The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 42-1-1 lead in the all-time series with Lawrence. The two schools met four times a season from 1988-89 to Tim Coghlin's first year in 1993-94, and have met 20 times since the 1994-95 season.

St. Norbert leads Marian 23-1-2 in a series which began in the 1996-97 season.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 536-138-53 in his 25th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 391-68-36 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's eight NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Lawrence coach Mike Szkodzinski (St. Norbert, 2000) is 115-168-25 in his 12th season in Appleton.

Marian coach Zach Gaynor (Marian, 2008) is 5-2-1 in his first season in Fond du Lac.

Last Season:

St. Norbert took three points from Lawrence last season. The two teams skated to a 1-1 tie on Dec. 2, 2016 in Appleton before the Green Knights countered with a 2-1 win the next night in De Pere. Nick Felan's goal for the Vikings late in the third period forced the tie in the opener, while Brad Pung's third-period marker in the second game was the game-winner for the Green Knights.

St. Norbert swept Marian last season in a home-and-home series on Oct. 28-29, 2016. The Green Knights won the opener 6-0 at home, with six different skaters scoring goals. St. Norbert won in Fond du Lac the next night 7-0, powered by five third-period goals.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend with a 7-0-1 overall record and a 4-0 mark in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green

Knights, ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Division III and D3hockey.com polls, faced Manhattanville at home last weekend, tying 1-1 before winning 2-1 in overtime in De Pere.

Senior forward Tanner Froese tops the Green Knights in scoring with three goals and seven assists for 10 points. Junior forward Riley Christensen has nine assists for nine points. Freshman forward Keegan Milligan has three goals and four assists for seven points, while freshman forward Peter Bates has two goals and five assists for seven points. Junior forward Brad Pung has four goals and one assist for five points, while junior forward Roman Uchyn has three goals and two assists for five points.

Junior goaltender T.J. Black is 7-0-1 with a 1.34 goals against average and .949 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 12-for-39 (30.8 percent) on the power play and is 27-for-30 (90.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the game with a 3-5 overall record and a 2-2 mark in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Vikings are coming off a runner-up finish this past weekend at the Primelink Great Northern Shootout in Middlebury, Vt., defeating Middlebury 6-3 before losing to Plattsburgh State 4-2 in the tournament's championship game.

Junior forward Josh Koepplinger leads the Vikings in scoring at four goals and seven assists for 11 points. Senior forward Lane King and junior forward Nick Felan each have four goals and six assists for 10 points. Senior defenseman Austin Frank has one goal and six assists for seven points.

Sophomore goaltender Evan Cline is 3-4 with a 3.51 goals against average and .891 save percentage. Junior Greg Procopio is 0-1 with a 4.47 goals against average and .839 save percentage.

Lawrence is 9-for-47 (19.1 percent) on the power play and is 37-for-47 (78.7 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Sabres:

Marian enters Friday's game with Finlandia 5-2-1 overall and 2-2 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Sabres, 4-0-1 in their last five games, tied St. John's 3-3 and beat Bethel 2-0 at home this past weekend.

Senior forward Derek Thorogood has seven goals and five assists for 12 points. Senior forward Hunter Stewart has two goals and six assists for eight points. Senior defenseman Gianni Mangone has three goals and four assists for seven points, while junior forward Nick Monfils has seven assists for seven points.

Sophomore goaltender Hunter Vorva is 5-2-1 with a 2.11 goals against average and .922 save percentage.

Marian is 8-for-33 (24.2 percent) on the power play and is 26-for-29 (89.7 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Overtime Observations:

St. Norbert's 2-1 overtime win over Manhattanville this past Saturday was the Green Knights' second win in extra time this young season. The Green Knights beat Adrian 4-3 in overtime on Nov. 11.

The Manhattanville series also marked the first time in school history both games in a two-game weekend series against the same opponent went to overtime. It was only the fifth time ever both games in a weekend went to overtime, regardless of opponent.

This season marks the fourth time the Green Knights have won at least two overtime games in one year. St. Norbert won a record four overtime games in 2007-08. The Green Knights won two each in 1995-96 and in 2013-14 as well as this season. The 2008 and 2014 seasons were national championship years.

St. Norbert is now 23-12-47 all-time in overtime games. The Green Knights have won eight consecutive overtime games not ending in a tie, going back to a 4-3 overtime loss to UW-River Falls on Jan. 27, 2012.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the

USCHO.com Division III Poll for 290 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 328 of 334 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 290-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 91 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 121-23-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 133-52-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 4-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 536-137-53 in his 25th season. Coghlin is tied for 20th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches in all divisions, deadlocked with retired Minnesota State-Mankato coach Don Brose, who had a career record of 536-335-79 from 1970-2000.

Coghlin is six wins ahead of current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin, who currently has a record of 530-392-86.

Retired Army coach Jack Riley and retired Bowdoin coach Terry Meagher are tied for 18th all-time with 542 wins apiece.

Coghlin earned his 500 career wins in just 680 games. That mark is the third-fastest to 500 wins in NCAA hockey history. Only UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli (658 games) and Bemidji State's Bob Peters (677 games) have reached 500 games more quickly. According to research by the St. Norbert sports information office, no other NCAA hockey coaches have ever reached 500 wins in less than 700 games.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert has a 78-game unbeaten streak when leading after two

periods, going 76-0-2 since the semester break of the 2013-14 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 279-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 297-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 24-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 290-1-7 over their last 298 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007, a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008 and a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 27 times in their last 469 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 725-game tenure.
