The Series:

St. Norbert leads MSOE in the all-time series 13-2, which began with a 4-2 Green Knights' win on Jan. 7, 2006 in Milwaukee.

St. Norbert has played Lake Forest 73 times, and holds a 48-21-4 advantage in a series begun in the 1988-89 season. Lake Forest won the first 14 games in the series, with St. Norbert posting a 48-7-5 ledger since.

St. Norbert leads Aurora 4-0 in an all-time series begun in the 2015-16 season.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 540-138-53 in his 25th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 395-68-36 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's eight NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

MSOE coach Mark Ostapina (Wisconsin, 1979) is 246-183-22 in his 17th season in Milwaukee. Including six seasons at New England College, Ostapina is 309-267-30 in 23 seasons.

Lake Forest coach Patrick Kelliher (St. Lawrence, 2010) is 48-38-5 in his fourth season in Lake Forest.

Aurora coach Jason Bloomingburg (Wayne State, 2006) is 6-26-6 in his second season in Aurora.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the week 11-0-1 overall and 6-0 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights, ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Division III and D3hockey.com polls, have been idle since Dec. 8-9, when they swept Augsburg 3-1 and 4-0.

Senior forward Tanner Froese has a team-high five goals and eight assists for 13 points, while junior forward Riley Christensen has three goals and a team-high 10 assists for

13 points. Freshman forward Keegan Milligan has four goals and six assists for 10 points. Freshman forward Peter Bates has three goals and five assists for eight points, while sophomore forward Dominick Sacco has two goals and six assists for eight points.

Junior goaltender T.J. Black is 11-0-1 with a 1.23 goals against average and .954 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 16-for-67 (23.9 percent) on the power play and is 43-for-50 (86.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Raiders:

MSOE enters the game with a 7-4-1 overall record. The Raiders have lost three of their last four games following a 6-1-1 start, including a 3-0 decision to Marian Friday and a 4-3 overtime loss to Concordia-Moorhead Saturday at the Superior Shootout.

Freshman forward Garrett Gintoli paces the Raiders with three goals and six assists for nine points. Senior forward James Ring has one goal and eight assists for nine points, while senior forward Brett Wagner has four goals and four assists for eight points. Senior defenseman Zach Simpson has four goals and three assists for seven points.

Senior goaltender Zach Woodman is 5-2 with a 1.71 goals against average and .942 save percentage. Freshman Rock Boynton is 2-2-1 with a 2.52 goals against average and .914 save percentage.

MSOE is 10-for-54 (18.5 percent) on the power play and is 60-for-71 (84.5 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters the game 7-6 overall and 4-2 in the NCHA. The Foresters were swept out east this past weekend with a 4-1 loss at Babson Saturday and a 4-2 loss at Curry Sunday.

Senior forward George Gerasimou leads the Foresters in scoring with four goals and 10 assists for 14 points. Senior forward Billy Kent has three goals and nine assists for 12 points, while fresh-

man forward Joe Sardina has a team-high seven goals and three assists for 10 points. Junior forward Cody Guidorzi has four goals and four assists for eight points.

Junior goaltender Louis-Philippe De Courcy is 5-3 with a 1.62 goals against average and .937 save percentage. Junior George Argiropoulos is 2-2 with a 3.03 goals against average and .867 save percentage.

Lake Forest is 11-for-81 (13.6 percent) on the power play and is 45-for-48 (93.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Spartans:

Aurora enters Friday's game with Finlandia 2-7-4 overall and 1-4-1 in the NCHA. The Spartans picked up a pair of 3-3 ties at home against Gustavus Adolphus this past weekend.

Freshman defenseman Tim Faulkner has three goals and four assists for seven points, while freshman defenseman Nick Minerva has two goals and five assists for seven points. Freshman forward Rihards Marenis, senior defenseman Tony Pnewski and sophomore forward Liam Stirtzinger all have two goals and four assists for six points.

Freshman goaltender Josh Boyko is 2-4-2 with a 3.69 goals against average and .881 save percentage. Freshman Jake Gwillim is 0-3-2 with a 3.23 goals against average and .900 save percentage.

Aurora is 6-for-77 (7.8 percent) on the power play and is 50-for-66 (75.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Fast Starts:

St. Norbert's 11-0-1 start to the 2017-18 season matches its longest stretch of games to go unbeaten to open a season.

The Green Knights also went 12 games without a loss to open a season in 2003-04, going 11-0-1 out of the gate.

St. Norbert opened the 2002-03 season with a 10-0 mark - the most wins to open a season without a blemish. St. Norbert has started 9-0-1 four additional times - in 2003-04, 2006-07, 2009-10 and 2014-15. The Green Knights went on to start 11-0-

1 in 2003-04 and started 10-0-1 in 2006-07 and 2014-15.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 292 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 330 of 336 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 292-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 93 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 125-23-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 135-52-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 4-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

St. Norbert is 6-0 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll this season.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 540-138-53 in his 25th season. Coghlin in 20th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches in all divisions.

Coghlin is two wins shy of moving into a tie for 18th place. Retired Army coach Jack Riley and retired Bowdoin coach Terry Meagher are tied for 18th all-time with 542 wins apiece.

Coghlin is also only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

St. Norbert has an 80-game unbeaten streak when leading after

two periods, going 78-0-2 since the semester break of the 2013-14 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 280-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 298-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 24-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 290-1-7 over their last 298 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007, a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008 and a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 27 times in their last 473 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 731-game tenure.
