The Series:

St. Norbert leads Stevenson 1-0 in a series begun in the 2018-19 season.

St. Norbert leads Neumann 1-0 in a series begun in the 2018-19 season.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 581-153-56 in his 27th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 437-84-39 in the last 18-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Stevenson coach Dominick Dawes (Norwich, 2004) is 36-38-9 in his fourth season in Stevenson. Including eight seasons at Neumann, Dawes is 143-100-34 in 11 overall seasons. Dawes led Neumann to the 2009 NCAA Division III championship. Dawes, St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin and UW-Stevens Point coach Tyler Krueger are the only three people to win an NCAA Division III national championship as a player and coach.

Neumann coach Kyle Mountain (Nebraska-Omaha, 2015) is 18-34-6 in his third season in Aston.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert defeated Stevenson 3-0 on Nov. 23, 2018 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. Kurt black scored a pair of second-period goals while Luke Davison added a third-period marker for the Green Knights. T.J. Black made 30 stops for St. Norbert in the shutout win, while Riley McVeigh turned away 30 shots for the Mustangs.

St. Norbert topped Neumann 4-1 on Nov. 24, 2018 at the Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. Thomas Mansbridge put Neumann ahead with an early power-play goal, but a goal by Peter Bates knotted the score at 1-1 after one period. Steven Phillips scored in the second period for St. Norbert, while Tim Nicksic converted a penalty shot and Kurt Black had a goal in the third period. Ryan Bontorin made 27 saves for St. Norbert, while

Sammy Bernard had 41 saves for Neumann.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert heads into this weekend at 2-6 overall. The Green Knights dropped a tough Northern Collegiate Hockey Association series with Marian this past weekend, falling 4-0 Friday in Fond du Lac before suffering a heartbreaking 2-1 overtime loss Saturday at home.

Junior forward Peter Bates leads the Green Knights in scoring with four goals and three assists for seven points. Senior forward Kurt Black has two goals and two assists for four points, while sophomore forward Peyton Frantti has four assists for four points. Junior forward Tim Nicksic has two goals and one assist for three points. Freshman forward Michael Spethmann and freshman defenseman Brendan Mark each have one goal and two assists for three points.

Junior goaltender Ryan Bontorin is 2-6 with a 2.38 goals against average and .913 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 0-for-39 (0.0 percent) on the power play and is 34-for-41 (82.9 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Mustangs:

Stevenson enters the weekend at 5-1 overall. The Mustangs are coming off a pair of United Collegiate Hockey Conference wins this past weekend, winning 5-0 at Manhattanville on Friday and 6-1 at Neumann on Saturday.

Sophomore forward Ryan Patrick leads Stevenson in scoring with two goals and nine assists for 11 points. Senior forward Nick Gray has seven goals and two assists for nine points. Freshman forward Austin Master has seven assists for seven points, while senior forward Dominic Brenza has one goal and five assists for six points.

Freshman goaltender Ryan Kenny has a 3-0 record with a 0.67 goals against average and .968 save percentage. Junior Dylan Schoen is 2-1 with a 2.37 goals against average and .896 save percentage.

Stevenson is 10-for-34 (29.4 percent) on the power play and is 24-for-27 (88.9 percent) on the penalty

kill this season.

About the Knights:

Neumann enters Friday's game with Lawrence 2-4 overall. The Knights split a pair of home United Collegiate Hockey Conference games this past weekend, beating Chatham 5-3 on Friday before falling to Stevenson 6-1 on Saturday.

Junior forward Zac Boyle leads the Knights in scoring with four goals and two assists for six points. Junior forward Barry Kneidler has four goals and one assist for five points. Senior forward Eric Madison and junior defenseman Richie Brusco each have one goal and three assists for four points.

Junior goaltender Mike Cosentino is 1-3 with a 4.82 goals against average and .875 save percentage. Sophomore Kyle Pantelone is 1-1 with a 4.04 goals against average and .875 save percentage.

Neumann is 4-for-26 (15.4 percent) on the power play and is 28-for-39 (71.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Eastern Eavesdroppings:

St. Norbert is 36-19-6 all-time against East Region opponents. The Green Knights played at least one game a season against an eastern foe for 18 years before not facing one in 2012-13 as well as 2013-14 until beating Geneseo State 6-2 on March 21, 2014 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four. St. Norbert then resumed facing an East Region foe with home-and-home series with Buffalo State in 2014-15 and 2015-16. The Green Knights went 2-1-1 in a home-and-home series Manhattanville in 2016-17 and 2017-18.

St. Norbert is 23-11-4 all-time on East Region ice, which includes eight neutral-site visits to the Frozen Four in 2008, 2010, 2012, 2016 and 2018 in Lake Placid, N.Y., in 2006 to Elmira, N.Y., in 2014 to Lewiston, Maine and in 2017 to Utica, N.Y.

The Green Knights are 17-8-3 all-time in the State of New York. The record includes five visits to the Frozen Four at Herb Brooks Arena in Lake Placid and one Frozen Four trip each to First Arena in Elmira and Memorial Auditorium in Utica.

St. Norbert is 8-2 all-time at Herb Brooks Arena.

The Green Knights are 14-3-2 all-time against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Plattsburgh State, 1-0 against Geneseo State and a 2-2 ledger against Oswego State. St. Norbert is 4-1-1 all-time against Fredonia State and 5-0-1 against Buffalo State.

St. Norbert is 9-6-3 all-time against the United Collegiate Hockey Conference (formerly known as the ECAC West) opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 4-6 all-time against the NESCAC (2-4 vs. Middlebury, 1-0 vs. Amherst and Colby and 0-1 vs. Trinity and Williams).

The Green Knights are 2-0 all-time against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season. The Green Knights are 1-0 against the Commonwealth Coast Conference.

St. Norbert is 5-3 against the New England Hockey Conference (formerly known as ECAC East), going 3-3 against Norwich and 1-0 against UMass-Boston and Southern Maine.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert saw its unprecedented streak of being ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll end at 325 consecutive weeks after being unranked this week.

The Green Knights have been ranked in 363 of 370 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

The last USCHO.com Poll that did not have the Green Knights ranked was Jan. 15, 2001, the last of three consecutive polls without St. Norbert. The ranking held just 10 teams at the time and did not go to 15 teams until the 2002-03 season.

During the 325-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 88 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 146-57-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com

Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 6-8-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 581-153-57 in his 27th season. Coghlin is in 16th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Residing in 15th place on the all-time list is George Gwozdecky, who went 593-391-85 in 27 seasons at Denver, Miami and UW-River Falls from 1982 to 2013. New Hampshire's Dick Umile is in 14th place with a 594-375-114 record in 28 seasons from 1991 to 2018.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 46-1 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 312-2-7 over their last 321 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 7-30-6 in its last 43 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a 6-5 win at St. Scholastica on Feb. 1, 2019.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 30 times in their last 531 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 790-game tenure.
