The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 587-155-58 in his 27th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 443-86-41 in the last 18-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Finlandia coach Joe Burcar is 117-170-17 in his 12th season in Hancock. This is the fourth season of his second stint with the Lions.

Last Season:

St. Norbert went 4-0 against Finlandia last season. The Green Knights swept the Lions 3-1 and 8-1 in a home-and-home regular-season series on Feb. 8-9, 2019. St. Norbert then swept Finlandia 2-1 and 9-0 in a NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs Quarterfinal Series at Cornerstone Community Center on Feb. 15-16, 2019.

In the four games against Finlandia, Peter Bates scored four goals and four assists for eight points. Peyton Frantti and Roman Uchyn each had three goals and three assists for six points. Brad Pung added one goal and five assists for six points, while Brendon Gysbers had six assists for six points.

T.J. Black finished 4-0 between the pipes with a 4-0 record and a .952 save percentage.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend at 8-8-2 overall and 6-6-2 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights are 6-1-2 in their last nine games after splitting with Adrian last weekend. St. Norbert topped the Bulldogs 1-0 before falling 3-2 in overtime.

Junior forward Peter Bates tops the Green Knights in scoring with nine goals and 16 assists for 25 points. Sophomore forward Peyton

Frantti has nine goals and 12 assists for 21 points, while senior forward Kurt Black has a team-high 12 goals with eight assists for 20 points. Senior forward Dominick Sacco has five goals and 10 assists for 15 points.

Freshman goaltender Colby Entz is 5-1-2 with a 2.07 goals against average and .928 save percentage. Junior Ryan Bontorin is 3-7 with a 2.91 goals against average and .897 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 9-for-77 (11.7 percent) on the power play and is 64-for-82 (78.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Lions:

Finlandia enters the series with a 4-13-2 overall record and a 2-10-2 showing in Northern Collegiate Hockey Association play. The Lions are coming off a series split at home with Trine this past weekend, losing 3-2 in overtime before winning 3-2 in overtime.

Junior defenseman Connor Hannon leads Finlandia in scoring with eight goals and four assists for 12 points. Sophomore forward Teddy Randell has two goals and nine assists for 11 points. Sophomore Tyler Watungwa has five goals and five assists for 10 points, while junior forward Cale Markham has four goals and six assists for 10 points.

Junior goaltender Marcus Gloss is 3-8-2 with a 3.06 goals against average and .912 save percentage. Freshman Ben Kelsch is 1-1 with a 4.79 goals against average and .887 save percentage.

Finlandia is 8-for-78 (10.3 percent) on the power play and is 79-for-100 (79.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Pitchers' Duels:

St. Norbert played its second 1-0 game of the season when it claimed a win over Adrian by that score this past Friday. The Green Knights lost a 1-0 decision to Lake Forest on Nov. 8.

In 912 all-time games, the Green

Knights have played just seven 1-0 games, going 3-4 in those contests. The 1-0 game against Lake Forest earlier this season was the first for the Green Knights in nearly 12 years.

St. Norbert's first two 1-0 wins in program history came with highly decorated goaltender Kyle Jones between the pipes. Jones made 28 saves in a 1-0 win over St. Scholastica in the semifinals of the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs on March 1, 2008. He also made 14 stops in a 1-0 win over UW-Superior on Jan. 21, 2006. Both games were at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Interestingly, Lake Forest and Middlebury own all four 1-0 wins over the Green Knights, each owning two. The Foresters also earned a 1-0 win on Nov. 5, 1999 in Lake Forest, Ill. Middlebury won 1-0 games over St. Norbert on Dec. 2, 2000 at Cornerstone Community Center and on March 20, 2004 at Kreitzberg Arena in Northfield, Vt., in the NCAA Division III national championship game.

St. Norbert has played just three scoreless ties in its history - on Jan. 27, 1995 against UW-Stevens Point at De Pere Ice Arena, on Feb. 3, 2012 at UW-Superior and on Jan. 8, 2015 at St. John's.

Since the start of the 1997-98 season, St. Norbert has been shutout just 14 times - a stretch of 694 games. Four of those have come in the 1-0 losses.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 264-35-15 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, going 244-27-12 in its last 283 games there.

The Green Knights had a 43-game unbeaten streak at the Cornerstone snapped in a 3-1 loss to No. 1-ranked UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 2, 2019. St. Norbert had gone 40-0-3 since a 4-2 loss to Concordia-Wis., on Jan. 27, 2017.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III histo-

ry - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 343-57-21 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 587-155-58 in his 27th season. Coghlin is in 16th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Residing in 15th place on the all-time list is George Gwozdecky, who went 593-391-85 in 27 seasons at Denver, Miami and UW-River Falls from 1982 to 2013. New Hampshire's Dick Umile is in 14th place with a 594-375-114 record in 28 seasons from 1991 to 2018.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji

The Green Knights are 49-2 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 316-3-7 over their last 326 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 7-31-6 in its last 44 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a 6-5 win at St. Scholastica on Feb. 1, 2019.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 31 times in their last 541 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 800-game tenure.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert saw its unprecedented streak of being ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll end at 325 consecutive weeks after being unranked on Nov. 25.

St. Norbert climbed back onto the poll's radar on Jan. 6 when it was listed in the "others receiving votes" category. The Green Knights are still receiving votes in this week's poll.

The Green Knights have been ranked in 363 of 375 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

Prior to this season, the last USCHO.com Poll that did not have the Green Knights ranked was Jan. 15, 2001, the last of three consecutive polls without St. Norbert. The ranking held just 10 teams at the time and did not go to 15 teams until the 2002-03 season.

During the 325-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 88 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 147-58-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 6-8-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.
