Montgomery made 35 saves for the Green Knights, while Kaitlyn Rolando made 37 for St. Benedict.

### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Rob Morgan (Alberta, 1992) is 12-11-4 in his second season in De Pere.

Entering Saturday's game at Marian, St. Benedict coach Jennifer Kranz (Providence, 2002) is 0-0-0 in her first year in St. Joseph.

### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters its second season of action coming off a successful inaugural campaign. The Green Knights finished 2010-11 with a 12-11-4 overall record in their first season on the ice and finished in a three-way tie for sixth in the NCHA at 9-8-3.

The Green Knights return 21 players from their first team. Sophomore forward Karissa Anderson is the leading returning scorer, having netted 12 goals and eight assists for 20 points. Sophomore forward Zoe Kurth, who won't join the team until the women's soccer season has finished, had 12 goals and five assists for 17 points and had six power-play goals. Sophomore forward Henriette Ostergaard also reached double digits in goals with 10, and added seven assists for 17 points.

Sophomore goaltender Kaley Gibson was a first-team All-NCHA selection last year. Gibson finished with a 7-7-3 record and a 1.93 goals against average with a .937 save percentage. Sophomore goaltenders Katie Aluia and Mandy Montgomery posted goals against averages last season of 1.78 and 2.26, respectively.

Last season, St. Norbert was 25-for-132 (18.9 percent) on the power play and was 109-for-118 (92.4 percent) on the penalty kill.

### About the Blazers:

St. Benedict enters Saturday's game at Marian coming off a 2010-11 that saw the Blazers finish 4-16-3 overall and an eighth-place record of 3-12-3 in the 10-team Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference.

The Blazers lost two of their top three scorers from last season. Senior forward Kerri Graske shared the team lead in scoring a year ago with five goals and five assists for 10 points. Senior forward Amie Ernst added five goals and two assists for seven points. Senior forward Kelly Fladebo and junior forward Ashley Olson had five goals apiece last season to share the team lead with Graske and Ernst.

Junior Kaitlyn Rolando is St. Benedict's lone returning goaltender. Rolando was 1-8-1 with a 3.38 goals against average and .902 save percentage a year ago.

Last season, St. Benedict was 12-for-99 (12.1 percent) on the power play and 104-for-130 (80.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

### Pre-Season Prognostications:

St. Norbert was picked by the NCHA coaches to fourth in this season's league pre-season poll.

Defending champion UW-River Falls received 10 first-place votes and 190 points. UW-Superior received the other first-place vote and totaled 162 points. Adrian was tabbed for third with 150 points, while St. Norbert was fourth with 136 points.

There was a large drop off in points between fourth and fifth, with UW-Stevens Point getting 98 points for the No. 5 spot. Lake Forest was sixth with 96 points, while UW-Eau Claire was seventh with 88 points. St. Scholastica was slotted eighth with 74 points.

Concordia-Wis. was ninth with 68 points, Finlandia tenth with 22 points and Marian 11th with 16 points.

### Ice Chips:

\* - Fifteen of St. Norbert's 23 non-tied games last year were decided by two goals or less. The Green Knights were 2-6 in one-goal games and are 4-3 in games decided by two goals.

\* - St. Norbert's penalty kill of 92.4 percent last season was good for third in the NCAA Division III national statistical rankings.
