The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Rob Morgan (Alberta, 1992) is 16-19-4 in his second season in De Pere.

Hamline coach Steve DeBus (Minnesota, 1998) is 7-23-4 in his second season in St. Paul.

St. Catherine coach Brad Marshall (St. Thomas, 1999) is 54-84-16 in his seventh season in St. Paul.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the non-conference weekend at 4-8 overall and 3-6 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights have been idle since Dec. 10, when they dropped a 3-0 decision at nationally ranked UW-River Falls. St. Norbert is looking for its first win since a 3-1 triumph over Concordia-Wis. on Nov. 30.

Freshman forward Ali Parker leads the Green Knights in scoring with four goals and three assists for seven points. Sophomore forward Karissa Anderson has three goals and four assists for seven points, but will miss the rest of the 2011-12 season due to injury. Sophomore forward Andrea Senne shares the team lead in goals at four, and also has two assists for six points. Freshman forward Jade Popescul has three goals and two assists for five points, while sophomore forward Henriette Ostergaard has two goals and three assists for five

Sophomore goaltender Katie Aluia possesses a 3-3 record and a 1.27 goals against average with a .945 save percentage. Sophomore Kaley Gibson is 1-4 with a 4.53 goals against average and .844 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 6-for-53 (11.3 percent) on the power play and is 43-for-56 (76.8 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Pipers:

Hamline enters the game with a 3-6-1 overall record and is 0-5-1 in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The Pipers'

last weekend series came on Dec. 9-10, when they swept Marian 3-2 and 1-0.

In Hamline's 10 games this season, it has scored more than one goal just twice, also beating UW-Superior 3-2 on Oct. 29. Freshman forward Corinne Henning leads the Pipers in scoring with two goals and three assists for five points. Junior forward Haley Johnson has two goals and two assists for four points, while freshman forward Jordan Verleye has two goals and one assist for three points. Junior forward Laura Randall has two assists for two points.

Freshman goaltender Sarah Schneekloth is 1-3-1 with a 2.18 goals against average and .921 save percentage. Senior Nicole Jones is 2-3 with a 1.80 goals against average and .943 save percentage.

Hamline is 1-for-35 (2.9 percent) on the power play and 29-for-34 (85.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Wildcats:

St. Catherine enters Friday's game at Concordia with a 5-2-2 overall record and a 3-1-2 mark in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The Wildcats have been off since a 4-3 loss to Concordia-Moorhead on Dec. 10.

Freshman forward Kasey Evans leads St. Catherine in scoring with nine goals and six assists for 15 points. Freshman forward Megan Killmer has seven goals and four assists for 11 points, while senior Kelsey Abrahamson had two goals and nine assists for 11 points. Senior forward Cassie Rooney has five goals and four assists for nine points.

Freshman netminder Samantha Geissler is 2-0-2 with a 2.54 goals against average and .919 save percentage. Freshman Haley Morningstar is 2-2 with a 3.44 goals against average and .856 save percentage.

St. Catherine is 14-for-49 (28.6 percent) on the power play and 23-for-28 (82.1 percent) on the penalty kill.
