Fierce rivals for the last two decades, St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stevens Point by a 47-21-6 margin in a series begun in the 1991-92 season. St. Norbert is 47-13-3 in the last 63 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 29-5-2 in the last 36 games in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 533-138-52 in his 25th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 388-68-35 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's eight NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

UW-Eau Claire coach Matt Loen (UW-Eau Claire, 1995) is 158-102-24 in his 11th season in Eau Claire.

UW-Stevens Point coach Tyler Krueger (UW-Stevens Point, 2014) is 5-1 in his first season in Stevens Point.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert topped UW-Eau Claire 3-2 on Nov. 18, 2014 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. Cullen Bradshaw's goal with 25 seconds left was the game-winning score. Erik Cooper and Tanner Froese also scored for St. Norbert, while R.J. Majkozak and Jake Hopfner scored for the Blugolds. David Jacobson made 13 saves for the Green Knights, while Jay Deo made 27 stops for Eau Claire.

St. Norbert defeated UW-Stevens Point 5-3 on Nov. 19, 2016 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. The Green Knights scored three first-period goals to take a 3-1 lead. Jeremy Olynyk and Brad Pung each had one goal and one assist for the Green Knights. Jono Davis had one goal and one assist for the Pointers, who got 22 saves in goal from Jesse Gordichuk. T.J. Black made 14 saves for the Green Knights.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend 4-0 overall and in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights, ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, defeated Trine 3-0 and No. 2-ranked Adrian 4-3 in overtime this past weekend in De Pere.

Senior forward Tanner Froese tops the Green Knights in scoring with one goal and seven assists for eight points. Freshman forward Peter Bates has two goals and five assists for seven points, while junior forward Riley Christensen has seven assists for seven points. Junior forward Brad Pung has four goals for four points. Freshman forward Keegan Milligan has two goals and two assists for four points, while sophomore forward Dominick Sacco has one goal and three assists for four points.

Junior goaltender T.J. Black is 4-0 with a 1.48 goals against average and .933 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 9-for-24 (37.5 percent) on the power play and is 19-for-21 (90.5 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Blugolds:

UW-Eau Claire enters the weekend with a 4-2 overall record. The Blugolds, ranked No. 14 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, lost 5-3 at St. Thomas last Thursday before defeating St. Mary's 5-4 on Saturday.

Senior Jesse Tredinnick has five goals and two assists for seven points to top Eau Claire in scoring. Sophomore forward Jake Bresser and senior forward Jake Hopfner each have four goals and one assist for five points. Sophomore forward Alex Strand has three goals and two assists for five points, while senior forward Colton Wolter has five assists for five points.

Freshman goaltender Camden Haugenoe is 4-2 with a 2.33 goals against average and .899 save percentage.

Eau Claire is 6-for-29 (20.7 percent) on the power play and is 38-for-43 (88.4 percent) on the penalty

kill this season.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters Friday's game with Marian at 5-1 overall. The Pointers, ranked No. 5 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, beat St. Mary's 7-2 and St. Thomas 2-1 in overtime last weekend in Minnesota.

Stevens Point is led by junior forward Tanner Karty, who has six goals and six assists for 12 points. Sophomore forward Logan Fredericks has one goal and seven assists for eight points. Freshman forward Luke McElhenie has four goals and two assists for six points, while freshman forward Carter Roo has two goals and two assists for four points.

Senior goaltender Max Milosek is 3-1 with a 1.50 goals against average and .935 save percentage. Freshman Connor Ryckman is 2-0 with a 2.50 goals against average and .896 save percentage.

Stevens Point is 6-for-39 (15.4 percent) on the power play and is 33-for-39 (84.6 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

WIAC Wisdom:

St. Norbert will face its only two Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference opponents of the regular season this weekend when it travels to UW-Eau Claire and UW-Stevens Point.

Since the 2002-03 season, the first year the Green Knights advanced to the NCAA Division III Frozen Four, St. Norbert is 137-24-17 against the WIAC schools. In program history, St. Norbert is 212-77-29 all-time against the WIAC.

Since 2002-03, St. Norbert is 32-5-2 against UW-Stevens Point, 33-4-2 against UW-Eau Claire, 26-5-1 against UW-River Falls, 22-5-3 against UW-Stout and 23-5-8 against UW-Superior.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 533-137-52 in his 25th season. Coghlin is in 21st place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches in

all divisions.

Coghlin is four wins ahead of current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin, who currently has a record of 529-391-86.

Retired Minnesota State-Mankato coach Don Brose is 20th all-time with a career record of 536-335-79 from 1970-2000. Retired Army coach Jack Riley and retired Bowdoin coach Terry Meagher are tied for 18th all-time with 542 wins apiece.

Coghlin earned his 500 career wins in just 680 games. That mark is the third-fastest to 500 wins in NCAA hockey history. Only UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli (658 games) and Bemidji State's Bob Peters (677 games) have reached 500 games more quickly. According to research by the St. Norbert sports information office, no other NCAA hockey coaches have ever reached 500 wins in less than 700 games.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 288 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 326 of 332 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 288-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 89 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 118-23-8 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 131-52-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 4-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert has a 76-game unbeaten streak when leading after two periods, going 74-0-2 since the semester break of the 2013-14 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 279-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 297-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 24-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 290-1-7 over their last 298 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007, a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008 and a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 27 times in their last 467 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 721-game tenure.
