The Series:

This is the first meeting between St. Norbert and Trine.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 531-138-52 in his 25th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 386-68-35 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's eight NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Trine coach Alex Todd (Union, 2001) is 0-4 in his first season in Angola. He was 114-78-21 in eight seasons at Castleton State to give him a career record of 114-82-21.

Adrian coach Adam Krug (Adrian, 2012) is 70-15-6 in his fourth season in Adrian.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend 2-0 overall and in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights, ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, topped Concordia-Wisconsin 6-2 and MSOE 4-1 this past weekend in De Pere.

Senior forward Tanner Froese leads the Green Knights in scoring with one goal and four assists for five points. Junior forward Riley Christensen and freshman forward Peter Bates both have four assists for four points. Junior forward Brad Pung has two goals for two points.

Junior goaltender T.J. Black is 2-0 with a 1.50 goals against average and .925 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 5-for-13 (38.5 percent) on the power play and is 11-for-12 (91.7 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Thunder:

First-year program Trine enters the game 0-4 overall and 0-2 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Thunder, located in Angola, Ind., lost at Marian 9-2 and at Lawrence 6-2 last weekend.

Senior forward Lucas Bombardier has two goals and two assists for four points. Sophomore forward Tanner Bennett has two goals for two points. Freshmen forwards Carmine Taffo and Corey Robertson each have two assists for two points.

Sophomore goaltender Brett Young is 0-4 with a 4.54 goals against average and .875 save percentage. Freshman Aaron Brickman is 0-0 with a 9.54 goals against average and .750 save percentage.

Trine is 2-for-22 (9.1 percent) on the power play and is 28-for-37 (75.7 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Bulldogs:

Adrian enters Friday's game at Finlandia with a 2-0 record overall and in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Bulldogs, ranked No. 2 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, won 5-1 at Lawrence and won 5-0 at Marian

Senior forward Kyle Brothers leads the Bulldogs in scoring with two goals and three assists for five points. Senior forwards Taylor McCloy and Austin Rust each have two goals and one assist for three points. Junior defenseman Cory Dunn and sophomore forward Dino Balsamo each have three assists for three points.

Junior goaltender Kevin Entmaa is 2-0 with a 0.50 goals against average and .972 save percentage.

Adrian is 3-for-11 (27.3 percent) on the power play and is 6-for-6 (100.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 531-137-52 in his 25th season. Coghlin is in 21st place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches in all divisions.

Coghlin is three wins ahead of current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin, who currently has a record of 528-390-86.

Retired Minnesota State-Mankato coach Don Brose is 20th all-time with a career record of 536-335-79 from 1970-2000. Retired Army coach Jack Riley and retired Bowdoin coach Terry Meagher are tied for 18th all-time with 542 wins apiece.

Coghlin earned his 500 career wins in just 680 games. That mark is the third-fastest to 500 wins in NCAA hockey history. Only UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli (658 games) and Bemidji State's Bob Peters (677 games) have reached 500 games more quickly. According to research by the St. Norbert sports information office, no other NCAA hockey coaches have ever reached 500 wins in less than 700 games.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 231-30-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 211-22-9 in its last 242 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 16-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 222-25-11 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 310-52-18 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Only two visiting teams have won at least two games at the Cornerstone Community Center in the same season. Superior won three times in 2001-02 and UW-Eau Claire won twice in 2012-13. Both of those teams went on to win the NCAA Division III national championship.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 287 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 325 of 331 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 287-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 88 weeks - surpassing Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 116-23-8 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 130-52-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 4-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 7-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 278-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 296-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 24-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 290-1-7 over their last 298 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007, a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008 and a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 27 times in their last 465 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 719-game tenure.
