In the opener, St. Norbert rallied from deficits of 3-0 and 4-1 to tie the game but Shana Katz's goal with 28 seconds left in regulation was the difference.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Rob Morgan (Alberta, 1992) is 17-20-4 in his second season in De Pere.

UW-Superior coach Dan Laughlin (UW-Superior, 1994) is 151-60-22 in his ninth season in Superior.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert enters the series with a 5-9 overall record and is 3-6 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights dropped a 2-1 decision to Hamline at home last Friday before rebounding to snap a five-game losing streak with a 7-5 triumph over St. Catherine on Saturday at the Resch Olympic Pavilion.

Freshman forward Ali Parker leads the Green Knights in scoring with four goals and three assists for seven points. Sophomore forward Andrea Senne shares the team lead in goals at four, and also has three assists for seven points. Freshman forward Jade Popescul has four goals and two assists for six points, while sophomore defenseman Lotta Haarala has one goal and a teamhigh five assists for six points.

Sophomore goaltender Katie Aluia possesses a 3-3 record and a 1.27 goals against average with a .945 save percentage. Sophomore Kaley Gibson is 1-4 with a 4.53 goals against average and .844 save percentage. Sophomore Mandy Montgomery is 1-2 with an .891 save percentage and 4.02 goals against average.

St. Norbert is 7-for-59 (11.9 percent) on the power play and is 48-for-63 (76.2 percent) on the penalty kill.

#### **About the Yellowjackets:**

UW-Superior, ranked No. 9 in this week's USCHO.com Division III Poll, enters the series with a 6-4-2 overall record and a 5-2-1 mark in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Yellowjackets end a 31-day idle stretch this weekend. Superior's last game came in a 1-0 loss to Gustavus Adolphus on Dec. 13.

Sophomore forward Kelsey

Firkus leads Superior in scoring with four goals and eight assists for 12 points. Freshman forward Dani Schultz has a team-high nine goals with two assists for 11 points. Sophomore forward Kerry Mayhew has four goals and six assists for 10 points. Sophomore defenseman Sheryl Kaskiw has a team-high 10 assists for 10 points.

Senior goaltender Amy Torgerson is 3-2-1 with a 1.47 goals against average and .935 save percentage. Sophomore Shanley Peters is 3-2-1 with a 1.47 goals against average and .927 save percentage. Both netminders have made six starts.

Superior is 11-for-51 (21.6 percent) on the power play and 38-for-44 (86.4 percent) on the penalty kill.

#### Goal Gusher:

St. Norbert had a scoring avalanche in this past Saturday's 7-5 win over St. Catherine, a triumph that snapped a five-game losing streak for the Green Knights.

During those five games, St. Norbert had scored just four goals. Entering the St. Catherine game, the Green Knights had registered just 26 markers on the season. St. Norbert scored 21.2 percent of its season goals total of 33 against St. Catherine.

St. Norbert's four first-period goals marked the first time the Green Knights have lit the lamp that many times in the first 20 minutes of action. The 12 combined goals in the game also set a school record.

Six different players scored goals for the Green Knights in the game, with Danielle Rozon scoring twice. Taylor Giacin, Zoe Kurth, Tara Frey, Emma Agen and Jade Popescul all scored one goal apiece.

It was the fourth time in program history St. Norbert scored at least seven goals in a game. The Green Knights had totals of 10 and eight against Marian last season, and also had nine in a game against Finlandia one year ago.
