#### The Series:

St. Mary's leads St. Norbert 2-0 in a series begun in 2010-11. The Cardinals topped the Green Knights 2-1 at the Resch Olympic Pavilion on Oct. 30, 2010. St. Mary's rallied from a 3-1 deficit after two periods to score four third-period goals en route to a 5-3 win over St. Norbert last Nov. 4 at the SMU Ice Arena in Winona, Minn.

This is the first meeting between St. Norbert and Concordia-Moorhead in women's ice hockey.

### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Rob Morgan (Alberta, 1992) is 25-25-4 entering his third season in De Pere.

St. Mary's coach Terry Mannor (St. Mary's, 1997) is 62-90-22 in his eighth season in Winona.

Concordia coach Brett Bruininks (North Dakota, 1996) is 30-14-9 in his third season in Moorhead.

### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert opens the 2012-13 season coming off a 13-14 record last year. The Green Knights went 11-9 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association to finish in seventh place. St. Norbert then lost to UW-Superior in the NCHA O'Brien Cup Playoffs quarterfinals.

Junior forward Zoe Kurth led St. Norbert in scoring a year ago with eight goals and 13 assists for 21 points. Kurth will not be available for the Green Knights until the St. Norbert women's soccer season concludes. Junior forward Henriette Ostergaard had eight goals and 11 assists for 19 points last season, while junior forward Andrea Senne had a team-high nine goals with eight assists for 17 points.

Two junior goaltenders return this season for St. Norbert. Katie Aluia was 7-5 last season with a 1.90 goals against average and .931 save percentage. Kaley Gibson was 3-7 with a 3.32 goals against average and .890 save percentage.

St. Norbert was 21-for-116 (18.1 percent) on the power play last season and was 97-for-122 (79.5 percent) on the penalty kill.

### About the Cardinals:

St. Mary's enters the 2012-13 season coming off a 2011-12 campaign that finished 7-12-6 overall. The Cardinals went 4-9-5 in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference to finish in seventh place.

Sophomore forward Breanna Peterson is the Cardinals' leading

returning scorer, posting eight goals and six assists for 14 points last season. Sophomore forward Mary DeBartolo had five goals and nine assists for 14 points last season, while junior forward Haley Coolsaet had six goals and six assists for 12 points.

Junior goaltender Sarah Gustafson is St. Mary's only experienced goaltender. Gustafson was 7-9-6 last season with a 2.43 goals against average and a .915 save percentage.

St. Mary's was 12-for-102 (11.8 percent) on the power play last season and was 96-for-118 (81.4 percent) on the penalty kill.

### About the Cobbers:

Concordia enters Friday's game at Concordia-Wisconsin coming off a 15-6-5 season a year ago. The Cobbers went 10-3-5 in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference to finish in second place. Concordia received an at-large berth into the NCAA Division III Tournament, where it lost 5-2 at RIT in the quarterfinals.

Junior forward Breann Julius is Concordia's leading returning scorer with a team-high 21 goals and 10 assists for 31 points. Junior forward Abby Taffe had 15 goals and 16 assists for 31 points last season. Sophomore forward Madison Gendreau had nine goals and 14 assists for 23 points.

Sophomore goaltender Rebecca Hendrickson was 6-2-2 last season with a 2.17 goals against average and .892 save percentage. Senior netminder Desiree Goret was 2-1-1 with a 2.96 goals against average and .865 save percentage.

Concordia was 28-for-108 (25.9 percent) last season on the power play and was 100-for-120 (83.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

### Ice Chip:
