The Series:

St. Norbert leads MSOE in the all-time series 15-4, which began with a 4-2 Green Knights' win on Jan. 7, 2006 in Milwaukee. The Green Knights have lost their last three games at the Kern Center.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 584-154-56 in his 27th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 440-85-39 in the last 18-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

MSOE coach Graham Johnson (Rhode Island, 2007) is 16-15-6 in his second season in Milwaukee.

Last Season:

St. Norbert tripped MSOE 5-0 on Oct. 27, 2018 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. Five different Green Knights scored goals as St. Norbert led 4-0 after two periods. T.J. Black made 14 saves for St. Norbert for his 13th career shutout. Rock Boynton made 31 stops for the Raiders.

MSOE returned the favor with a 3-2 overtime win over the Green Knights on Nov. 3, 2018 at Kern Center in Milwaukee. St. Norbert held a 2-0 lead after two periods on goals by Roman Uchyn and Dominick Sacco, but the Raiders got power-play goals in the third period from Garrett Gintoli and Kevin Shand to tie it. Adam Ostrowski scored at 2:53 of overtime for the game-winner. Black made 21 saves for St. Norbert, while Boynton made 35 stops for MSOE.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series at 5-7 overall and 3-5 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights have been idle since the weekend of Dec. 6-7, when they swept Concordia Wisconsin by a

score of 7-1 in De Pere and 5-4 in Mequon.

Junior forward Peter Bates holds the team lead in scoring with five goals and 12 assists for 17 points. Sophomore forward Peyton Frantti has six goals and nine assists for 15 points, while senior forward Kurt Black has a team-high eight goals with five assists for 13 points. Senior forward Dominick Sacco has four goals and six assists for 10 points.

Junior goaltender Ryan Bontorin is 3-7 with a 2.91 goals against average and .897 save percentage. Freshman Colby Entz is 2-0 with a 1.50 goals against average and .939 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 6-for-53 (11.3 percent) on the power play and is 41-for-53 (77.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Raiders:

Milwaukee School of Engineering enters the series 6-2-2 overall and 1-2-2 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Raiders have been idle since Dec. 6-7 when they took just one point at Finlandia in a 2-2 tie and 3-1 loss.

Freshman forward Matt Hanewall leads the Raiders in scoring with seven goals for seven points. Junior forward Stian Owens has three goals and three assists for six points. Freshman forward Kyle Herbster has one goal and five assists for six points, while junior forward Garrett Gintoli has six assists for six points.

Junior goaltender Logan Halladay is 6-2-1 with a 1.87 goals against average and .926 save percentage. Junior Rock Boynton is 0-0-1 with a 1.85 goals against average and .895 save percentage.

MSOE is 6-for-55 (10.9 percent) on the power play and is 39-for-44 (88.6 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Goal Gossip:

In its last four games before the semester break, St. Norbert scored 25 total goals. This came on the

heels of scoring just 13 goals in its first eight games en route to an uncharacteristic 2-6 start.

The Green Knights broke out of their scoring slump with a 6-5 loss to Stevenson on Nov. 29, but then scored eight times in an 8-2 win at Neumann the next day. St. Norbert then scored 12 goals in a series sweep of Concordia Wisconsin, winning 7-1 and 5-4.

Sophomore forward Peyton Frantti has scored six goals and five assists for 11 points in the last four games, while junior forward Peter Bates has one goal and nine assists for 10 points. Senior forward Kurt Black has six goals and three assists for nine points, while senior forward Dominick Sacco has two goals and six assists for eight points in that stretch.

Bates was the only Green Knights with more than four points in the first eight games, scoring four goals and three assists for seven points.

In its last four games, St. Norbert is 6-for-14 on the power play, good for 42.9 percent. The Green Knights were 0-for-39 with the man advantage in their first eight games.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 262-34-15 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, going 242-26-12 in its last 280 games there.

St. Norbert dropped its first four home games this season, its first four-game home losing streak in 24 years. The Green Knights last lost four straight at home during the 1995-96 season, dropping one game each to Mercyhurst and UW-Stevens Point and a two-game series with Bemidji State. St. Norbert has not lost five straight home games since 1989-90, which was a six-game skid dating back to 1988-89.

St. Norbert has lost four home games in a season at the Cornerstone just twice - a 13-4-1 mark in 2012-13 and a 9-4-1 ledger in 2000-01, the first year in the building. At the De Pere Ice Arena, the Green Knights were 17-5 in

1997-98, 8-5-1 in 1995-96 and 7-4-2 in 1994-95.

The Green Knights had a 43-game unbeaten streak at the Cornerstone snapped in a 3-1 loss to No. 1-ranked UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 2, 2019. St. Norbert had gone 40-0-3 since a 4-2 loss to Concordia-Wis., on Jan. 27, 2017.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 341-56-21 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 584-154-57 in his 27th season. Coghlin is in 16th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Residing in 15th place on the all-time list is George Gwozdecky, who went 593-391-85 in 27 seasons at Denver, Miami and UW-River Falls from 1982 to 2013. New Hampshire's Dick Umile is in 14th place with a 594-375-114 record in 28 seasons from 1991 to 2018.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 23 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such record in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped in 2016 with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

St. Norbert has 21 20-win seasons under Coghlin's supervision, all coming in the last 23 years.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 48-2 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 315-3-7 over their last 325 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 7-31-6 in its last 44 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a 6-5 win at St. Scholastica on Feb. 1, 2019.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 31 times in their last 535 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 792-game tenure.
