Concordia-Moorhead coach Sarah Erickson (Minnesota, 2012) is 0-0 in her first season in Moorhead.

St. Benedict coach Jennifer Kranz (Providence, 2002) is 10-30-7 in her third season in St. Joseph.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert and Concordia tied 1-1 on Oct. 27, 2012 at the Resch Olympic Pavilion in De Pere. Breann Julius scored for Concordia early in the third period before Laurel Hill's extra-attacker power-play goal with 36 seconds left in regulation forced the tie. Kaley Gibson had 31 saves for St. Norbert, while Rebecca Hendrickson had 35 saves for the Cobbers.

St. Norbert beat St. Benedict 3-0 on Oct. 30, 2011 at the Resch Olympic Pavilion in De Pere. Jade Popescul, Andrea Senne and Katie Conlon all scored goals for the Green Knights. Katie Aluia made 13 saves for the Green Knights, while Jenna Traut made 28 stops for the Blazers.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the 2013-14 season coming off a season that saw the Green Knights finish 18-10-2 overall and earn their first NCAA Division III Tournament berth. The Green Knights, ranked No. 8 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, return 22 letterwinners from last year's squad.

Senior forward Henriette Ostergaard led the Green Knights in scoring a year ago with 16 goals and 15 assists for 31 points. Senior forward Karissa Anderson finished with 14 goals and 15 assists for 29 points, while senior forward Zoe Kurth had 12 goals and 10 assists for 22 points.

Senior goaltender Kaley Gibson was 17-9-2 with a 2.26 goals against average and .921 save percentage. Junior Katie Aluia was 1-1 with a 4.20 goals against average and .788 save percentage.

St. Norbert was 21-for-119 (17.6

percent) on the power play last season and was 111-for-133 (83.5 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Cobbers:

Concordia enters the season coming off a 13-8-5 overall record. The Cobbers finished 11-4-3 to place third in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference.

Junior forward Madison Gendreau is the Cobbers' leading returning scorer with 10 goals and nine assists for 19 points. Senior forward Abby Taffe had six goals and eight assists for 14 points, while sophomore forward Anna Westmark had nine goals and four assists for 13 points.

Sophomore goaltender Madison Denny was 8-6-3 last year with a 1.89 goals against average and .926 save percentage. Junior Rebecca Hendrickson was 5-2-2 with a 2.10 goals against average and .925 save percentage.

Concordia was 16-for-91 (17.6 percent) on the power play last season and was 102-for-113 (90.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Blazers:

St. Benedict enters the new season coming off a 5-13-4 season with a 3-13-2 record in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference to finish in eighth place.

Junior forward Alli O'Brien led the Blazers in scoring last season with six goals and six assists for 12 points. Senior forward Allyson Nielsen had six goals and four assists for 10 points, while junior forward Megan Brettingen had five goals and three assists for eight points.

Junior goaltender Jenna Traut finished 3-9-2 with a 2.55 goals against average with .916 save percentage. Senior Kaitlyn Rolando was 2-4-2 with a 2.59 goals against average and .904 save percentage.

St. Benedict was 6-for-88 (6.8 percent) on the power play last season and was 64-for-83 (77.1 percent) on the penalty kill.
