The Series:

St. Norbert and Augsburg are tied 10-10-1 in an all-time series begun during the 1988-89 season. The Green Knights are 9-1-1 against the Auggies since Tim Coghlin took over in 1993-94. St. Norbert is 3-0 all-time against Augsburg in the NCAA Tournament, with the Green Knights defeating the Auggies in national quarterfinal games in 2016, 2017 and 2018.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 564-144-54 in his 26th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 420-75-37 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Augsburg coach Chris Brown (UW-River Falls, 1994) is 161-138-27 in his 13th season in Minneapolis. He was 69-56-8 in five years combined at Marian and Hamline for a total record of 230-194-35.

Last Season:

St. Norbert extended its winning streak over Augsburg to eight games by going 3-0 in the series last season.

St. Norbert swept Augsburg 3-1 and 4-0 in a regular-season series on Dec. 8-9, 2017 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere.

Augsburg had a 1-0 lead after two periods in the opener but St. Norbert scored three goals in the final 20 minutes by William Yates, Tyler Andrews and Tanner Froese. Nate Flynn scored for the Auggies. Nick Schmit made 32 saves for Augsburg, while T.J. Black made 24 stops for the Green Knights.

Riley Christensen scored two goals in the second game for St. Norbert, with Peter Bates and Keegan Milligan also adding markers. Black made 37 saves in the shutout win, while Schmit made 32 stops in the loss.

St. Norbert topped Augsburg 5-2 on March 17, 2018 at Cornerstone Community Center in an NCAA Division III Tournament Quarterfinal. The Green Knights led 3-0 early in the second period before Augsburg cut the deficit to 3-2 after two periods. Timmy Nicksic's goal at 11:04 of the third period gave St. Norbert some breathing room, while Milligan's empty-net goal with 1:15 left sealed it. Black made 23 saves, while Schmit turned away 31 shots.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series 8-2-1 overall. The Green Knights, ranked No. 3 in the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com polls, are coming off an 8-1 win over Lawrence Friday and a 5-0 triumph over Marian Saturday in Northern Collegiate Hockey Association games in De Pere.

Sophomore forward Peter Bates has a team-high 10 points, registering three goals and seven assists. Junior forward Kurt Black has a team-high eight goals along with one assist for nine points. Senior forward Riley Christensen has six goals and three assists for nine points, while senior forward Roman Uchyn has five goals and four assists for nine points. Junior forward Dominick Sacco has four goals and four assists for eight points.

Senior goaltender T.J. Black is 7-2-1 with a 1.17 goals against average and .944 save percentage. Sophomore Ryan Bontorin is 1-0 with a 1.00 goals against average and .964 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 10-for-50 (20.0 percent) on the power play and is 38for-43 (88.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Auggies:

Augsburg enters the series 8-1-1 overall. The Auggies, ranked No. 9 by USCHO.com and No. 10 by D3hockey.com, grabbed three Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference points this past weekend with a 5-2 win and a 2-2 tie

against St. Thomas.

Senior forward Alex Rodriguez leads the Auggies in scoring with 10 goals and five assists for 15 points. Senior forward Chandler Madry has five goals and eight assists for 13 points, while sophomore forward Tommy Carey has two goals and eight assists for 10 points. Senior forward Luke Dietsch has two goals and seven assists for nine points.

Senior goaltender Nick Schmit is 4-0-1 with a 1.14 goals against average and .958 save percentage. Sophomore Daniil Gerasimov is 4-1 with a 2.34 goals against average and .912 save percentage.

Augsburg is 9-for-46 (19.6 percent) on the power play and is 32for-35 (91.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Black Bullets:

St. Norbert senior goaltender T.J. Black registered his 16th career shutout in this past Saturday's 5-0 win over Marian.

Black is fourth in NCAA Division III history in career shutouts. St. Norbert's Kyle Jones is the all-time leader with 25 from 2008-11, while the Green Knights' David Jacobson is second with 20 from 2012-15. St. Thomas' Drew Fielding is third with 19 from 2012-15. All three of those goaltenders are Sid Watson Award recipients.

Black also has 61 career wins to sit in a tie for 13th place in Division III history. Black needs just nine wins to become the fifth goaltender in Division III history to reach the 70win plateau.

MIAC Minutiae:

St. Norbert has a solid 90-11-7 record against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference competition since Tim Coghlin took over the Green Knights' helm in 1993. Two of the losses came in a sweep at St. Mary's in Coghlin's first year of 1993-94.

Since then, the Green Knights are 90-9-7 against the MIAC. St. Norbert is 14-1-1 in its last 16 games against the MIAC, with the only loss coming in a 2-1 setback at Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 3, 2012.

At home under Coghlin, St. Norbert is a remarkable 53-2-3 against MIAC foes. The losses came in a 3-2 defeat to St. Thomas in the 2005 NCAA Division III Tournament and to Gustavus Adolphus 4-2 on Nov. 3, 2007.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 310 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 348 of 354 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 310-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 142-54-19 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 5-6-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 564-144-54 in his 26th season. Coghlin is in 17th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Coghlin is 13 wins shy of moving into 16th place. UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli was 577-224-43 in 32 seasons (1985-2016) with the Corsairs.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Tough After Two:

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 293-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 311-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 36-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 302-1-7 over their last 310 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-29-6 in its last 41 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 28 times in their last 504 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 762-game tenure.

2018-2019 St. Norbert Hockey Game Summaries
