year in 1993-94, and have met 21 times since the 1994-95 season.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 542-139-53 in his 25th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 397-69-36 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's eight NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Marian coach Zach Gaynor (Marian, 2008) is 10-3-1 in his first season in Fond du Lac.

Lawrence coach Mike Szkodzinski (St. Norbert, 2000) is 118-170-26 in his 12th season in Appleton.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert beat Marian 4-1 on Dec. 2, 2017 at Blue Line Family Ice Center in Fond du Lac. Roman Uchyn, Kurt Black, Dominick Sacco and Tanner Froese all scored for the Green Knights, while Curtis Lewington scored for the Sabres. T.J. Black made 27 saves for the Green Knights, who were 3-for-10 on the power play. Hunter Vorva made 31 stops for Marian.

St. Norbert defeated Lawrence 3-2 on Dec. 1, 2017 at Appleton Family Ice Center in Appleton. Riley Christensen, Timmy Nicksic and William Yates scored for St. Norbert, while Lane King and Nick Felan scored for the Vikings. T.J. Black made 15 saves for the Green Knights, while Evan Cline made 31 stops for Lawrence.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend 13-1-1 overall and 8-0 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights, ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Division III and D3hockey.com polls, topped Lake Forest 7-0 and Aurora 5-3 this past weekend in a return to action in the NCHA.

Freshman forward Keegan Milligan has moved into a share of the team scoring lead with eight goals and seven assists for 15 points. Senior forward Tanner Froese has six goals and nine assists for 15 points. Junior forward Riley Christensen has three goals and 11 assists for 14 points, while junior forward Roman Uchyn has five goals and six assists for 11 points. Freshman forward Peter Bates has four goals and six assists for 10 points, while sophomore forward Dominick Sacco has three goals and seven assists for 10 points.

Junior goaltender T.J. Black is 13-1-1 with a 1.33 goals against average and .947 save percentage. Freshman Ryan Bontorin is 0-0 with a 0.00 goals against average and 1.000 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 22-for-84 (26.2 percent) on the power play and is 58for-65 (89.2 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Sabres:

Marian enters the game with a 10-3-1 overall record and a 5-3 ledger in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Sabres, who are 9-1-1 in their last 11 games, beat Concordia 4-1 on Friday and MSOE 3-1 on Saturday.

Senior forward Hunter Stewart leads Marian in scoring with nine goals and 11 assists for 20 points, while senior forward Derek Thorogood has eight goals and 12 assists for 20 points. Junior forward Nick Monfils has two goals and 12 assists for 14 points, while senior defenseman Gianni Mangone has four goals and six assists for 10 points.

Sophomore goaltender Hunter Vorva is 10-3-1 this season with a 1.78 goals against average and .930 save percentage.

Marian is 13-for-58 (22.4 percent) on the power play and is 50-for-58 (86.2 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Foresters:

Lawrence enters Friday's game at Finlandia 6-8-1 overall and 4-4 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Vikings beat MSOE 3-1 on Friday before falling 4-3 in overtime at Concordia on Saturday.

Senior forward Lane King leads the Vikings in scoring with 10 goals and 13 assists for 23 points. Junior forward Josh Koepplinger has 12 goals and nine assists for 21 points. Junior forward Nick Felan has five goals and 12 assists for 17 points, while senior defenseman Austin Frank has one goal and 11 assists for 12 points.

Sophomore goaltender Evan Cline is 6-7-1 with a 2.98 goals against average and .918 save percentage. Junior Greg Procopio is 0-1 with a 4.47 goals against average and .839 save percentage.

Lawrence is 17-for-71 (23.9 percent) on the power play and is 68for-81 (84.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 236-30-13 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 216-22-10 in its last 248 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the secondlongest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 16-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 227-25-12 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 315-52-19 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 294 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 332 of 338 polls conducted since its incep-

tion at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 294-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 95 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 127-24-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 135-52-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 4-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

St. Norbert is 6-0 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll this season.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 542-139-53 in his 25th season. Coghlin is tied for 18th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches in all divisions.

Coghlin's 542 wins matches retired Army coach Jack Riley and retired Bowdoin coach Terry Meagher for 18th all-time with 542 wins apiece.

Coghlin is 13 wins shy of 17th place, trailing legendary Michigan Tech coach John MacInnes' 555-295-39 mark from 1957-82.

Coghlin is also only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert has an 81-game unbeaten streak when leading after two periods, going 79-0-2 since the semester break of the 2013-14 season.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 298-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 26-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 292-1-7 over their last 300 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007, a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008 and a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 27 times in their last 476 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 734-game tenure.
