The Series:

St. Norbert leads Concordia-Wisconsin 10-2 in an all-time series dating back to the 2011-12 campaign.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 582-154-56 in his 27th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 438-85-39 in the last 18-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Concordia coach Jasen Wise (St. Thomas, 1996) is 77-99-14 in his eighth season in Mequon. Wise went 117-88-14 coaching at Marian for eight seasons for an overall record of 197-186-28 in 16 seasons.

Last Meeting:

In the only meeting between the two teams last season, St. Norbert tripped Concordia Wisconsin 3-2 in overtime at Ozaukee Ice Center in Mequon.

Nick Guerra gave Concordia a 1-0 lead after one period before St. Norbert answered in the second with goals by Riley Christensen and Brad Pung. Guerra tied the game at 6:44 of the third period before St. Norbert won it on a Kurt Black goal with 39 seconds remaining in overtime.

T.J. Black made 23 saves for St. Norbert, while Dakota Delbridge made 30 stops for the Falcons.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert heads into the series at 3-7 overall and 1-5 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights split a pair of games out east this past weekend, falling to Stevenson 6-5 last Friday before rebounding to top Neumann 8-2 on Saturday.

Junior forward Peter Bates heads up the Green Knights in scoring with four goals and eight assists for 12 points. Senior forward Kurt Black has seven goals and four assists for 11 points, while sophomore forward Peyton Frantti has three goals and eight assists for 11 points. Junior forward Tim Nicksic has two goals and three assists for five points. Freshman forward Ben Schmidling has three goals and one assist for four points.

Junior goaltender Ryan Bontorin is 2-7 with a 2.79 goals against average and .899 save percentage. Freshman Colby Entz is 1-0 with a 2.00 goals against average and .933 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 2-for-47 (4.3 percent) on the power play and is 39-for-49 (79.6 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Falcons:

Concordia enters the series at 5-2-1 overall and 2-1-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Falcons won a pair of non-conference road games this past weekend, defeating Bethel 6-0 last Friday before topping UW-Stevens Point 5-4 on Saturday.

Junior forward Braydon Barker leads the Falcons in scoring with three goals and 10 assists for 13 points. Junior forward Nick Guiney has four goals and five assists for nine points, while junior forward Cole Pickup has two goals and seven assists for nine points. Freshman forward Brandon Picard has five goals and three assists for eight points. Junior forward Nick Guerra has four goals and four assists for eight points.

Sophomore goaltender Bo Didur is 5-2-1 with a 2.90 goals against average and .927 save percentage. Junior Dakota Delbridge is 0-0 with a 6.14 goals against average and .850 save percentage.

Concordia is 8-for-39 (20.5 percent) on the power play and is 35-for-39 (89.7 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 261-34-15 all-time at the Cornerstone Community

Center, going 241-26-12 in its last 276 games there.

St. Norbert is off to an 0-4 start at the Cornerstone this year, its first four-game home losing streak in 24 years. The Green Knights last lost four straight at home during the 1995-96 season, dropping one game each to Mercyhurst and UW-Stevens Point and a two-game series with Bemidji State. St. Norbert has not lost five straight home games since 1989-90, which was a six-game skid dating back to 1988-89.

St. Norbert has lost four home games in a season at the Cornerstone just twice - a 13-4-1 mark in 2012-13 and a 9-4-1 ledger in 2000-01, the first year in the building. At the De Pere Ice Arena, the Green Knights were 17-5 in 1997-98, 8-5-1 in 1995-96 and 7-4-2 in 1994-95.

The Green Knights had a 43-game unbeaten streak at the Cornerstone snapped in a 3-1 loss to No. 1-ranked UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 2, 2019. St. Norbert had gone 40-0-3 since a 4-2 loss to Concordia-Wis., on Jan. 27, 2017.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 340-56-21 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert saw its unprecedented streak of being ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll end at 325 consecutive weeks after being unranked on Nov. 25.

The Green Knights have been ranked in 363 of 371 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

Perior to this season, the last

USCHO.com Poll that did not have the Green Knights ranked was Jan. 15, 2001, the last of three consecutive polls without St. Norbert. The ranking held just 10 teams at the time and did not go to 15 teams until the 2002-03 season.

During the 325-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 88 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 146-57-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 6-8-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2-ranked team.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 582-154-57 in his 27th season. Coghlin is in 16th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Residing in 15th place on the alltime list is George Gwozdecky, who went 593-391-85 in 27 seasons at Denver, Miami and UW-River Falls from 1982 to 2013. New Hampshire's Dick Umile is in 14th place with a 594-375-114 record in 28 seasons from 1991 to 2018.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 23 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such record in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped in 2016 with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

St. Norbert has 21 20-win seasons under Coghlin's supervision, all coming in the last 23 years.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 46-2 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 313-3-7 over their last 323 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 7-31-6 in its last 44 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a 6-5 win at St. Scholastica on Feb. 1,

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 31 times in their last 533 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 792-game tenure.
