St. Norbert College Green Knights Hockey Preview NCAA DIVISION III TOURNAMENT - QUARTERFINAL No. 3 St. Norbert College (23-4-3) at No. 1 UW-Stevens Point (26-0-2) Saturday, March 16, 2019 - 7 p.m.

Game Overview:

St. Norbert and UW-Stevens Point meet in the quarterfinal round of the NCAA Division III Tournament for the first time since 1998. St. Norbert enters with a 14-game winning streak, while the Pointers have won 20 consecutive games. The defending national champion Green Knights seek their 13th Frozen Four trip. The Pointers are pursuing their 11th Frozen Four appearance and are attempting to be the first team in NCAA Division III history to finish a season without a loss. The winner advances to the NCAA Division III Frozen Four on March 22-23 at an on-campus site to be announced Sunday by the NCAA.

The Series:

Fierce rivals for a quarter century, St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stevens Point by a 48-21-7 margin in a series begun in the 1991-92 season. St. Norbert is 48-13-4 in the last 65 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 30-5-3 in the last 38 games in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 579-146-56 in his 26th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 435-77-39 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

UW-Stevens Point coach Tyler Krueger (UW-Stevens Point, 2014) is 47-6-5 in his second season in Stevens Point.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert and UW-Stevens Point skated to a 1-1 tie on Nov. 17, 2018 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. In a scoreless game through two periods, Roman Uchyn put St. Norbert ahead at 1:06 of the third period. Stevens Point's Ryan Bittner tied the game at 12:13 of the period. The Green Knights outshot the Pointers 26-20. T.J. Black made 19 saves for St. Norbert, while Connor Ryckman made 25 stops for Stevens Point. The Green Knights were 0-for-6 on the power play, while the Pointers were 0-for-3.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 19th overall NCAA Division Tournament appearance, all coming within in the last 23 seasons. The Green Knights are 32-13-1 all-time in NCAA competition, have reached 12 Frozen Fours, and have won 23 of their last 27 NCAA Tournament games. St. Norbert won national championships in 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 and was the national runner-up in 2004, 2006, 2010 and 2016. The Green Knights are just one of three programs in NCAA Division III history to have won consecutive national championships (UW-Stevens Point 1989-91 and Middlebury 1995-99 and 2004-06).

UW-Stevens Point is making its 15th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance. The Pointers, who are 27-16-3 all-time in the tournament, won national titles in 1989, 1990, 1991, 1993 and 2016. Stevens Point has played in six consecutive NCAA Tournaments.

St. Norbert Hockey vs. No. 1

St. Norbert has played in 12 games in its history against the No. 1-ranked team in the USCHO.com Division III Poll since the rating was established at the start of the 1998-99 season. The Green Knights are 5-6-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 23-4-3 overall. The Green Knights, ranked No. 3 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, defeated Augsburg 4-3 in overtime on Saturday in a first-round NCAA Division III Tournament game to extend their winning streak to 14 games.

Senior forward Roman Uchyn, who scored two goals and two assists in the win over Augsburg, has a team-high 15 goals with 18 assists for 33 points. Senior forward Riley Christensen has 14 goals and 19 assists for 33 points. Sophomore forward Peter Bates has 11 goals and 20 assists for 31 points, while junior forward Dominick Sacco has 12 goals and 18 assists for 30 points. Freshman forward Peyton Frantti has 14 goals and 13 assists for 27 points, while freshman defenseman Brendon Gysbers has four goals and 23 assists for 27 points.

Senior goaltender T.J. Black is 22-4-2 with a 1.65 goals against average and .927 save percentage. Sophomore Ryan Bontorin is 1-0-1 with a 1.54 goals against average and .949 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 41-for-149 (27.5 percent) on the power play and is 82-for-97 (84.5 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point, ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, enters the game with a 26-0-2 overall record. The Pointers, who have won their last 20 games, last played on March 2, a 3-2 home win over UW-Eau Claire in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Tournament championship.

Senior forward Tanner Karty leads the Pointers in scoring with 10 goals and 24 assists for 34 points. Sophomore forward Zach Zech has nine goals and 18 assists for 27 points, while junior forward Luke McElhenie has nine goals and 15 assists for 24 points. Sophomore forward Carter Roo has 11 goals and 12 assists for 23 points, while sophomore forward Colin Raver has a team-high 12 goals with seven assists for 19 points.

Sophomore goaltender Connor Ryckman is 23-0-1 with a 1.42 goals against average and .934 save percentage. Freshman Eli Billing is 3-0-1 with a 1.65 goals against average and .904 save percentage.

Stevens Point is 24-for-115 (20.9 percent) on the power play and is 114-for-129 (88.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Trail Mix:

St. Norbert enters this Saturday's game having trailed just 7.8 percent of playing time this season, the second-lowest total for the Green Knights since records started being kept in that area in 2002.

The Green Knights have trailed just 141 minutes 48 seconds this year out of a possible 1827:47. The only mark lower was 7.7 percent in 2007-08. Joining those seasons below 10 percent was a 9.6 percent mark in 2006-07.

UW-Stevens Point has trailed a minuscule 2.7 percent of game time this season - 45:24 out of a possible 1690:00. Just over a quarter of that time came against St. Norbert on Nov. 17, when the Green Knights led for 11:07.

St. Norbert Hockey Winning Streaks

St. Norbert's current 14-game winning streak is one of seven winning streaks in school history of at least 13 games. St. Norbert has two winning streaks of 16 games, two of 14 games and three of 13 games.

Overtime Observations:

St. Norbert played its eighth overtime game of the season in this past Saturday's 4-3 win over Augsburg in the first round of the NCAA Tournament, but its first since Jan. 4.

The Green Knights are 2-3-3 in overtime games during the 2018-19 season, while UW-Stevens Point's two ties are its only overtime affairs this year.

St. Norbert is now 27-16-50 alltime in overtime games. The Green Knights are 6-3-1 in overtime games in the NCAA Tournament. St. Norbert has won its last four overtime NCAA Tournament games.

Ranking Report:

This weekend's game features two of the top offensive and defensive teams in Division III hockey this season.

St. Norbert is fourth nationally in scoring offense at 4.37 goals per game. UW-Stevens Point is fifth at 4.25 goals per game. Geneseo State is first at 4.89 goals per game.

Stevens Point is second nationally in scoring defense at 1.46 goals per game, while St. Norbert is fourth at 1.67 goals per game. Geneseo State is first at 1.19 goals per game.

WIAC Wisdom:

St. Norbert faces a Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foe this weekend in UW-Stevens Point.

Since the 2002-03 season, the first year the Green Knights advanced to the NCAA Division III Frozen Four, St. Norbert is 140-24-18 against the WIAC schools. In program history, St. Norbert is 215-77-30 all-time against the WIAC.

Since 2002-03, St. Norbert is 33-5-3 against UW-Stevens Point, 35-4-2 against UW-Eau Claire, 26-5-1 against UW-River Falls, 22-5-3 against UW-Stout and 23-5-8 against UW-Superior.

UW-Stevens Point enters this weekend's game with seven Canadians on its roster.

Iron Man:

St. Norbert senior forward Steven Phillips enters this Saturday's game never having missed a game in his career.

Phillips has skated in all 122 games played during his career with the Green Knights, tallying 32 goals and 38 assists for 70 points.

Phillips' streak longest consecutive games played mark in NCAA Division III history, according to the NCAA Ice Hockey Record Book. Norwich's Travis Janke previously held the Division III record with 119 consecutive games played from 2011-14.

Phillips has tied the St. Norbert record for career games with 122. Jason Deitsch (2002-05), Shane Dickson (1998-2001) and Rob Smillie (1996-99) currently share the

career games played record.

Power Play Patter:

St. Norbert is currently third nationally in Division III in powerplay percentage at 27.5 percent (41for-149).

The Green Knights trail only Geneseo State's 29.1 percent (39-for-134) and University of New England's 27.5 percent (38-for-138). St. Norbert's last power-play unit this efficient was in 2012-13 when it finished at 27.8 percent. The Green Knights have not been north of 28 percent on the power play since a slick 32.1 percent in 2003-04.

During St. Norbert's current 14game winning streak, the Green Knights are 28-for-81 (34.6 percent) on the power play. Seven of the 14 games have multiple power-play goals.

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 23 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped in 2016 with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

St. Norbert has 21 20-win seasons under Coghlin's supervision, all coming in the last 23 years.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 320 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 358 of 364 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 320-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003. 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com

St. Norbert is 145-55-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 5-6-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 579-145-57 in his 26th season. Coghlin is in 16th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

With a 4-1 win over Adrian on March 2, Coghlin moved into 16th place past UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli, who was 577-224-43 in 32 seasons (1985-2016) with the Corsairs.

Residing in 15th place on the alltime list is George Gwozdecky, who went 593-391-85 in 27 seasons at Denver, Miami and UW-River Falls from 1982 2013. to Hampshire's Dick Umile is in 14th place with a 594-375-114 record in 28 seasons from 1991 to 2018.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that

St. Norbert enters Saturday's game with UW-Stevens Point having amassed the second-most wins in NCAA Tournament play in the 36-year history of the tournament. The Green Knights have totaled 32 wins in NCAA play, which trails only Middlebury's 34 for the most in tournament history. Teams with at least 20 NCAA Tournament wins are listed below.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Tough After Two:

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 304-2-4 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 322-3-5 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 45-1 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 311-2-7 over their last 320 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 7-30-6 in its last 43 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a 6-5 win at St. Scholastica on Feb. 1, 2019

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 30 times in their last 522 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 781-game tenure.


