a 2.01 goals against

Colby is 21-for-112 (18.8 percent) on the power play and is 70-for-86 (81.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Seahawks:

Salve Regina enters the Frozen Four at 21-5-2 overall and ranked No. 6 in both the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com polls. The Seahawks advanced to the Frozen Four with a 4-3 win over Nichols this past Saturday in the NCAA quarterfinals.

Sophomore forward Jack Billings has 19 goals and 26 assists for 45 points, while freshman forward Danny Eruzione has 10 goals and 25 assists for 35 points. Sophomore defenseman Vincenzo Renda has two goals and 20 assists for 22 points. Senior forward Colin Clapton has 13 goals and eight assists for 21 points, while freshman forward Erik Udahl has 12 goals and nine assists for 21 points.

Junior goaltender Blake Wojtala is 19-5-2 with a 2.07 goals against average and .933 save percentage. Freshman Ulysses Lalor is 2-0 with a 1.96 goals against average and .918 save percentage.

Salve Regina is 28-for-143 (19.6 percent) on the power play and is 115-for-137 (83.9 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters the Frozen Four 21-5-3 overall and ranked No. 4 in the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com polls. The Pointers won their national quarterfinal over No. 2-ranked Adrian 5-2 on the road this past Saturday.

Junior forward Tanner Karty leads all players in the Frozen Four in scoring with 22 goals and 26 assists for 48 points. Senior forward Willem Nong-Lambert has 11 goals and 23 assists for 34 points.

Stevens Point is 29-for-146 (23.0 percent) on the power play and is 111-for-126 (88.1 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert enters the NCAA Tournament with the No. 1-rated defense in Division III, allowing just 1.40 goals per game.

Only three times in Division III history has a team had a scoring defense for the season under 1.45 goals per game. St. Norbert holds the Division III record at 1.34 in 2007-08. Norwich had a 1.39 mark

in 2009-10, while St. Norbert had a 1.44 ledger in 2013-14.

The Green Knights have led the Division III in scoring defense five times (2007, 2008, 2011, 2014 and 2017).

St. Norbert also boasts the nation's top penalty kill at 91.8 percent.

St. Norbert has outscored its opponents 44-8 during its 10-game winning streak and has allowed more than one goal just once during that stretch.

Black Bullets:

St. Norbert junior goaltender T.J. Black enters the Frozen Four is second in Division III in goals against average at 1.37 and is third in save percentage at .941.

Black has also tied a St. Norbert season record for goaltender wins at 25. Black matched Kyle Jones' 25 wins in the 2006-07 season.

Black also has 12 career shutouts, which is third-most in school history. Jones had 25 from 2005-08, while David Jacobson posted 20 white-

Freshmen Fodder:

St. Norbert has benefitted this season from its 10-member freshmen class. Four of the Green Knights' top eight scorers this season have been freshmen.

Forward Keegan Milligan has 12 goals and 13 assists for 25 points, while forward Peter Bates has 11 goals and 14 assists for 25 points. Bates also has five power-play goals and five game-winning goals.

Forward Timmy Nicksic has six goals and 12 assists for 18 points, with goals in each of this last two games. Defenseman Luke Davison is the Green Knights' top scoring blueliner this season at five goals and 13 assists for 18 points.

St. Norbert's four freshmen in the top eight in scoring are the most of any team in the Frozen Four.

Tourney Tidbits:

St. Norbert enters this year's Frozen Four with a glittering 20-4 record in its last 24 NCAA Tournament games. The stretch covers its last eight NCAA Tournament appearances dating back to 2008.

The Green Knights went 3-0 in 2008, 2011 and 2014 en route to winning NCAA Division III national championships all three years. St. Norbert was 3-1 during the 2010 tournament, losing 2-1 in double overtime to Norwich in the national

title game. St. Norbert went 4-0 in 2012 to win its third national title.

St. Norbert is 29-13-1 all-time in the tournament. The Green Knights' 29 NCAA Tournament wins are tied with Norwich for second-most all-time in the 35-year history of the tournament. Middlebury is 34-7-2 all-time in 14 appearances for the most wins in tournament annals.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 554-142-53 in his 25th season. Coghlin is in 18th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Coghlin's 554 wins is now one win shy of 17th place, trailing legendary Michigan Tech coach John MacInnes' 555-295-39 mark from 1957-82. MacInnes' win total was the most in college hockey history at the time of his retirement.

Coghlin is also only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marks the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a sea-

St. Norbert enters the 2018 NCAA Division III Frozen Four having amassed the second-most wins in NCAA Tournament play in the 35-year history of the tournament. The Green Knights have totaled 29 wins in NCAA play, which trails only Middlebury's 34 for the most in tournament history. Teams with at least 20 NCAA Tournament wins are listed below.

son. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane has seven, while Emery has six.

Coghlin also has 29 NCAA Division III Tournament victories, which is second-most all-time. Only Middlebury's Bill Beaney possesses more with 33.

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 22 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such record in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped in 2016 with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

Overtime Observations:

St. Norbert's 2-1 overtime win over Adrian to win the NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs on March 3 was its third overtime triumph this season.

This season marks the fourth time the Green Knights have won at least two overtime games in one year. St.

Norbert won a record four overtime games in 2007-08, followed by three wins this season. The Green Knights won two each in 1995-96 and in 2013-14. The 2008 and 2014 seasons were national championship years.

St. Norbert is now 24-13-47 all-time in overtime games. The Green Knights have won nine of their last 10 overtime games not ending in a tie, the only blemish a 3-2 loss to Adrian on Jan. 26, 2018.

WIAC Wisdom:

St. Norbert could face Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference member UW-Stevens Point this weekend if both teams advance to the national championship game.

Since the 2002-03 season, the first year the Green Knights advanced to the NCAA Division III Frozen Four, St. Norbert is 139-24-17 against the WIAC schools. In program history, St. Norbert is 214-77-29 all-time against the WIAC.

Since 2002-03, St. Norbert is 33-5-2 against UW-Stevens Point, 34-4-2 against UW-Eau Claire, 26-5-1 against UW-River Falls, 22-5-3 against UW-Stout and 23-5-8 against UW-Superior.

Eastern Eavesdroppings:

St. Norbert is 32-19-6 all-time against East Region opponents. The Green Knights played at least one game a season against an eastern foe for 18 years before not facing one in 2012-13 as well as 2013-14 until beating Geneseo State 6-2 on March 21, 2014 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four. St. Norbert then resumed facing an East Region foe with home-and-home series with

Buffalo State in 2014-15 and 2015-16. The Green Knights went 2-1-1 in a home-and-home series Manhattanville in 2016-17 and 2017-18.

St. Norbert is 21-11-4 all-time on East Region ice, which includes five neutral-site visits to the Frozen Four in 2008, 2010 and 2012 in Lake Placid, N.Y., in 2014 to Lewiston, Maine, and in 2017 to Utica, N.Y.

The Green Knights are 15-8-3 all-time in the State of New York. The record includes four visits to the Frozen Four at Herb Brooks Arena in Lake Placid and one Frozen Four trip each to First Arena in Elmira and Memorial Auditorium in Utica. St. Norbert is 6-2 all-time at Herb Brooks Arena.

The Green Knights are 14-3-2 all-time against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Plattsburgh State, 1-0 against Geneseo State and a 2-2 ledger against Oswego State. St. Norbert is 4-1-1 all-time against Fredonia State and 5-0-1 against Buffalo State.

St. Norbert is 7-6-3 all-time against the United Collegiate Hockey Conference (formerly known as the ECAC West) opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 3-6 all-time against the NESCAC (2-4 vs. Middlebury, 1-0 vs. Amherst, 0-1 vs. Trinity and Williams).

The Green Knights are 2-0 all-time against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season.

St. Norbert is 5-3 against the New England Hockey Conference (formerly

Most NCAA Division III Frozen Four Appearances

Only nine programs have skated in at least six NCAA Division III Frozen Fours since the start of the NCAA Division III Tournament in 1984. Two of those nine will be participating this weekend in the 2017 Frozen Four in Utica, N.Y., with St. Norbert (12) and UW-Stevens Point (10) playing in the tournament. Those two schools have accounted for nine national championships, with St. Norbert winning four and UW-Stevens Point five. By contrast, Salve Regina and Colby are both making its first Frozen Four appearance.

known as ECAC East), going 3-3 against Norwich and 1-0 against UMass-Boston and Southern Maine.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 302 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 340 of 346 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 302-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 97 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 130-26-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 138-53-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 5-6 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

St. Norbert is 9-1 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll this season (see info box on Page 2).

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert had an 83-game unbeaten streak when leading after two periods snapped in a 3-2 overtime loss to Adrian on Jan. 26. The Green Knights were 81-0-2 since the semester break of the 2013-14 season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 288-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods

of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 306-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 33-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 299-1-7 over their last 307 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 28 times in their last 491 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 745-game tenure.

Western Wonders:

The Northern Collegiate Hockey

Association placed a representative in the NCAA Division III championship game 22 out of a possible 34 times. St. Norbert has made eight title game appearances, coming in 2004, 2006, 2008, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2016.

Bemidji State did it twice (1985-86), UW-River Falls three times (1988, '93, '94), UW-Stevens Point six times (1989-93, '98), Mankato State once (1991), UW-Superior four times (1994, '97, '99, 2002) and UW-Eau Claire once (2013). NCHA teams have squared off for the national championship three times (1991 - Stevens Point vs. Mankato State, 1993 - Stevens Point vs. River Falls, 1994 - River Falls vs. Superior).

UW-Stevens Point (1989, '90, '91, '93), UW-River Falls (1988, '94), Bemidji State (1986), UW-Superior (2002), St. Norbert (2008, '11, '12, '14) and UW-Eau Claire (2013) have all won Division III national titles while playing under the NCHA banner.

In 35 NCAA Division III Frozen Fours, the NCHA has placed a team among the final four 33 years - the most of any league. The NCHA did not advance a team through to the Frozen Four in 1984 and 2005. River Falls lost to Union in the 1984 quarterfinals and St. Norbert lost to St. Thomas in the 2005 quarterfinals.

St. Norbert's 4-3 win over Adrian in the 2011 national championship game marked the first All-West Region final since 1994, when UW-River Falls beat UW-Superior 6-4 for the title. St. Norbert also defeated UW-Stevens Point 3-1 for the 2014 national title before the Pointers returned the favor with a 5-1 win over the Green Knights in 2016 in Lake Placid, N.Y.

St. Norbert at Herb Brooks Arena

St. Norbert is making its fifth appearance in a NCAA Division III Frozen Four at historic Herb Brooks Arena in Lake Placid, N.Y. The Green Knights are the first team to play in five Frozen Fours in Lake Placid, advancing in 2008, 2010, 2012, 2016 and 2018. St. Norbert did not advance to Lake Placid, missing the NCAA tournament altogether in 2009 and losing in the quarterfinals to eventual champion UW-Eau Claire in 2009. Below are the eight games St. Norbert has played in Lake Placid.
