## The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 586-154-58 in his 27th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 442-85-41 in the last 18-plus seasons. Coghlin's five national championships are the second most in Division III history, while his nine national title game appearances are tied for the most. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Adrian coach Adam Krug (Adrian, 2012) is 120-33-10 in his sixth season in Adrian.

## Last Season:

Adrian tipped St. Norbert 4-3 in overtime on Nov. 10, 2018 at Arrington Ice Arena in Adrian, Mich. The Green Knights led 3-0 after two periods before the Bulldogs rallied. Dominick Sacco scored two goals for St. Norbert, while Bryan Yim scored an extraattacker goal and the overtime game-winning marker for Adrian. T.J. Black made 30 saves for the Green Knights while Kevin Entmaa made 28 stops for the Bulldogs.

St. Norbert blanked Adrian 7-0 on Jan. 25, 2019 at Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. It was the first shutout for either team in the series. St. Norbert broke open a 2-0 game with five thirdperiod goals. Kurt Black, Timmy Nicksic and Peyton Frantti all had two goals apiece for the Green Knights. T.J. Black made 22 saves for St. Norbert, while Nikita Babintsev made 31 stops for the Bulldogs.

St. Norbert clipped Adrian 4-1 on March 2, 2019 for the NCHA Harris Cup title at Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights carried a 1-0 lead into the third period before pulling away. Timmy Nicksic scored a pair of markers for St. Norbert. T.J. Black made 31 saves for the Green Knights, while Kevin Entmaa had 32 stops for the Bulldogs.

## About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series at 7-7-2 overall and 5-5-2 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights are unbeaten in their last seven games, including a pair of 3-3 ties at Aurora this past weekend.

Junior forward Peter Bates leads the Green Knights and NCHA in scoring with seven goals and 16 assists for 23 points. Senior forward Kurt Black has a team-high 12 goals with eight assists for 20 points, while sophomore forward Peyton Frantti has nine goals and 11 assists for 20 points. Senior forward Dominick Sacco has five goals and nine assists for 14 points.

Freshman goaltender Colby Entz is 4-0-2 with a 2.25 goals against average and .918 save percentage. Junior Ryan Bontorin is 3-7 with a 2.91 goals against average and .897 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 8-for-67 (11.9 percent) on the power play and is 54for-72 (75.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

### About the Bulldogs:

Adrian, ranked No. 14 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, enters the series 8-4-3 overall and 6-2-2 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Bulldogs are coming off a pair of 4-4 ties this past weekend with Milwaukee School of Engineering.

Sophomore forward Andrew Bellant leads the Bulldogs with eight goals and 15 assists for 23 points. Sophomore forward Sam Ruffin has six goals and 15 assists for 21 points, while senior forward Dino Balsamo has 10 goals and nine assists for 19 points. Freshman forward Zachary Heintz has nine goals and nine assists for 18 points.

Junior goaltender Cameron Gray is 5-3-1 with a 2.86 goals against average and .889 save percentage. Freshman Nic Tallarico is 3-1-2 with a 2.60 goals against average

and .893 save percentage.

Adrian is 24-for-86 (27.9 percent) on the power play and is 68-for-84 (81.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

### Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 263-34-15 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, going 243-26-12 in its last 281 games there.

The Green Knights had a 43-game unbeaten streak at the Cornerstone snapped in a 3-1 loss to No. 1ranked UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 2, 2019. St. Norbert had gone 40-0-3 since a 4-2 loss to Concordia-Wis., on Jan. 27, 2017.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the secondlongest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 342-56-21 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

### **Coghlin Count:**

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin owns a record of 586-154-58 in his 27th season. Coghlin is in 16th place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches across all divisions.

Residing in 15th place on the alltime list is George Gwozdecky, who went 593-391-85 in 27 seasons at Denver, Miami and UW-River Falls from 1982 to 2013. New Hampshire's Dick Umile is in 14th place with a 594-375-114 record in 28 seasons from 1991 to 2018.

Coghlin is only the seventh coach in college hockey history to be at least 400 games over .500. Coghlin joins Jerry York (primarily Boston College), Ron Mason (primarily Michigan State), Jack Parker (Boston Univ.), Red Berenson (Michigan), Bob Peters (Bemidji State) and Bob Emery (Plattsburgh State) as those who reached that plateau.

The 2017-18 season marked the 11th time Coghlin has led the Green Knights to at least 25 wins in a season. According to available records, only two other coaches in Division III history have at least six such seasons. Norwich's Mike McShane had seven, while Emery has six.

### **Steady Study:**

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 23 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such record in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped in 2016 with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

St. Norbert has 21 20-win seasons under Coghlin's supervision, all coming in the last 23 years.

### **Gimme Five:**

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015 in the infamous "Net Game." The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 49-2 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 316-3-7 over their last 326 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 7-31-6 in its last 44

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 31 times in their last 539 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 798-game tenure.

# **Poll Position:**

St. Norbert saw its unprecedented streak of being ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll end at 325 consecutive weeks after being unranked on Nov. 25.

St. Norbert climbed back onto the poll's radar during its fivegame winning streak, receiving 13 points to be listed in the "others receiving votes" category on Jan. 6. The Green Knights are still receiving votes in this week's poll.

The Green Knights have been ranked in 363 of 374 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

Prior to this season, the last USCHO.com Poll that did not have the Green Knights ranked was Jan. 15, 2001, the last of three consecutive polls without St. Norbert. The ranking held just 10 teams at the time and did not go to 15 teams until the 2002-03 season.

During the 325-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 100 weeks - ahead of Norwich's 88 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2018 final polls. The Green Knights are 134-27-9 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 146-57-20 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 6-8-1 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 8-7-1 all-time when playing the No. 2ranked team.
