Fierce rivals for more than two decades, St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stevens Point by a 48-21-6 margin in a series begun in the 1991-92 season. St. Norbert is 48-13-3 in the last 64 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 30-5-2 in the last 37 games in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 559-144-53 in his 26th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 415-75-36 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

UW-Eau Claire coach Matt Loen (UW-Eau Claire, 1995) is 178-110-25 in his 12th season in Eau Claire.

UW-Stevens Point coach Tyler Krueger (UW-Stevens Point, 2014) is 26-6-4 in his second season in Stevens Point.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert defeated UW-Eau Claire 3-1 on Nov. 17, 2017 at Hobbs Ice Center in Eau Claire. Tanner Froese, Steven Phillips and Luke Davison all scored for the Green Knights, who had a 3-0 lead. Jake Hofpner scored for the Blugolds, who got 14 saves from Camden Haugenoe. T.J. Black made 37 saves for St. Norbert.

St. Norbert topped UW-Stevens Point 2-1 on Nov. 18, 2017 at K.B. Willett Arena in Stevens Point. Tanner Froese and Luke Karakas scored second-period goals for St. Norbert, while Willem Nong-Lambert scored in the third period for the Pointers. T.J. Black made 30 saves for St. Norbert, while Max Milosek turned away 30 shots for the Pointers. St. Norbert was called for one penalty in the game.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend 3-

2 overall. The Green Knights split a pair of games in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association last weekend, winning at Trine 4-0 before falling at Adrian 4-3 in overtime. St. Norbert is ranked No. 4 by USCHO.com and No. 3 by D3hockey.com in the national Division III polling.

Sophomore forward Peter Bates tops the Green Knights in scoring with two goals and five assists for seven points. Senior forward Riley Christensen, who had a natural hat trick against Trine, has five goals for points. five Junior forward Dominick Sacco has three goals and two assists for five points. Senior forward Roman Uchyn has two goals and two assists for four points, while sophomore forward Keegan Milligan has four assists for four points.

Senior goaltender T.J. Black is 3-2 with a 1.75 goals against average and .920 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 4-for-24 (16.7 percent) on the power play and is 18for-22 (81.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Blugolds:

UW-Eau Claire enters the game 7-0 overall. The Blugolds, ranked No. 5 by USCHO.com and No. 6 by D3hockey.com in the Division III polling, topped St. Thomas 2-1 and St. Mary's 3-1 last weekend at home.

Senior defenseman Lucas Kohls has four goals and four assists for eight points, including three powerplay goals. Freshman forward Andrew McGlynn has two goals and six assists for eight points, while junior forward Jake Bresser has one goal and seven assists for eight points. Junior forward Steen Cooper has three goals and four assists for seven points.

Sophomore goaltender Zach Dyment is 7-0 with a 1.14 goals against average and .937 save percentage.

Eau Claire is 8-for-35 (22.9 percent) on the power play and is 32for-37 (86.5 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters Friday's game at Marian at 5-0-1 overall. The Pointers, ranked No. 1 by both USCHO.com and D3hockey.com, topped St. Mary's 3-2 and St. Thomas 2-1 last weekend at home.

Junior forward Luke McElhenie leads the Pointers in scoring with three goals and four assists for seven points. Sophomore forward Carter Roo has three goals and three assists for six points, while junior defenseman Drew McLean has two goals and four assists for six points. Junior forward Logan Fredericks has three goals and two assists for five points.

Sophomore goaltender Connor Ryckman is 5-0 with a 1.80 goals against average and .918 save percentage. Freshman Eli Billing is 0-0-1 with a 1.85 goals against average and .833 save percentage.

Stevens Point is 5-for-25 (20.0 percent) on the power play and is 22for-25 (88.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

WIAC Wisdom:

St. Norbert is facing a pair of Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foes this weekend in UW-Eau Claire and UW-Stevens Point.

Since the 2002-03 season, the first year the Green Knights advanced to the NCAA Division III Frozen Four, St. Norbert is 139-24-17 against the WIAC schools. In program history, St. Norbert is 214-77-29 all-time against the WIAC.

Since 2002-03, St. Norbert is 33-5-2 against UW-Stevens Point, 34-4-2 against UW-Eau Claire, 26-5-1 against UW-River Falls, 22-5-3 against UW-Stout and 23-5-8 against UW-Superior.

Maple Leaf Musings:

St. Norbert has just three Canadian players on its roster in 2018-19.

Ryan Bontorin (Calgary, Alberta), Kurt Black (Lake Country, British Columbia) and Keegan Milligan (Emerald Park, Saskatchewan) are the only three Green Knights from north of the 49th parallel.

UW-Stevens Point enters this weekend's series with seven Canadians on its roster, while UW-Eau Claire has three.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 307 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 345 of 351 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 307-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 140-54-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 5-6 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 559-144-53 in his 26th season. Coghlin is in 17th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Coghlin's 559 wins surpassed legendary Michigan Tech coach John MacInnes' 555-295-39 mark from 1957-82. MacInnes' win total was the most in college hockey history at the time of his retirement.

Coghlin is also only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Tough After Two:

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 289-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 307-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 34-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 300-1-7 over their last 308 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 28 times in their last 498 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 752-game tenure.
