St. Norbert opens Northern Collegiate Hockey Association action with a two-game home series against Lake Forest. The Green Knights are the pre-season favorite in the NCHA Coaches' Poll to repeat as league champions, while the Foresters are pegged for sixth.

The Series:

St. Norbert has played Lake Forest 75 times, and holds a 49-21-5 advantage in a series begun in the 1988-89 season. Lake Forest won the first 14 games in the series, with St. Norbert posting a 49-7-5 ledger since.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 580-148-56 in his 27th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 436-79-39 in the last 18-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Lake Forest coach Patrick Kelliher (St. Lawrence, 2010) is 69-53-14 in his sixth season in Lake Forest.

Last Season:

St. Norbert and Lake Forest battled to a 1-1 tie on Jan. 4, 2019 at Cornerstone Community Center in the only matchup last year between the two teams.

The game featured just three total penalties, with the Foresters going 0-for-2 on the power play and St. Norbert 0-for-1.

Brad Pung scored at 1:46 of the second period, just six seconds after St. Norbert's only power play of the game expired. That marker held up until Lake Forest's Aaron O'Neill scored an extra-attacker goal with 48 seconds remaining in the third period.

St. Norbert outshot Lake Forest 30-21. T.J. Black made 20 saves for the Green Knights, while George Argiropoulos made 29 stops for the Foresters.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert heads into this weekend's series at 1-1 overall. The Green Knights are ranked No. 3 in this week's USCHO.com Division III Poll after splitting a pair of games with No. 1 UW-Stevens Point last weekend. The Green Knights won 3-2 in overtime last Friday in Stevens Point before dropping Saturday's game in De Pere by a 3-1 count.

Senior forward Dominick Sacco has two goals for two points. Junior forward Peter Bates has one goal

and one assist for two points, while freshman defenseman Brendan Aird has one goal for one point. Six different skaters have one assist for one point.

Junior goaltender Ryan Bontorin is 1-1 with a 2.54 goals against average and .907 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 0-for-10 (0.0 percent) on the power play and is 8-for-9 (88.9 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters the series with a 1-0-1 overall record. The Foresters tied St. Mary's 3-3 last Friday before gaining a 4-3 win over the Cardinals last Saturday in Winona, Minn.

Junior forward Aaron O'Neill has one goal and three assists for four points. Freshman forward David Cohen has two goals and one assist for three points, while senior forward Austin Aksoy has one goal and one assist for two points. Senior defenseman Zach Feldman and junior defenseman Mark DerManulian each have two assists for two points.

Junior goaltender Boyd DiClemente is 1-0-1 with a 2.88 goals against average and .900 save percentage.

Lake Forest is 2-for-8 (25.0 percent) on the power play and is 7-for-9 (77.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Series Stuff:

St. Norbert and Lake Forest have met 75 times in an all-time series dating back to the 1988-89 season.

The only opponent the Green Knights have met more often than the Foresters is UW-Stevens Point, checking in at 78 games after last weekend's two-game series.

St. Norbert has met St. Scholastica 74 times for third on the all-time list. The Green Knights have played UW-Superior 69 times and UW-Eau Claire and UW-River Falls 61 times apiece to round out the top five.

The only other current NCHA member St. Norbert has played at

least 40 times is Lawrence, which has played 50 games against the Green Knights.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 323 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 361 of 367 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 323-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 85 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 146-57-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 6-8-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 261-31-15 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, going 241-23-12 in its last 276 games there.

The Green Knights had a 43-game unbeaten streak at the Cornerstone snapped in a 3-1 loss to No. 1-ranked UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 2, 2019. St. Norbert had gone 40-0-3 since a 4-2 loss to Concordia-Wis., on Jan. 27, 2017.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 340-53-21 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice

Arena.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 580-148-57 in his 27th season. Coghlin is in 16th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Residing in 15th place on the all-time list is George Gwozdecky, who went 593-391-85 in 27 seasons at Denver, Miami and UW-River Falls from 1982 to 2013. New Hampshire's Dick Umile is in 14th place with a 594-375-114 record in 28 seasons from 1991 to 2018.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Tough After Two:

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 304-2-4 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 322-3-5 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 23 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such record in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped in 2016 with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

St. Norbert has 21 20-win seasons under Coghlin's supervision, all coming in the last 23 years.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 45-1 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 311-2-7 over their last 320 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 7-30-6 in its last 43 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a 6-5 win at St. Scholastica on Feb. 1, 2019.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 30 times in their last 525 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 784-game tenure.
