St. Norbert leads Aurora 5-0 in an all-time series begun in the 2015-16 season. The Green Knights are 2-0 at home in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 564-145-55 in his 26th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 420-76-38 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Lake Forest coach Patrick Kelliher (St. Lawrence, 2010) is 61-48-10 in his fifth season in Lake Forest.

Aurora coach Jason Bloomingburg (Wayne State, 2006) is 17-39-7 in his third season in Aurora.

Last Season:

St. Norbert defeated Lake Forest 7-0 on Jan. 5, 2018 at Alumni Memorial Fieldhouse in Lake Forest, Ill. Keegan Milligan scored four goals to lead the Green Knights, while Jack Thomas added three assists. T.J. Black made 11 saves in just under 48 minutes for St. Norbert, while Louis-Philippe De Courcy made 20 stops in 42 minutes for the Foresters.

St. Norbert defeated Aurora 5-3 on Jan. 6, 2018 at Fox Valley Ice Arena in Geneva, Ill. The Green Knights scored three third-period goals to snap a 2-2 tie. Peter Bates, Tanner Froese and Steven Phillips scored in the third period for St. Norbert. T.J. Black made 17 stops for the Green Knights, while Josh Boyko made 25 saves for the Spartans.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend 8-3-2 overall and 4-2 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights have been idle since the weekend of Dec. 7-8, when Augsburg defeated the Green Knights 6-5 and tied 3-3 in a pair of overtime contests.

Junior forward Dominick Sacco leads the Green Knights in scoring with five goals and seven assists for 12 points. Senior forward Riley Christensen has seven goals and four assists for 11 points, while senior forward Roman Uchyn has six goals and five assists for 11 points. Sophomore forward Peter Bates has four goals and seven assists for 11 points. Junior forward Kurt Black has a team-high eight goals with two assists for 10 points, including four game-winning goals.

Senior goaltender T.J. Black is 7-3-1 with a 1.60 goals against average and .927 save percentage. Sophomore Ryan Bontorin is 1-0-1 with a 1.92 goals against average and .942 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 13-for-58 (22.4 percent) on the power play and is 42-for-48 (87.5 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters the game 5-5-3 overall and 3-2-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Foresters are coming off a 3-2 home loss to Babson this past Sunday.

Sophomore forward Joe Sardina leads the Foresters in scoring with six goals and eight assists for 14 points. Sophomore defenseman Mark DerManulian has two goals and eight assists for 10 points. Senior forward Cody Guidorzi has five goals and four assists for nine points, while sophomore forward Aaron O'Neill has six goals and two assists for eight points.

Senior goaltender Louis-Philippe De Courcy is 4-4-2 with a 2.39 goals against average and .925 save percentage. Senior George Argiropoulos is 1-1-1 with a 2.61 goals against average and .925 save percentage.

Lake Forest is 14-for-68 (20.6 percent) on the power play and is 50-

for-60 (83.3 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Spartans:

Aurora enters Friday's game at Finlandia with an 8-5 overall record and a 5-1 mark in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Spartans are coming off a non-conference series split at Gustavus Adolphus last weekend, losing 3-0 before winning 4-2.

Freshman forward Jacob Holmers leads the Spartans in scoring with seven goals and seven assists for 14 points. Freshman forward Larry Jungwirth has two goals and nine assists for 11 points, while freshman forward Shawn O'Malley has five goals and five assists for 10 points. Junior forward Drew Doyon has four goals and six assists for 10 points.

Sophomore goaltender Josh Boyko is 6-5 with a 3.03 goals against average and .888 save percentage. Sophomore Jake Gwillim is 2-0 with a 2.08 goals against average and .932 save percentage.

Aurora is 8-for-64 (12.5 percent) on the power play and is 46-for-56 (82.1 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 251-30-14 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 231-22-11 in its last 264 games at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights are currently on a 31-game unbeaten streak at home, going 29-0-2 since a 4-2 loss to Concordia-Wis., on Jan. 27, 2017.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert

is 330-52-20 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 311 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 349 of 355 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 313-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 142-55-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 5-6-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 564-145-55 in his 26th season. Coghlin is in 17th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Coghlin is 13 wins shy of moving into 16th place. UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli was 577-224-43 in 32 seasons (1985-2016) with the Corsairs.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the

Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Tough After Two:

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 293-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 311-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 36-1 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 302-2-7 over their last 311 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-30-6 in its last 42 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 29 times in their last 505 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 764-game tenure.
