St. Norbert has won the last three home games in the series, including a series sweep last year with a 3-2 overtime win and a 4-3 triumph on Jan. 22-23, 2016.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Meredith Roth (Providence, 2004) is 15-12-4 in her second season in De Pere.

St. Scholastica coach Jackie MacMillan (Wisconsin, 2003) is 71-72-20 in her seventh season in Duluth. Including three seasons at New England College, MacMillan is 102-98-23 in 10 seasons of collegiate coaching.

Last Season:

St. Norbert and St. Scholastica split the four games the two teams played last season. The home team won all four games.

St. Scholastica swept St. Norbert by scores of 5-4 and 5-3 on Nov. 13-14, 2015 at Mars Lakeview Arena in Duluth, Minn. Abby Sawyer's goal with 7:05 remaining snapped a 4-4 tie in the opener. Kristen Hunt made 18 saves for the Saints. In the second game, St. Scholastica led 4-2 after two periods and held on. Lindsey Hartfiel made 37 saves for the Saints and Brianna Kelly made 18 stops for the Green Knights.

St. Norbert returned the favor with a sweep of St. Scholastica by scores of 3-2 in overtime and 4-3 on Jan. 22-23, 2016 at Resch Olympic Pavilion in De Pere. Jillian Kosteck scored the overtime game-winning goal in Game 1. Hartfiel made 35 saves while Leigh Grall made 16 stops for St. Norbert. Reaghan Chadwick's goal in the third period snapped a 3-3 tie in Game 2 to give St. Norbert the win. Grall made 15 saves and Hartfiel 24 saves.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series 0-3 overall and 0-2 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights fell to No. 5-ranked Adrian by a 3-1 score this past Friday at Resch Olympic Pavilion.

Junior forward Reaghan Chadwick tops the Green Knights in scoring with four goals for four points. Senior forward Jillian Kosteck has three assists for three points, while junior defenseman Natasha Smith has two assists for two points. Sophomore forward Lauren Michael and sophomore defenseman Kelli Sorge each have one goal for one point.

Junior goaltender Leigh Grall is 0-2 with a 3.04 goals against average and .918 save percentage. Sophomore Brianna Kelly is 0-1 with a 2.06 goals against average and .889 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 3-for-14 (21.4 percent) on the power play this season and is 13-for-15 (86.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Saints:

St. Scholastica enters the series with a 2-2 overall record and is 1-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Saints are coming off getting swept at home by Lake Forest this past weekend, both by scores of 4-3.

Junior forward Emily Stegora tops the Saints in scoring with five goals and two assists for seven points. Junior forward Abby Sawyer has three goals and three assists for six points, while senior forward Sierra Hanowski has six assists for six points.

Senior goaltender Lindsey Hartfiel is the lone Saints goaltender to see action so far this season. Hartfiel is 2-2 with a 2.52 goals against average and .905 save percentage.

St. Scholastica is 5-for-23 (21.7 percent) on the power this season and is 20-for-23 (87.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

Ice Chips:

- * This weekend's series features the top two goal scorers in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. St. Scholastica's Emily Stegora tops the NCHA with five goals, while St. Norbert's Reaghan Chadwick is second with four markers.
- * Three of Reaghan Chadwick's four goals this season have come on the power play. Those three goals are all three goals the Green Knights have scored on the power play this season.
