The Series:

St. Norbert leads Aurora 6-0 in an all-time series begun in the 2015-16 season. The Green Knights are 3-0 at Aurora in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 586-154-56 in his 27th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 442-85-39 in the last 18-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Aurora coach Jason Bloomingburg (Wayne State, 2006) is 21-48-8 in his fourth season in Aurora.

Last Season:

St. Norbert topped Aurora 5-1 on Jan. 5, 2019 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere in last season's lone matchup between the Green Knights and Spartans.

Aurora's Larry Jungwirth scored the first period's only goal before the Green Knights responded. Roman Uchyn and Riley Christensen scored in the second period, while Brendon Gysbers, Dominick Sacco and Keegan Milligan potted goals in the third period for the Green Knights.

St. Norbert outshot Aurora 40-25. T.J. Black made 24 saves for the Green Knights, while Josh Boyko turned away 35 shots for the Spartans.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series at 7-7 overall and 5-5 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights have won five consecutive games, including 3-2 overtime and 7-3 wins over Milwaukee School of Engineering in a home-and-home series this past weekend.

Junior forward Peter Bates leads

the Green Knights in scoring with six goals and 14 assists for 20 points. Senior forward Kurt Black has a team-high 11 goals with six assists for 17 points, while sophomore forward Peyton Frantti has seven goals and 10 assists for 17 points. Senior forward Dominick Sacco is the only other Green Knights scoring in double figures with four goals and nine assists for 13 points.

Junior goaltender Ryan Bontorin is 3-7 with a 2.91 goals against average and .897 save percentage. Freshman Colby Entz is 4-0 with a 1.98 goals against average and .931 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 8-for-59 (13.6 percent) on the power play and is 48for-63 (76.2 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Spartans:

Aurora enters the series 9-5-1 overall and 5-4-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Spartans have been idle since Dec. 13-14, when they fell at Augsburg 3-1 before defeating St. Thomas 2-0.

Freshman forward Adam Keves leads Aurora in scoring with three goals and 14 assists for 17 points. Sophomore forward Riley Doyon has nine goals and seven assists for 16 points, while sophomore forward Connor Chilton has eight goals and seven assists for 15 points. Sophomore forward Larry Jungwirth has four goals and 10 assists for 14 points, with sophomore defenseman Brayden Sampson totaling three goals and eight assists for 11 points.

Junior goaltender Josh Boyko is the only netminder to see action for Aurora this season. Boyko is 9-5-1 with a 1.72 goals against average and .935 save percentage.

Aurora is 16-for-82 (19.5 percent) on the power play and is 61-for-70 (87.1 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Goal Gossip:

In its last six games, St. Norbert

scored 35 total goals for an average of 5.8 goals per game. This came on the heels of scoring just 13 goals in its first eight games en route to an uncharacteristic 2-6 start.

The Green Knights broke out of their scoring slump with a 6-5 loss to Stevenson on Nov. 29, but then scored eight times in an 8-2 win at Neumann the next day. St. Norbert then scored 12 goals in a series sweep of Concordia Wisconsin, winning 7-1 and 5-4. The Green Knights have kept it going with 10 goals in a sweep of Milwaukee School of Engineering, winning by scores of 3-2 and 7-3.

Senior forward Kurt Black has scored nine goals and four assists for 13 points in his last six games. Sophomore forward Peyton Frantti has seven goals and six assists for 13 points, while junior forward Peter Bates has two goals and 11 assists Senior forward Dominick Sacco has two goals and nine assists for 11 points.

Bates was the only Green Knights with more then four points in the first eight games, scoring four goals and three assists for seven points.

In its last four games, St. Norbert is 8-for-20 on the power play, good for 40.0 percent. The Green Knights were 0-for-39 with the man advantage in their first eight games.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 586-154-57 in his 27th season. Coghlin is in 16th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Residing in 15th place on the alltime list is George Gwozdecky, who went 593-391-85 in 27 seasons at Denver, Miami and UW-River Falls from 1982 to 2013. New Hampshire's Dick Umile is in 14th place with a 594-375-114 record in 28 seasons from 1991 to 2018.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 23 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such record in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped in 2016 with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

St. Norbert has 21 20-win seasons under Coghlin's supervision, all coming in the last 23 years.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 49-2 since that loss to Stevens Point, making

them 316-3-7 over their last 326 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 7-31-6 in its last 44 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The last such win came in a 6-5 win at St. Scholastica on Feb. 1, 2019.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 31 times in their last 537 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 794-game tenure.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert saw its unprecedented streak of being ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll end at 325 consecutive weeks after being unranked on Nov. 25.

St. Norbert climbed back onto the poll's radar during its five-game winning streak, receiving 13 points to be listed in the "others receiving votes" category.

The Green Knights have been ranked in 363 of 373 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

Prior to this season, the last USCHO.com Poll that did not have the Green Knights ranked was Jan. 15, 2001, the last of three consecutive polls without St. Norbert. The ranking held just 10 teams at the time and did not go to 15 teams until the 2002-03 season.

During the 325-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 88 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 146-57-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 6-8-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2ranked team.
