The Series:

St. Norbert leads Marian 27-1-2 in a series which began in the 1996-97 season.

St. Norbert holds a 47-1-1 lead in the all-time series with Lawrence dating back to the 1988-89 season.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 565-145-56 in his 26th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 421-76-39 in the last 17-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Marian coach Zach Gaynor (Marian, 2008) is 27-14-3 in his second season in Fond du Lac.

Lawrence coach Mike Szkodzinski (St. Norbert, 2000) is 122-182-27 in his 13th season in Appleton.

This Season:

St. Norbert tripped Marian 5-0 in a battle of nationally ranked teams on Dec. 1, 2018 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. Five different players scored goals for the Green Knights, with Peyton Frantti scoring one goal and one assist. T.J. Black made 15 saves for the Green Knights, while Hunter Vorva made 28 stops for the Sabres.

St. Norbert topped Lawrence 8-1 on Nov. 30, 2018 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. The Green Knights scored all of their goals in the first two periods and got a hat trick from Kurt Black. T.J. Black made 14 saves for St. Norbert. Greg Procopio made 32 stops in 40 minutes for the Vikings, while Evan Cline added 11 saves. St. Norbert outshot Lawrence 51-15.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend

9-3-3 overall and 5-2-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights tied Lake Forest 1-1 last Friday before defeating Aurora 5-1 this past Saturday.

Senior forward Riley Christensen has moved into the team scoring lead with 14 points, netting eight goals and six assists. Senior forward Roman Uchyn has seven goals and six assists for 13 points, while junior forward Dominick Sacco has six goals and seven assists for 13 points. Sophomore forward Peter Bates has four goals and nine assists for 13 points. Freshman defenseman Brendon Gysbers has three goals and eight assists for 11 points, while sophomore defenseman Luke Davison has one goal and a team-high 10 assists for 11 points.

Senior goaltender T.J. Black is 8-3-2 with a 1.50 goals against average and .932 save percentage. Sophomore Ryan Bontorin is 1-0-1 with a 1.92 goals against average and .942 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 13-for-62 (21.0 percent) on the power play and is 46-for-52 (88.5 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Sabres:

Marian enters the weekend 7-6-2 overall and 5-3 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Sabres have been idle since Jan. 3, when they lost 3-0 to Milwaukee School of Engineering.

Senior forward Nick Monfils has six goals and five assists for 11 points, while junior forward Connor Blanck has four goals and seven assists for 11 points. Senior forward Jake Howie has three goals and six assists for nine points. Junior forward Clay Cross has four goals and four assists for eight points.

Junior forward Hunter Vorva has a 6-5-2 overall record and 2.15 goals against average with a .929 save percentage. Senior Jack Romanuik is 1-1 with a 3.30 goals against average with an .862 save

percentage.

Marian is 11-for-61 (18.0 percent) on the power play and is 61-for-68 (89.7 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the game 4-10-1 overall and 2-5-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Vikings are coming off a 2-2 tie at home with Milwaukee School of Engineering on Tuesday.

Senior forward Josh Koeplinger leads the Vikings in scoring with two goals and six assists for eight points. Freshman forward Vincent Dekumbis and junior forward Jake Drinkard each have four goals and two assists for six points. Junior defenseman Daniel Gysi has one goal and four assists for five assists.

Junior goaltender Evan Cline is 3-7-1 with a 2.78 goals against average and .922 save percentage. Senior Greg Procopio is 1-3 with a 5.71 goals against average and .866 save percentage.

Lawrence is 4-for-67 (6.0 percent) on the power play and is 68-for-83 (81.9 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Overtime Observations:

Through just 15 games this season, St. Norbert has already played in a whopping seven overtime games. The Green Knights are 1-3-3 in overtime games this season.

The St. Norbert school record for overtime games in a season is eight, with the Green Knights going 4-0-4 in those games during their first national championship season of 2007-08.

Colby holds the NCAA Division III record for overtime games in a season with 11, set in 1997-98. Five other teams have played 10 overtime games in one season.

The most ties St. Norbert has ever had in a season is five, set in 2011-12. The Green Knights went 21-5-5 that season en route to their third NCAA Division III national championship.

St. Norbert is now 26-16-56 all-time in overtime games.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 312 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 350 of 356 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 312-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 142-55-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 5-6-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 565-145-56 in his 26th season. Coghlin is in 17th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Coghlin is 12 wins shy of moving into 16th place. UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli was 577-224-43 in 32 seasons (1985-2016) with the Corsairs.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available

records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Tough After Two:

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 294-2-4 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 312-3-5 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 37-1 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 303-2-7 over their last 312 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 6-30-6 in its last 42 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a wild 8-7 double-overtime win over UMass-Boston on March 25, 2016 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 29 times in their last 507 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 766-game tenure.
