games in the series have been overtime contests, with each team winning twice.

St. Norbert leads Trine 3-0 in an all-time series that began during the 2017-18 season.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 568-146-56 in his 26th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 424-77-39 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Adrian coach Adam Krug (Adrian, 2012) is 105-26-7 in his fifth season in Adrian.

Trine coach Alex Todd (Union, 2001) is 14-26-4 in his second season in Angola. He was 114-78-21 in eight seasons at Castleton State to give him a career record of 128-104-25.

Last Meetings:

Adrian tipped St. Norbert 4-3 in overtime on Nov. 10, 2018 at Arrington Ice Arena in Adrian, Mich. The Green Knights led 3-0 after two periods before the Bulldogs rallied. Dominick Sacco scored two goals for St. Norbert, while Bryan Yim scored an extra-attacker goal and the overtime game-winning marker for Adrian. T.J. Black made 30 saves for the Green Knights while Kevin Entmaa made 28 stops for the Bulldogs.

St. Norbert blanked Trine 4-0 on Nov. 9, 2018 at Thunder Ice Arena in Angola, Ind. Riley Christensen registered a natural hat trick while Peter Bates added the other goal. T.J. Black made 16 saves for the Green Knights, while Brett Young made 34 stops for the Thunder.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend with a 12-4-3 overall record and an 8-3-1 mark in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights are coming off a decisive weekend sweep with a 7-0

win over Northland and a 7-2 triumph over St. Scholastica.

Senior forward Riley Christensen has 10 goals and nine assists for 19 points, while senior forward Roman Uchyn has eight goals and 10 assists for 18 points. Junior forward Dominick Sacco has eight goals and eight assists for 16 points. Sophomore forward Peter Bates has five goals and 11 assists for 16 points, while freshman defenseman Brendon Gysbers has three goals and a team-high 13 assists for 16 points.

Senior goaltender T.J. Black is 11-4-2 with a 1.50 goals against average and .933 save percentage. Sophomore Ryan Bontorin is 1-0-1 with a 1.92 goals against average and .942 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 20-for-81 (24.7 percent) on the power play and is 57-for-66 (86.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Bulldogs:

Adrian enters the weekend 13-5-1 overall and 8-3-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Bulldogs swept a pair of home games this past weekend with a 3-1 win over Milwaukee School of Engineering and a 5-3 win over Concordia Wisconsin.

Junior forward Dino Balsamo has seven goals and 12 assists for 19 points, while senior defenseman Cory Dunn has five goals and 14 assists for 19 points. Senior forward Bryan Yim has 12 goals and six assists for 18 points, while senior forward Trevor Boyd has 11 goals and seven assists for 18 points. Senior forward Connor Armour has four goals and 13 assists for 17 points.

Senior goaltender Kevin Entmaa is 10-4-1 with a 2.13 goals against average and .908 save percentage. Sophomore Nikita Babintsev is 3-0 with a 1.05 goals against average and .948 save percentage.

Adrian is 26-for-103 (25.2 percent) on the power play and is 83-for-95 (87.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Thunder:

Trine enters Friday's game at Finlandia with an 8-9-2 overall

record and a 4-7-1 showing in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Thunder took three points at home last weekend, tying Concordia Wisconsin 3-3 before defeating Milwaukee School of Engineering 4-1.

Freshman forward Garrett Hallford leads the Thunder in scoring with 11 goals and eight assists for 19 points. Sophomore defenseman Blake Robertson has eight goals and three assists for 11 points, while freshman forward Jon Doyle has two goals and nine assists for 11 points. Freshman forward Gianni Vitali has four goals and five assists for nine points.

Junior goaltender Brett Young is 8-9-2 with a 2.48 goals against average and .914 save percentage.

Trine is 16-for-87 (18.4 percent) on the power play and is 64-for-82 (78.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Goals Galore:

St. Norbert pumped in 14 goals in its series this past weekend, scoring seven apiece in wins over Northland (7-0) and St. Scholastica (7-2).

The Green Knights have moved into the NCHA scoring lead with 73 goals. Adrian's 69 goals the closest. Lake Forest is the only other team with more than 60 goals, totaling 61.

St. Norbert last scored at least seven goals in both games of a weekend series on Jan. 15-16, 2016, when it defeated Finlandia 7-1 and 8-0.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 254-30-15 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, going 234-22-12 in its last 268 games there.

The Green Knights are currently on a 35-game unbeaten streak at home, going 32-0-3 since a 4-2 loss to Concordia-Wis., on Jan. 27, 2017.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a

36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 333-52-21 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 314 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 352 of 358 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 314-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 142-55-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 5-6-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 568-145-57 in his 26th season. Coghlin is in 17th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Coghlin is nine wins shy of moving into 16th place. UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli was 577-224-43 in 32 seasons (1985-2016) with the Corsairs.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the

Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Tough After Two:

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 296-2-4 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 314-3-5 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 39-1 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 305-2-7 over their last 314 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-30-6 in its last 42 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 29 times in their last 511 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 770-game tenure.
