The Series:

St. Norbert leads Adrian 13-9 in an all-time series that began during the 2009-10 season. St. Norbert holds a 10-9 edge in the last 19 meetings in the series after the Green Knights won the first three games.

The Green Knights and Bulldogs are meeting for the sixth consecutive season in the NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs Championship Game. St. Norbert has won the last three such meetings after Adrian claimed the first two.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 596-156-58 in his 27th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 452-87-41 in the last 18-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Adrian coach Adam Krug (Adrian, 2012) is 132-34-10 in his sixth season in Adrian.

This Season:

St. Norbert and Adrian split a pair of games in a hotly contested Northern Collegiate Hockey Association series on Jan. 17-18, 2020 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere.

The Green Knights won the series opener 1-0. Peter Bates scored the game's lone marker at 15:18 of the third period, with St. Norbert holding off 1:11 of Adrian extra-attacker time to get the win. Colby Entz made 33 saves for the Green Knights, while Cameron Gray made 20 stops for the Bulldogs.

Adrian countered with a 3-2 overtime win to salvage a series split. Joey Colatarci scored 38 seconds into overtime for the game-winning goal after tying the game at 10:49 of the third period with a shorthanded goal. Bates and Brendan Aird scored goals for St. Norbert, while Sam Ruffin added another shorthanded goal for the Bulldogs. Gray made 26 saves for the Bulldogs, while Entz made 28 saves for the Green Knights.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 17-9-2 overall and ranked No. 11 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll. The Green Knights advanced to the NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs Championship Game after beating Marian 2-0 in a semifinal game this past Saturday in Fond du Lac.

Junior forward Peter Bates leads the NCHA in scoring with 15 goals and 25 assists for 40 points. Senior forward Kurt Black tops the NCHA in goals with 21 and also has 16 assists for 37 points. Sophomore forward Peyton Frantti has 14 goals and 19 assists for 33 points. Senior forward Dominick Sacco has fashioned six goals and 18 points for 24 points. Junior forward Tim Nicksic has six goals and 15 assists for 21 points.

Freshman goaltender Colby Entz is 12-2-2 with a 1.81 goals against average and .929 save percentage. Junior Ryan Bontorin is 5-7 with a 2.59 goals against average and .906 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 23-for-130 (17.7 percent) on the power play and is 98for-117 (83.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Bulldogs:

Adrian enters the game with a 20-5-3 overall record. The Bulldogs, who have won their last 12 games, advanced to the NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs Championship Game by rallying past Trine for a 4-3 win this past Saturday in Adrian.

Senior forward Dino Balsamo leads the Bulldogs with 19 goals and 20 assists for 39 points. Sophomore forward Andrew Bellant has 17 goals and 21 assists for 38 points, while sophomore forward Sam Ruffin has 10 goals and 27 assists for 37 points. Freshman forward Zachary Heintz has 14 goals and 19 assists for 33 points, while freshman forward Alessio

Luciani has 10 goals and 21 assists for 31 points.

Junior goaltender Cameron Gray is 17-4-1 with a 2.58 goals against average and .900 save percentage. Freshman Nic Tallarico is 3-1-2 with a 2.46 goals against average and .901 save percentage.

Adrian is 38-for-159 (23.9 percent) on the power play and is 127-for-158 (80.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Cup Clamor:

St. Norbert continues its quest for a 16th NCHA Playoffs championship when it heads to Adrian on Saturday for the championship game of the Harris Cup Playoffs.

The Green Knights are 78-14-1 alltime in the NCHA Playoffs, and are 73-7 at home all-time in the tournament. St. Norbert is 5-7-1 on the road.

St. Norbert has won its last 27 rounds at home in the NCHA Playoffs, which includes 41 consecutive wins. The Green Knights' last home loss in the league post-season was a 3-2 overtime loss to UW-Superior in the 2006 NCHA Peters Cup Championship.

Since the 1996-97 season, St. Norbert has played just nine of its last 62 NCHA Playoff series/rounds on the road. Included in those seven are five trips to Adrian for the Harris Cup title the last six seasons. The Green Knights lost at Adrian in 2015 and 2016 before winning the Harris Cup there in 2017 and 2018. St. Norbert was at Marian in the 2020 semifinals.

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 23 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such record in NCAA Division III hockey history.

The Green Knights are just one win shy of reaching the 18-win mark this season.

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped in 2016 with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

St. Norbert has 21 20-win seasons under Coghlin's supervision, all coming in the last 23 years.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 596-156-58 in his 27th season. Coghlin is in 14th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

In a two-game series with Lawrence on Feb. 21-22, Coghlin passed George Gwozdecky for 15th place on the all-time list, who went 593-391-85 in 27 seasons at Denver, Miami and UW-River Falls from 1982 to 2013. New Hampshire's Dick Umile was in 14th place with a 594-375-114 record in 28 seasons from 1991 to 2018.

Bill Beaney is in 13th place, posting a record of 602-260-59 in 35 seasons at Middlebury and New England College from 1978 to 2015.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such sea-

sons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Tough After Two:

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 312-3-4 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 330-4-5 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' other losses when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead and on Jan. 18, 2020 in a 3-2 overtime loss to Adrian after holding a 2-1 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 57-2 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 324-3-7 over their last 334 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert has scored at least five goals in eight of its last nine games, averaging 5.78 goals per game (52 goals in nine games). The Green Knights have scored 47.7 percent (52 of 109) of their goals this season in their last nine games.

St. Norbert is 7-31-6 in its last 44 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a 6-5 win at St. Scholastica on Feb. 1, 2019.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 31 times in their last 551 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 810-game tenure.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert saw its unprecedented streak of being ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll end at 325 consecutive weeks after being unranked on Nov. 25.

St. Norbert climbed back onto the poll's radar on Jan. 6 when it was listed in the "others receiving votes" category. The Green Knights moved back into the poll on Feb. 10 with a No. 14 ranking and maintained that position for a second week before moving up to No. 12 on Feb. 24. St. Norbert is ranked 11th in this week's poll.

The Green Knights have been ranked in 367 of 381 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

Prior to this season, the last USCHO.com Poll that did not have the Green Knights ranked was Jan. 15, 2001, the last of three consecutive polls without St. Norbert. The ranking held just 10 teams at the time and did not go to 15 teams until the 2002-03 season.

During the consecutive 325-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 94 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 148-58-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 6-8-1 all-time against the No. 1-

ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Ice Chips:

* - St. Norbert has scored the first goal 14 times and its opponents have scored 14 times. The Green Knights are 9-3-2 when scoring first and 8-6 when their opponent scores first.

* - St. Norbert is 5-5 this season in one-goal games and is 2-3 in two-goal games. The Green Knights are 10-1 in games decided by at least three goals.

* - St. Norbert is 13-2 this season when leading after two periods. The Green Knights are 2-3-2 when trailing after 40 minutes and are 2-4 when tied at second intermission.

* - St. Norbert is 2-2-2 in overtime games this season, with wins over UW-Stevens Point and MSOE and losses to Marian and Adrian.
