Game Overview:

St. Norbert and Augsburg meet in the NCAA Division III Tournament for the fourth consecutive season. The Green Knights won the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association Peters Cup and Harris Cup titles, while the Auggies claimed the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference regular-season and playoff titles. The winner advances to a NCAA Division III quarterfinal game on Saturday, March 16 at UW-Stevens Point.

The Series:

Augsburg leads St. Norbert 11-10-2 in an all-time series begun during the 1988-89 season. The Green Knights are 9-2-2 against the Auggies since Tim Coghlin took over in 1993-94. St. Norbert is 3-0 all-time against Augsburg in the NCAA Tournament, with the Green Knights defeating the Auggies in national quarterfinal games in 2016, 2017 and 2018.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 578-146-56 in his 26th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 434-77-39 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Augsburg coach Chris Brown (UW-River Falls, 1994) is 174-140-29 in his 13th season in Minneapolis. He was 69-56-8 in five years combined at Marian and Hamline for a total record of 243-196-37.

This Season:

Augsburg earned a win and a tie over St. Norbert on Dec. 7-8 at Augsburg Ice Arena in Minneapolis.

The Auggies won the opener 6-5 in overtime when Alex Rodriguez scored at 1:29 of the extra session. St. Norbert rallied from a 5-2 deficit with goals from Logan Froberg, Timmy Nicksic and Dominick Sacco. Rodriguez had two goals for Augsburg. Nick Schmit made 38 saves for the Auggies, while T.J. Black made 26 stops for the Green Knights.

Luke Dietsch scored an Augsburg power-play goal at 12:06 of the third period to force a 3-3 tie in the second game. Riley Christensen, Roman Uchyn and Peter Bates all scored for the Green Knights. Dietsch had two goals for the Auggies, who got 35 saves from Schmit. Ryan Bontorin made 38 saves for St. Norbert.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 19th overall NCAA Division III Tournament appearance, all coming within in the last 23 seasons. The Green Knights are 31-13-1 all-time in NCAA competition, have reached 12 Frozen Fours, and have won 22 of their last 26 NCAA Tournament games. St. Norbert won national championships in 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 and was the national runner-up in 2004, 2006, 2010 and 2016. The Green Knights are just one of three programs in NCAA Division III history to have won consecutive national championships (UW-Stevens Point 1989-91 and Middlebury 1995-99 and 2004-06).

Augsburg is making its sixth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance. The Auggies, 4-7-1 all-time in the tournament, received bids in 1984, 1998, 2016, 2017 and 2018. Augsburg advanced to the Frozen Four in 1984 and 1998, placing fourth both times.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 22-4-3 overall. The Green Knights, ranked No. 3 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, won their 15th Northern Collegiate Hockey Association playoffs championship with a 4-1 win over Adrian this past Saturday.

Senior forward Riley Christensen has 13 goals and 19 assists for a team-high 32 points. Sophomore forward Peter Bates owns 11 goals and 20 assists for 31 points, while senior forward Roman Uchyn has 13 goals with 16 assists for 29 points. Junior forward Dominick Sacco has 11 goals and 16 assists for 27 points. Freshman defenseman Brendon Gysbers has four goals and a team-high 23 assists for 27 points, while freshman forward Peyton Frantti has a team-high 14 goals with 13 assists for 27 points.

Senior goaltender T.J. Black is 21-4-2 with a 1.60 goals against average and .930 save percentage. Sophomore Ryan Bontorin is 1-0-1 with a 1.54 goals against average and .949 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 40-for-145 (27.6 percent) on the power play and is 81-for-95 (85.3 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Auggies:

Augsburg enters the game with a 21-3-3 overall record. The Auggies won the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference playoffs championship game with a 2-1 triumph over St. John's in four overtimes this past Saturday in Minneapolis.

Senior forward Alex Rodriguez leads the Auggies in scoring with 21 goals and 18 assists for 39 points. Senior forward Chandler Madry has 10 goals and 21 assists for 31 points, while senior forward Luke Dietsch has 14 goals and 15 assists for 29 points. Sophomore forward Tommy Carey has nine goals and 16 assists for 25 points. Senior forward Eric Brenk has seven goals and 15 assists for 22 points.

Senior goaltender Nick Schmit is 16-2-3 with a 1.91 goals against average and .931 save percentage. Sophomore Daniil Gerasimov is 5-1 with a 2.25 goals against average and .915 save percentage.

Augsburg is 28-for-107 (26.2 percent) on the power play and is 79-for-91 (86.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Scoring Stuff:

St. Norbert has had three players on extended streaks of games scoring points.

Senior forward Riley Christensen and freshman forward Peyton Frantti have both scored in 12 of their last 13 games. Junior forward Kurt Black has scored in 10 of his last 11 games.

Frantti and Black both did not score in a 3-1 win over Finlandia on Feb. 8, while Christensen did not score in a 2-1 win over Finlandia on Feb. 15.

Power Play Patter:

St. Norbert is currently third nationally in Division III in power-play percentage at 27.6 percent (40-for-145).

The Green Knights trail only Geneseo State's 29.1 percent (39-for-134) and University of New England's 28.1 percent (38-for-135). St. Norbert's last power-play unit this efficient was in 2012-13 when it finished at 27.8 percent. The Green Knights have not been north of 28 percent on the power play since a slick 32.1 percent in 2003-04.

During St. Norbert's current 13-game winning streak, the Green Knights are 27-for-77 (35.1 percent) on the power play. Seven of the 13 games have multiple power-play goals.

Iron Man:

St. Norbert senior forward Steven Phillips enters the NCAA Division III Tournament never having missed a game in his career.

Phillips has skated in all 121 games played during his career with the Green Knights, tallying 32 goals and 38 assists for 70 points.

Phillips' streak longest consecutive games played mark in NCAA Division III history, according to the NCAA Ice Hockey Record Book. Norwich's Travis Janke previously held the Division III record with 119

Phillips is one game short of tying the St. Norbert record for career games with 122. Jason Deitsch (2002-05), Shane Dickson (1998-2001) and Rob Smillie (1996-99) currently share the career games played record.

MIAC Minutiae:

St. Norbert has a solid 90-12-8 record against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference competition since Tim Coghlin took over the Green Knights' helm in 1993. Two of the losses came in a sweep at St. Mary's in Coghlin's first year of 1993-94.

Since then, the Green Knights are 90-10-8 against the MIAC. St. Norbert is 14-2-2 in its last 18 games against the MIAC.

At home under Coghlin, St. Norbert is a remarkable 53-2-3 against MIAC foes. The losses came in a 3-2 defeat to St. Thomas in the 2005 NCAA Division III Tournament and to Gustavus Adolphus 4-2 on Nov. 3, 2007.

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 23 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such record in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped in 2016 with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

St. Norbert has 21 20-win seasons under Coghlin's supervision, all coming in the last 23 years.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 261-30-15 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, going 241-22-12 in its last 275 games there.

The Green Knights are currently on a 42-game unbeaten streak at home, going 39-0-3 since a 4-2 loss to Concordia-Wis., on Jan. 27, 2017.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 340-52-21 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 320 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 358 of

364 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 320-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 144-55-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 5-6-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 578-145-57 in his 26th season. Coghlin is in 16th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 & 2018 NCAA DIVISION III NATIONAL CHAMPIONS

With a 4-1 win over Adrian on March 2, Coghlin moved into 16th place past UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli, who was 577-224-43 in 32 seasons (1985-2016) with the Corsairs.

Residing in 15th place on the all-time list is George Gwozdecky, who went 593-391-85 in 27 seasons at Denver, Miami and UW-River Falls from 1982 to 2013. New Hampshire's Dick Umile is in 14th place with a 594-375-114 record in 28 seasons from 1991 to 2018.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Tough After Two:

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 303-2-4 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3

overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 321-3-5 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 45-1 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 311-2-7 over their last 320 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 7-30-6 in its last 43 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a 6-5 win at St. Scholastica on Feb. 1, 2019.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 30 times in their last 521 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 780-game tenure.
