The Green Knights have won seven of the last nine NCHA post-season titles as well as 12 of the last 16. The winner of the game will receive an automatic berth into the NCAA Division III Tournament.

England College 8, Amherst 1, Manhattanville 1, Williams 1. 2009-10 season. The two teams have split the last 16 meetings in the series after the Green Knights won the first three games. It is the fifth consecutive meeting between the two programs in the NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs Championship Game.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 577-146-56 in his 26th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 433-77-39 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Adrian coach Adam Krug (Adrian, 2012) is 112-28-7 in his fifth season in Adrian.

This Season:

Adrian tipped St. Norbert 4-3 in overtime on Nov. 10, 2018 at Arrington Ice Arena in Adrian, Mich. The Green Knights led 3-0 after two periods before the Bulldogs rallied. Dominick Sacco scored two goals for St. Norbert, while Bryan Yim scored an extraattacker goal and the overtime game-winning marker for Adrian. T.J. Black made 30 saves for the Green Knights while Kevin Entmaa made 28 stops for the Bulldogs.

St. Norbert blanked Adrian 7-0 on Jan. 25, 2019 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. It was the first shutout for either team in the series. St. Norbert broke open a 2-0 game with five thirdperiod goals. Kurt Black, Timmy Nicksic and Peyton Frantti all had two goals apiece for the Green Knights. T.J. Black made 22 saves for St. Norbert, while Nikita Babintsev made 31 stops for the Bulldogs.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 21-4-3 overall. The Green Knights, ranked No. 3 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, advanced to the NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs championship game with a 6-2 win over Marian in a semifinal game this past Saturday.

Senior forwards Rilev Christensen has 12 goals and 19 assists for a team-high 31 points. Sophomore forward Peter Bates has 10 goals and 20 assists for 30 points. while senior forward Roman Uchyn has a 13 goals with 15 assists for 28 points. Junior forward Dominick Sacco has 11 goals and 16 assists for 27 points. Freshman defenseman Brendon Gysbers has four goals and a team-high 22 assists for 26 points, while freshman forward Peyton Frantti has a team-high 14 goals with 11 assists for 25 points.

Senior goaltender T.J. Black is 20-4-2 with a 1.63 goals against average and .928 save percentage. Sophomore Ryan Bontorin is 1-0-1 with a 1.54 goals against average and .949 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 39-for-141 (27.7 percent) on the power play and is 78for-92 (84.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Bulldogs:

Adrian enters the game 20-7-1 overall. The Bulldogs advanced to the NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs championship game with a 5-1 semifinal win over Lake Forest this past Saturday.

Senior defenseman Cory Dunn leads the Bulldogs in scoring with five goals and 26 assists for 31 points. Junior forward Dino Balsamo has 13 goals and 15 assists for 28 points, while senior defenseman Braden Hellems has 11 goals and 16 assists for 27 points. Senior forward Connor Armour has four goals and 20 assists for 24 points, while senior forward Bryan Yim has a team-high 15 goals with eight assists for 23 points.

Senior goaltender Kevin Entmaa is 16-5-1 with a 2.00 goals against average and .908 save percentage. Sophomore Nikita Babintsev is 3-1 with a 2.15 goals against average and .915 save percentage. Adrian is 34-for-145 (23.4 percent) on the power play and is 117-for-133 (88.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Power Play Patter:

St. Norbert is currently second nationally in Division III in powerplay percentage at 27.7 percent (39for-141).

The Green Knights trail only Geneseo State's 28.5 percent (37-for-130). St. Norbert's last power-play unit this efficient was in 2012-13 when it finished at 27.8 percent. The Green Knights have not been north of 28 percent on the power play since a slick 32.1 percent in 2003-04.

During St. Norbert's current 12game winning streak, the Green Knights are 26-for-73 (35.6 percent) on the power play. Seven of the 12 games have multiple power-play goals.

Iron Man:

St. Norbert senior forward Steven Phillips enters the championship of the NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs never having missed a game in his career.

Phillips has skated in all 120 games played during his career with the Green Knights, tallying 32 goals and 37 assists for 69 points.

Phillips' streak longest consecutive games played mark in NCAA Division III history, according to the NCAA Ice Hockey Record Book. Norwich's Travis Janke previously held the Division III record with 119 consecutive games played from 2011-14.

Phillips' set the new St. Norbert record earlier this season, surpassing the old mark of 109 set by Steven Sleep from 2005-09.

Cup Clamor:

St. Norbert attempts to capture its 15th NCHA Playoffs championship when it continues play in the Harris Cup Playoffs this weekend.

The Green Knights are 74-14-1 alltime in the NCHA Playoffs, and are 70-7 at home all-time in the tournament. St. Norbert is 4-7-1 on the road.

St. Norbert has won its last 25 rounds at home in the NCHA Playoffs, which includes 38 consecutive wins. The Green Knights' last home loss in the league post-season was a 3-2 overtime loss to UW-Superior in the 2006 NCHA Peters Cup Championship.

Since the 1996-97 season, St. Norbert has played just seven of its last 59 NCHA Playoff series/rounds on the road. Included in those seven are four trips to Adrian for the Harris Cup title the last four seasons. The Green Knights lost at Adrian in 2015 and 2016 before winning the Harris Cup there in 2017 and 2018.

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 23 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such record in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped in 2016 with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

St. Norbert has 21 20-win seasons under Coghlin's supervision, all coming in the last 23 years.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 260-30-15 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, going 240-22-12 in its last 274 games there.

The Green Knights are currently on a 41-game unbeaten streak at

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the secondlongest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 339-52-21 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 319 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 357 of 363 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 319-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 143-55-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 5-6-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 577-145-57 in his 26th season. Coghlin is tied for 16th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Coghlin is even with UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli, who was 577-224-43 in 32 seasons (1985-2016) with the Corsairs.

Residing in 15th place on the alltime list is George Gwozdecky, who

went 593-391-85 in 27 seasons at Denver, Miami and UW-River Falls from 1982 to 2013. New Hampshire's Dick Umile is in 14th place with a 594-375-114 record in 28 seasons from 1991 to 2018.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Tough After Two:

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 302-2-4 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 320-3-5 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 45-1 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 311-2-7 over their last 320 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 7-30-6 in its last 43 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a 6-5 win at St. Scholastica on Feb. 1, 2019.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 30 times in their last 520 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 779-game tenure.
