The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 562-144-54 in his 26th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 418-75-37 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Lawrence coach Mike Szkodzinski (St. Norbert, 2000) is 119-179-26 in his 13th season in Appleton.

Marian coach Zach Gaynor (Marian, 2008) is 25-10-2 in his second season in Fond du Lac.

Last Season:

St. Norbert swept Lawrence in a four-game season series. The Green Knights won 3-2 on Dec. 1, 2017 in Appleton and followed with a 6-0 win over the Vikings on Jan. 13, 2018 in De Pere. St. Norbert swept an NCHA Playoffs quarterfinal series by a pair of 3-1 scores on Feb. 16-17, 2018 in De Pere.

St. Norbert swept Marian in three games a year ago. The Green Knights claimed a 4-1 win on Dec. 2, 2017 in Fond du Lac and earned a 7-2 win on Jan. 12, 2018 in De Pere. St. Norbert then won an NCHA Playoffs semifinal game 3-0 on Feb. 24, 2018 in De Pere.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend 6-2-1 overall and 2-2 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights, ranked No. 3 in the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com Division III polls, defeated Stevenson 3-0 and Neumann 4-1 this past weekend in De Pere.

Sophomore forward Peter Bates leads the Green Knights in scoring with three goals and six assists for nine points. Senior forward Riley Christensen has a team-high six goals with one assist for seven points, while senior forward Roman Uchyn has four goals and

three assists for seven points. Junior forward Kurt Black has five goals and one assist for six points. Junior forward Dominick Sacco has three goals and three assists for six points, while sophomore defenseman Luke Davison has one goal and five assists for six points.

Senior goaltender T.J. Black is 5-2-1 with a 1.34 goals against average and .941 save percentage. Sophomore Ryan Bontorin is 1-0 with a 1.00 goals against average and .964 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 8-for-41 (19.5 percent) on the power play and is 32-for-37 (86.5 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the weekend 1-7 overall and 0-4 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Vikings split a pair of one-goal games last weekend, defeating Neumann 3-2 before losing to Stevenson 1-0.

Sophomore forward Danny Toycen leads Lawrence in scoring with two goals and two assists for four points. Senior forward Josh Koeplinger has one goal and two assists for three points, while junior forward Jake Drinkard has one goal and one assist for two points. Junior forward Evan Ketner and junior defenseman Daniel Gysi each have two assists for two points.

Junior goaltender Evan Cline is 0-5 with a 3.88 goals against average and .903 save percentage. Senior Greg Procopio is 1-2 with a 4.52 goals against average and .885 save percentage.

Lawrence is 1-for-41 (2.4 percent) on the power play and is 38-for-48 (79.2 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Sabres:

Marian enters Friday's game with Finlandia at 5-2-1 overall an 4-0 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Sabres, ranked No. 14 in the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com Division III polls, beat Bethel 6-2 and tied St. John's 1-

1 in Minnesota last weekend.

Senior forward Nick Monfils has four goals and five assists for nine points. Junior forward Connor Blanck has three goals and three assists for six points. Junior forward Clay Cross and freshman forward Parker Colley each have three goals and two assists for five points. Senior forward Jake Howie has two goals and three assists for five points.

Junior goaltender Hunter Vorva is 4-1-1 with a 1.66 goals against average and .937 save percentage. Senior Jack Romanuik is 1-1 with a 2.56 goals against average and .878 save percentage.

Marian is 8-for-37 (21.6 percent) on the power play and is 36-for-41 (87.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Penalty Shot Patter:

St. Norbert converted just the second penalty shot in the 19-year, 293-game history of the Cornerstone Community Center this past Saturday.

Timmy Nicksic was the victim of a tripping penalty on a breakaway in a 4-1 win over Neumann. Nicksic then converted the penalty shot.

Michael Hill has the only other penalty shot at the Cornerstone, converting on Feb. 19, 2016 against Milwaukee School of Engineering following a delay of game penalty.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 249-30-14 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 229-22-11 in its last 262 games at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights are currently on a 29-game unbeaten streak at home, going 27-0-2 since a 4-2 loss to Concordia-Wis., on Jan. 27, 2017.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4,

2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 328-52-20 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 309 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 347 of 353 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 309-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 141-54-19 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 5-6-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 562-144-54 in his 26th season. Coghlin is in 17th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green

Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Tough After Two:

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 291-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 309-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 34-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 300-1-7 over their last 308 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 28 times in their last 502 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 760-game tenure.
