### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Meredith Roth (Providence, 2004) is 15-9-4 in her second season in De Pere.

St. Mary's coach Terry Mannor (St. Mary's, 1997) is 99-144-31 in his 12th season in Winona.

Concordia-Wis. coach Steve Fabiilli (Canisius, 2001) is 20-26-7 entering his third season in Mequon.

### Last Season:

St. Norbert topped St. Mary's 3-2 in overtime on Nov. 28, 2015 at SMU Ice Arena in Winona, Minn. Jillian Kosteck's overtime goal was the difference, while Lexi Pyykkonen's power-play goal late in the third period forced overtime. Leigh Grall made 14 saves for St. Norbert while Ashley Corcoran made 42 saves for the Cardinals.

St. Norbert opened the 2015-16 season with a 4-1 win over Concordia-Wisconsin on Nov. 3, 2015 at Resch Olympic Pavilion. The Green Knights then swept the Falcons 4-1 and 3-2 on Dec. 4-5, 2015 at Ozaukee Ice Center in Mequon.

### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters 2016-17 season coming off a 15-9-4 overall record and a third-place showing in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association at 9-6-3. The Green Knights advanced to the NCHA Slaats Cup championship game before falling 2-0 at Adrian.

Junior forward Reaghan Chadwick is the leading returning scorer with 11 goals and seven assists for 18 points last season. Senior forward Kylie Gazzolo had six goals and nine assists for 15 points, while senior forward Jillian Kosteck had eight goals and four assists for 12 points.

Junior goaltender Leigh Grall was 12-5-2 with a 1.53 goals against average and .921 save percentage a year ago. Sophomore Brianna Kelly was 3-4-2 with a 2.15 goals against average and .903 save percentage.

St. Norbert was 15-for-79 (19.0 percent) on the power play last

season and was 94-for-111 (84.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

### About the Cardinals:

St. Mary's enters the new season after a 10-13-3 overall record and a 8-7-2 mark in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference last season.

Junior forward Jamie Henderson led the Cardinals in scoring a year ago with 13 goals and seven assists for 20 points. Senior forward Kassie Lien had five goals and seven assists for 12 points, while senior forward Jane Hannula had seven goals and two assists for nine points.

Senior goaltender Marah Shields was 1-6 last season with a 2.47 goals against average and .940 save percentage. Sophomore Ashley Corcoran was 0-2-1 with a 2.47 goals against average and .924 save percentage.

St. Mary's was 10-for-77 (13.0 percent) on the power play last season and was 82-for-96 (85.4 percent) on the penalty kill.

### About the Falcons:

Concordia enters this weekend's series at Hamline coming off an 8-15-2 overall record with a 6-11-1 mark in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association.

Junior forward Lexi Holman led the Falcons in scoring last season with 12 goals and 15 assists for 27 points. Senior forward Veronika Metanova had eight goals and 10 assists for 18 points, while senior forward Brandi Muller had three goals and 11 assists for 14 points.

Sophomore goaltender Christina Pattengale was 6-8-1 last season with a 2.39 goals against average and .926 save percentage. Junior Allison Kurek was 2-7-1 with a 3.19 goals against average and .884 save percentage.

Concordia was 21-for-94 (22.3 percent) on the power play last season and was 73-for-93 (78.5 percent) on the penalty kill.
