Rachel Koppang, Henriette Ostergaard and Stephanie Slinde all scored two goals apiece for the Green Knights. Katie Aluia made 26 saves for St. Norbert.

Stephanie Kirk scored two goals for St. Benedict, while Kaitlyn Rolando made 38 saves.

### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Rob Morgan (Alberta, 1992) is 62-42-8 in his fifth season in De Pere.

St. Benedict coach Jennifer Kranz (Providence, 2002) is 17-48-7 in her fourth season in St. Joseph.

### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters its fifth season of intercollegiate women's ice hockey coming off a 2013-14 season that saw the Green Knights finish 19-7-2 overall. The Green Knights advanced to the championship game of the NCHA Slaats Cup Playoffs before losing a 3-2 overtime heartbreaker to Lake Forest.

Five of St. Norbert's top 11 scorers from last season return from a year ago. Senior forward Ali Parker led the Green Knights last season with 17 goals, and also had 13 assists for 30 points. Junior forward Lauren Roethlisberger had 11 goals, the second most on the squad, along with 12 assists for 23 points. Junior forward Myranda Hayes had six goals and eight assists for 14 points, while sophomore defenseman Megan Crandell had one goal and 10 assists for 11 points.

St. Norbert has two freshmen goaltenders on its roster this season: Brianna Kelly (Lombard, Ill.) and Leigh Grall (Janesville, Wis.)

St. Norbert was 27-for-111 (24.3 percent) on the power play last season and was 122-for-137 (89.1 percent) on the penalty kill.

### About the Blazers:

St. Benedict enters the 2014-15 season after finishing 7-18 overall a year ago. The Blazers tied for ninth place in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference with a 4-14 record.

Sophomore forward Stephanie Kirk led the Blazers last season with 11 goals and five assists for 16 points. Sophomore forward Elli Marvin had six goals and 10 assists for 16 points. Sophomore defenseman Maddie Rainey had five goals and five assists for 10 points, while junior forward Siri Berg-Moberg had four goals and four assists for eight points.

Senior goaltender Jenna Traut was 6-6 last season with a 2.59 goals against average and .900 save percentage. Junior goaltender Dory Johnson was 0-6 with a 3.53 goals against average and .898 save percentage.

St. Benedict was 13-for-110 (11.8 percent) on the power play last season and was 82-for-105 (78.1 percent) on the penalty kill.

### Roster Report:

St. Norbert enters this season with a roster of 21 players after finishing with 25 players at the end of last season.

A total of 17 players are from the United States, while three hail from Canada and one from Sweden.

Six of St. Norbert's players are Wisconsin natives, while four are from Michigan - all from that state's Upper Peninsula. There are two players each from Illinois and California. Indiana, Massachusetts and Missouri all have one player apiece.

Two of St. Norbert's Canadian players are from Ontario, and the third is from British Columbia.

### Opener Observations:

St. Norbert is 4-0 all-time in season-opening games. Three of the Green Knights' curtain raisers have been shutouts.

The Green Knights won their first game in program history with a 2-0 win over Bethel on Oct. 29, 2010. St. Norbert then hosted St. Benedict on Oct. 30, 2011 and won 3-0. The Green Knights again opened at home on Oct. 26, 2012 with a 6-3 win over St. Mary's.

Last year, St. Norbert opened on the road for the first time with a 4-0 win over Concordia-Moorhead.
