The Series:

St. Norbert leads Trine 2-0 in an alltime series that began in 2017-18.

St. Norbert leads Adrian 10-7 in an all-time series that began during the 2009-10 season. The two teams have split their last 14 meetings in the series after the Green Knights won the first three games. St. Norbert is 4-5 all-time at Arrington Ice Arena, but is 4-1 in its last five games there.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 558-143-53 in his 26th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 414-74-36 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Trine coach Alex Todd (Union, 2001) is 8-18-3 in his second season in Angola. He was 114-78-21 in eight seasons at Castleton State to give him a career record of 122-96-24.

Adrian coach Adam Krug (Adrian, 2012) is 95-22-6 in his fifth season in Adrian.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert defeated Trine 5-1 on Jan. 27, 2018 at Thunder Ice Arena in Angola, Ind. Five different Green Knights scored goals, while Sean Campbell had three assists. T.J. Black made 16 saves for the Green Knights, while a pair of Thunder goaltenders combined for 32 stops.

St. Norbert tripped Adrian 2-1 in overtime on March 3, 2018 at Arrington Ice Arena in Adrian, Mich., for the NCHA Harris Cup championship. Timmy Nicksic's goal 3:19 was the different. Mathew Thompson scored in the second period for Adrian, while Tanner Froese tied the game with a powerplay goal midway through the third stanza. Black made 26 saves for St. Norbert, while Kevin Entmaa made

34 stops for the Bulldogs.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend 2-1 overall and 1-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights, ranked No. 3 in the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com Division III polls, defeated Concordia Wisconsin 3-2 in overtime last Friday before falling to MSOE 3-2 in overtime on Saturday.

Sophomore forward Peter Bates leads the Green Knights in scoring with five assists for five points. Senior forward Roman Uchyn has two goals and one assist for three points, while junior forward Dominick Sacco has one goal and two assists for three points. Senior forward Riley Christensen and junior forward Kurt Black each have two goals for two points.

Senior goaltender T.J. Black is 2-1 with a 1.60 goals against average and .921 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 3-for-15 (20.0 percent) on the power play and is 11-for-14 (78.6 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Thunder:

Trine enters the game with a 1-2-1 overall record and a 1-1 mark in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Thunder lost to Marian 4-2 last Friday before defeating Lawrence 5-1 on Saturday.

Freshman forward Garrett Haliford has one goal and three assists for four points, while junior defenseman Henry Hearon has three assists for three points. Sophomore defenseman Blake Robertson has two goals for two assists. Sophomore forward Alex Johanson and freshman forward Gianni Vitali each have one goal and one assist for two points.

Junior goaltender Brett Young is 1-2-1 with a 2.24 goals against average and .924 save percentage.

Trine is 4-for-18 (22.2 percent) on the power play and is 11-for-14 (78.6 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Bulldogs:

Adrian enters Friday's game with Finlandia with a 3-1 overall record and a 1-1 mark in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Bulldogs, ranked No. 4 in the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com polls, are coming off a 7-0 win over Lawrence on Friday and a 4-1 loss to Adrian on Saturday.

Senior forward Bryan Yim paces the Bulldogs with four goals for four points. Senior defenseman Cory Dunn and junior forward Dino Balsamo each have one goal and three assists for four points. Freshman forward Jared Domin has two goals and one assist for three points, while senior forward Connor Armour has one goal and two assists for three points.

Senior goaltender Kevin Entmaa is 3-1 with a 1.26 goals against average and .945 save percentage.

Adrian is 4-for-20 (20.0 percent) on the power play and is 18-for-21 (85.7 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Overtime Observations:

St. Norbert had both of its games last weekend head to overtime. It marked just the sixth time in school history the Green Knights had both games of a weekend necessitate extra time.

The Green Knights last had both games of a series go to overtime in last season's Thanksgiving set against Manhattanville, resulting in a tie and St. Norbert win.

Other weekends with two overtime games were a trip to UW-River Falls and UW-Stevens Point in 2013-14 (win/tie), a trip to St. Scholastica and UW-Superior in 2009-10 (tie/tie), home games with St. Mary's and St. Thomas in 2007-08 (win/win) and UW-River Falls and UW-Superior in the 2002 NCHA Peters Cup Final Four (win/loss).

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 306 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 344 of

350 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 306-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 140-53-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 5-6 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 558-143-53 in his 26th season. Coghlin is in 17th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Coghlin's 558 wins surpassed legendary Michigan Tech coach John MacInnes' 555-295-39 mark from 1957-82. MacInnes' win total was the most in college hockey history at the time of his retirement.

Coghlin is also only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

winning streak when leading after two periods snapped in a 3-2 overtime loss to Milwaukee School of Engineering on Nov. 3. The Green Knights were 92-1-2 in their last 95 games overall when leading after two periods dating back to the semester break of the 2013-14 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 289-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 307-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 34-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 300-1-7 over their last 308 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 28 times in their last 494 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 748-game tenure.
