The Series:

St. Norbert leads Marian 28-2-2 in a series which began in the 1996-97 season. The Green Knights are 16-1-1 at home in the series and 11-1-1 in Fond du Lac. One game was played on neutral ice.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 581-151-56 in his 27th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 437-82-39 in the last 18-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Marian coach Zach Gaynor (Marian, 2008) is 36-21-5 in his third season in Fond du Lac.

Last Season:

St. Norbert tripped Marian 5-0 in a battle of nationally ranked teams on Dec. 1, 2018 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. Five different players scored goals for the Green Knights, with Peyton Frantti scoring one goal and one assist. T.J. Black made 15 saves for the Green Knights, while Hunter Vorva made 28 stops for the Sabres.

Marian then defeated St. Norbert 3-1 on Jan. 11, 2019 at Blue Line Family Ice Center in Fond du Lac. The Sabres scored three first-period goals 4:41 apart. Evan Cholak scored St. Norbert's lone goal at 17:15 of the third period. Vorva made 32 saves for the Sabres, while Black turned away 31 shots for the Green Knights.

St. Norbert defeated Marian 6-2 on Feb. 23, 2019 at Cornerstone Community Center in a NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs semifinal. The Green Knights snapped a 1-1 tie with five third-period goals. Frantti scored two goals and Luke Davison had three assists for the Green Knights. Black made 13 saves for St. Norbert while Vorva turned away 30 shots for the Sabres.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert heads into this week-

end at 2-4 overall and 1-3 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights split at Trine this past weekend, winning 5-3 before dropping the second game 2-0.

Junior forward Peter Bates tops the Green Knights in scoring with three goals and three assists for six points. Senior forward Kurt Black has two goals and two assists for four points. Junior forward Tim Nicksic has two goals and one assist for three points, while freshman forward Michael Spethmann has one goal and two assists for three points. Sophomore forward Peyton Frantti has three assists for three points.

Junior goaltender Ryan Bontorin is 2-4 with a 2.36 goals against average and .910 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 0-for-24 (0.0 percent) on the power play and is 21for-26 (80.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Sabres:

Marian enters the weekend with a 2-3 overall record and a 1-3 slate in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Sabres were swept in a home-and-home series with Lake Forest this past weekend, falling at home 2-1 before dropping a 6-4 road decision.

Sophomore forward Gianni Vitali tops Marian with two goals and three assists for five points. Senior forward Clay Cross has one goal and four assists for five points. Sophomore defenseman Salvatore Scalise has five assists for five points. Sophomore defenseman Nathan Walker and sophomore forward Blaine Caton each have three goals and one assist for five points.

Senior goaltender Hunter Vorva is 1-2 with a 3.42 goals against average and .868 save percentage. Freshman Dawson Rodin is 0-1 with a 4.16 goals against average and .872 save percentage.

Marian is 3-for-18 (16.7 percent) on the power play and is 13-for-20 (65.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the

USCHO.com Division III Poll for 325 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 363 of 369 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

The Green Knights barely kept the streak alive with a No. 15 ranking in this week's poll. The last USCHO.com Poll that did not have the Green Knights ranked was Jan. 15, 2001, the last of three consecutive polls without St. Norbert. The ranking held just 10 teams at the time and did not go to 15 teams until the 2002-03 season.

During the 325-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 87 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 146-57-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 6-8-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 261-33-15 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, going 241-25-12 in its last 276 games there.

The Green Knights had a 43-game unbeaten streak at the Cornerstone snapped in a 3-1 loss to No. 1ranked UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 2, 2019. St. Norbert had gone 40-0-3 since a 4-2 loss to Concordia-Wis., on Jan. 27, 2017.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the secondlongest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 340-55-21 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 581-151-57 in his 27th season. Coghlin is in 16th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Residing in 15th place on the alltime list is George Gwozdecky, who went 593-391-85 in 27 seasons at Denver, Miami and UW-River Falls from 1982 to 2013. New Hampshire's Dick Umile is in 14th place with a 594-375-114 record in 28 seasons from 1991 to 2018.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Tough After Two:

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 304-2-4 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 322-3-5 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

has directed the Green Knights to 23 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such record in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped in 2016 with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

St. Norbert has 21 20-win seasons under Coghlin's supervision, all coming in the last 23 years.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 46-1 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 312-2-7 over their last 321 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 7-30-6 in its last 43 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a 6-5 win at St. Scholastica on Feb. 1, 2019.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 30 times in their last 529 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 788-game tenure.

Ice Chips:

* - Since the start of the 1997-98 season, St. Norbert has been shutout just 13 times - a stretch of 682 games. Four of those have come in 1-0 losses.
