2017-18 season. The Green Knights are 2-0 all-time in Angola, and this weekend marks the first time they will play a two-game weekend series at Thunder Ice Arena.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 580-150-56 in his 27th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 436-81-39 in the last 18-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Trine coach Alex Todd (Union, 2001) is 19-31-4 in his third season in Angola. He was 114-78-21 in eight seasons at Castleton State to give him a career record of 133-109-25.

Last Season:

St. Norbert blanked Trine 4-0 on Nov. 9, 2018 at Thunder Ice Arena in Angola, Ind. Riley Christensen registered a natural hat trick while Peter Bates added the other goal. T.J. Black made 16 saves for the Green Knights, while Brett Young made 34 stops for the Thunder.

St. Norbert them tipped Trine 3-2 on Jan. 26, 2019 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. Keegan Milligan, Bates and Peyton Frantti scored power-play goals for St. Norbert, while Alex Johanson and Michael Meisenbacher scored for the Thunder. Young made 26 saves for Trine, while Black had 29 stops for St. Norbert.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert heads into this weekend's series at 1-3 overall and 0-2 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights were swept at home this past weekend by Lake Forest by scores of 1-0 and 4-3 to drop to No. 10 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll.

Junior forward Peter Bates leads the Green Knights in scoring with two goals and two assists for four points. Senior forward Dominick Sacco has two goals for two points, while freshman forward Michael Spethmann has two assists for two points. Three Green Knights have one goal, while seven others have one assist.

Junior goaltender Ryan Bontorin is 1-3 with a 2.54 goals against average and .900 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 0-for-17 (0.0 percent) on the power play and is 15-for-19 (78.9 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Thunder:

Trine enters the series with a 3-1 overall record and a 2-0 ledger in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Thunder is coming off a series sweep at Lawrence this past weekend, winning by scores of 1-0 and 5-2.

Junior forward Corey Robertson has one goal and four assists for five points, while freshman defenseman Brad Jenion has four goals for four points. Sophomore forward Garrett Hallford has three goals and one assist for four points. Senior defenseman Henry Hearon has four assists for four points.

Senior goaltender Brett Young is 3-1 with a 1.76 goals against average and .914 save percentage.

Trine is 3-for-22 (13.6 percent) on the power play and is 22-for-25 (88.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Pitchers' Duels:

St. Norbert played in a rare 1-0 game when the Green Knights lost to Lake Forest by that score this past Friday in De Pere.

In 898 all-time games, the Green Knights have played just six 1-0 games, going 2-4 in those contests. The 1-0 game against Lake Forest was the first for the Green Knights in nearly 12 years.

St. Norbert's two 1-0 wins in program history came with highly decorated goaltender Kyle Jones between the pipes. Jones made 28 saves in a 1-0 win over St.

Scholastica in the semifinals of the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs on March 1, 2008. He also made 14 stops in a 1-0 win over UW-Superior on Jan. 21, 2006. Both games were at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Interestingly, Lake Forest and Middlebury own all four 1-0 wins over the Green Knights, each owning two. In addition to last Friday's game, the Foresters earned a 1-0 win on Nov. 5, 1999 in Lake Forest, Ill. Middlebury won 1-0 games over St. Norbert on Dec. 2, 2000 at Cornerstone Community Center and on March 20, 2004 at Kreitzberg Arena in Northfield, Vt., in the NCAA Division III national championship game.

St. Norbert has played just three scoreless ties in its history - on Jan. 27, 1995 against UW-Stevens Point at De Pere Ice Arena, on Feb. 3, 2012 at UW-Superior and on Jan. 8, 2015 at St. John's.

Since the start of the 1997-98 season, St. Norbert has been shutout just 12 times - a stretch of 680 games. Four of those have come in the 1-0 losses.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 324 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 362 of 368 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 324-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 86 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 146-57-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 6-8-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-

ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 580-150-57 in his 27th season. Coghlin is in 16th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Residing in 15th place on the all-time list is George Gwozdecky, who went 593-391-85 in 27 seasons at Denver, Miami and UW-River Falls from 1982 to 2013. New Hampshire's Dick Umile is in 14th place with a 594-375-114 record in 28 seasons from 1991 to 2018.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Tough After Two:

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 304-2-4 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 322-3-5 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 23 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such record in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped in 2016 with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

St. Norbert has 21 20-win seasons under Coghlin's supervision, all coming in the last 23 years.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 45-1 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 311-2-7 over their last 320 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 7-30-6 in its last 43 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a 6-5 win at St. Scholastica on Feb. 1,

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 30 times in their last 527 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 786-game tenure.
