St. Norbert is 54-14-4 all-time against St. Scholastica in a series begun during the 1991-92 season. St. Norbert holds a 18-8-2 series edge in its last 28 meetings with the Saints.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 566-146-56 in his 26th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 422-77-39 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Northland coach Seamus Gregory (St. Thomas-Ontario, 2001) is 37-67-14 in his sixth season in Ashland.

St. Scholastica coach Tim Madsen (Niagara, 2007) is 9-7-1 in his first season in Duluth.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert dropped Northland 5-0 on Feb. 3, 2018 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. Kurt Black, Tanner Froese, Riley Christensen, Brad Pung and Steven Mather all scored goals for the Green Knights. T.J. Black made 12 saves for the Green Knights, while A.J. Smith made 28 stops for the Lumberjacks.

St. Norbert defeated St. Scholastica 4-1 on Feb. 2, 2018 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. The Green Knights snapped a 1-1 tie after two periods with third-period markers from Steven Phillips, Kurt Black and Sean Campbell. T.J. Black made 14 saves for St. Norbert, while Zane Steeves turned away 40 shots for the Saints.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert comes into the weekend 10-4-3 overall and 6-3-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights lost at Marian 3-1 on Friday before defeating Lawrence 4-1 on Saturday. Senior forward Riley Christensen holds the team scoring lead with nine goals and seven assists for 16 points. Junior forward Dominick Sacco and senior forward Roman Uchyn each have seven goals and seven assists for 14 points. Sophomore forward Peter Bates has four goals and nine assists for 13 points, while sophomore defenseman Luke Davison has one goal and 11 assists for 12 points.

Senior goaltender T.J. Black is 9-4-2 with a 1.57 goals against average and .932 save percentage. Sophomore Ryan Bontorin is 1-0-1 with a 1.92 goals against average and .942 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 14-for-71 (19.7 percent) on the power play and is 50for-58 (86.2 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Lumberjacks:

Northland enters the weekend with a 7-8-2 overall record and a 5-3-2 mark in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Lumberjacks defeated Milwaukee School of Engineering 7-2 on Friday before falling 4-3 in overtime at Concordia Wisconsin on Saturday.

Junior forward Kalib Ford leads the Lumberjacks in scoring with five goals and 13 assists for 19 points. Freshman forward Zackary Fisher has seven goals and 10 assists for 17 points, while senior forward Lucas DeBenedet has eight goals and seven assists for 15 points. Freshman forward Cole Woodliffe has seven goals and five assists for 12 points.

Senior goaltender David Krejcik owns a 7-6-2 record with a 2.92 goals against average and .914 save percentage.

Northland is 14-for-66 (21.2 percent) on the power play and is 54for-67 (80.6 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Saints:

St. Scholastica heads into Friday's game at Finlandia with a 9-7-1 overall record and 4-5-1 ledger in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Saints have lost six of their last seven games, including a 4-2 loss at

Concordia Wisconsin Friday and a 6-3 setback at Milwaukee School of Engineering Saturday.

Senior forward Cole Golka leads the Saints in scoring with nine goals and eight assists for 17 points. Sophomore defenseman Jordan Fralich has one goal and 15 assists for 16 points. Sophomore forward Carson Rose has eight goals and six assists for 14 points, while sophomore forward Nate Pionk has five goals and nine assists for 14 points.

Sophomore goaltender Nick Trenciansky is 8-4-1 with a 2.47 goals against average and .922 save percentage. Junior Zane Steeves is 1-1 with a 2.43 goals against average and .931 save percentage.

St. Scholastica is 18-for-76 (23.7 percent) on the power play and is 64-for-81 (79.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Roster Report:

St. Norbert has added freshman defenseman Keenan Spillum to the roster. He is a transfer from Colorado College, but did not see any game action with the Tigers earlier this season.

Spillum, a 6-foot-3, 190-pound Phoenix, Ariz., native, played with the NAHL's Aberdeen Wings last season. An assistant captain, he posted four goals and 13 assists in 54 games. He played earlier with the NAHL's Corpus Christi Ice Rays.

Spillum is eligible to play starting with Friday's game against Northland.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 252-30-15 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 232-22-12 in its last 266 games at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights are currently on a 33-game unbeaten streak at home, going 30-0-3 since a 4-2 loss to Concordia-Wis., on Jan. 27, 2017.

The Green Knights had a 25game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 331-52-21 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 313 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 351 of 357 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 313-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 142-55-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 5-6-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 566-145-57 in his 26th season. Coghlin is in 17th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Coghlin is 11 wins shy of moving into 16th place. UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli was 577-224-43 in 32 seasons (1985-2016) with the Corsairs.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Tough After Two:

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 294-2-4 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 312-3-5 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 37-1 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 303-2-7 over their last 312 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-30-6 in its last 42 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 29 times in their last 509 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 768-game tenure.
