The Series:

St. Norbert leads Concordia-Wisconsin 9-2 in an all-time series dating back to the 2011-12 campaign.

St. Norbert leads MSOE in the all-time series 15-3, which began with a 4-2 Green Knights' win on Jan. 7, 2006 in Milwaukee.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 557-142-53 in his 26th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 413-73-36 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Concordia coach Jasen Wise (St. Thomas, 1996) is 65-86-10 in his seventh season in Mequon. Wise went 117-88-14 coaching at Marian for eight seasons for an overall record of 184-174-24 in 15 seasons.

MSOE coach Graham Johnson (Rhode Island, 2007) is 0-2 in his first season entering Friday's game with Finlandia.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert trimmed Concordia 6-2 on Oct. 28, 2017 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. Six different players scored for the Green Knights, who broke open a 3-2 game with three unanswered goals 4:27 apart in the third period. T.J. Black made 12 saves for the Green Knights.

St. Norbert tripped MSOE 5-0 this past Saturday at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. Five different Green Knights scored goals as St. Norbert led 4-0 after two periods. T.J. Black made 14 saves for St. Norbert for his 13th career shutout. Rock Boynton made 31 stops for the Raiders.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend 1-0 overall. The Green Knights,

ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com Division III Polls, defeated Milwaukee School of Engineering 5-0 in a non-conference game Saturday.

Freshman forward Peyton Frantti and freshman defenseman Brendon Gysbers each have won goal and one assist for two points. Sophomore forward Peter Bates has two assists for two points. Senior forwards Roman Uchyn and Riley Christensen and junior forward Kurt Black all have one goal for one point.

Senior goaltender T.J. Black is 1-0 with a 0.00 goals against average and 1.000 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 1-for-4 (25.0 percent) on the power play and is 3-for-3 (100.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Falcons:

Concordia enters the weekend 0-2 overall. The Falcons opened their season with a pair of road losses, a 5-0 defeat Friday at UW-River Falls and a 4-3 loss Saturday at UW-Superior.

Sophomore defenseman Braydon Barker has one goal and one assist for two points. Senior forward Connor Hogg and sophomore forward Andrej Buchko each have one goal for one point.

Freshman goaltender Bo Didur is 0-2 with a 4.55 goals against average and .868 save percentage.

Concordia is 0-for-7 (0.0 percent) on the power play and is 6-for-9 (66.7 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Raiders:

MSOE enters Friday's game with Finlandia 0-2 overall. The Raiders lost Friday at UW-Eau Claire 3-1 before falling 5-0 on Saturday at St. Norbert.

Junior forward Evan Kearns has one goal for one point. Sophomore forward Stian Owens and freshman forward Brendan Ferguson each have one assist for one point.

Sophomore goaltender Rock Boynton is 0-2 with a 4.00 goals

against average and .897 save percentage.

MSOE is 0-for-8 (0.0 percent) on the power play and is 8-for-11 (72.7 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Victory Vespers:

St. Norbert is currently on a 13-game winning streak dating back to last season.

The Green Knights' last loss came in a 3-2 overtime setback at Adrian on Jan. 26, 2018.

St. Norbert has won a school-record 16 consecutive games twice. The Green Knights fashioned the two streaks from Feb. 16-Nov. 21, 2008 and from Feb. 7-Nov. 14, 2014.

Black Bullets:

St. Norbert senior goaltender T.J. Black fashioned his 13th career shutout in this past Saturday's 5-0 win over Milwaukee School of Engineering.

Black's 13th shutout came in his 65th career start. Exactly 20 percent of his starts have resulted in complete-game shutouts.

Black is tied for fifth in NCAA Division III history in shutouts with Oswego State's Matt Zawadzki, who had 13 from 2014-17.

St. Norbert's Kyle Jones is the NCAA career shutouts leader with 25 from 2005-08. The Green Knights' David Jacobson is second with 20 from 2012-15. St. Thomas' Drew Fielding had 19 from 2012-15, while St. John's Adam Hanna had 14 from 2004-06.

Black now holds a 55-8-3 career record with the Green Knights. His 55 wins is tied for third in St. Norbert history with B.J. O'Brien (2009-11). That total trails only Jones (87) and Jacobson (75).

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 305 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 343 of 349 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in

Division III.

During the 305-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 133-26-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 140-53-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 5-6 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 557-142-53 in his 26th season. Coghlin is in 17th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Coghlin's 557 wins surpassed legendary Michigan Tech coach John MacInnes' 555-295-39 mark from 1957-82. MacInnes' win total was the most in college hockey history at the time of his retirement.

Coghlin is also only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Coghlin also has 31 NCAA Division III Tournament victories, which is second-most all-time. Only retired Middlebury coach Bill Beaney possesses more NCAA wins with 33.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert had an 83-game unbeaten streak when leading after two periods snapped in a 3-2 overtime loss to Adrian on Jan. 26. The Green Knights were 81-0-2 since the semester break of the 2013-14 season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 289-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 307-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 34-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 300-1-7 over their last 308 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 28 times in their last 494 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 748-game tenure.
