The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Meredith Roth (Providence, 2004) is 30-41-9 in her fourth season in De Pere.

St. Mary's coach Greg Moore (St. Mary's, 2010) is 9-14-2 in his second season in Winona.

Last Season:

St. Mary's beat St. Norbert 3-1 on Oct. 28, 2017 at SMU Ice Arena in Winona, Minn.

The Cardinals took a 2-1 lead after the first period. Bailey Wendt and Jamie Henderson scored power-play goals sandwiched around a St. Norbert goal by Lauren Michael. The Cardinals got a third-period insurance goal by Wendt.

Ary Ziakas made 28 saves for St. Mary's, while Leigh Grall made 28 stops for the Green Knights.

St. Mary's was 3-for-6 on the power play, while St. Norbert was 0-for-2.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the new season after going 9-14-4 overall in 2017-18. The Green Knights finished in a fourth-place tie in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association at 9-6-3 a year ago.

The Green Knights have lost four of their top six scorers from last season. Senior forward Jessica Schlaff is the leading returning scorer after posting seven goals and 10 assists for 17 points last season. Senior forward Lauren Michael had seven goals and four assists for 11 points. Junior forward Lisa Lenell had four goals and three assists for seven points, while senior forward Rebecka Olsson had three goals and four assists for seven points.

Sophomore Anais Aurard and freshman Audrey Moore will battle for time in goal for the Green Knights this season.

St. Norbert was 14-for-90 (15.6 percent) on the power play last season and was 87-for-107 (81.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Cardinals:

St. Mary's enters the season after finishing 9-14-2 overall and 6-10-2 in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference a season ago.

The Cardinals return three of their top four scorers from last season. Senior forward Bailey Wendt had 13 goals and three assists for 16 points. Junior defenseman Natalie Ryan had five goals and nine assists for 14 points, while sophomore forward Courtney Moser had three goals and 11 assists for 14 points.

Senior goaltender Ashley Corcoran was 7-11-2 with a 2.84 goals against average and .910 save percentage last season. Sophomore Ary Ziakas was 2-3 with a 3.43 goals against average and .904 save percentage.

St. Mary's was 18-for-95 (18.9 percent) on the power play last season and is 88-for-110 (80.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

Season Openers:

St. Norbert is 6-2 all-time in season openers entering its ninth season of women's ice hockey.

The Green Knights have opened against a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foe in seven of their first eight seasons, going 5-2 in those matchups.

Saturday's game marks the fourth time St. Norbert will play its season opener against St. Mary's. The Green Knights are 1-2 against the Cardinals in those games.

MIAC Musings:

St. Norbert plays the first of three games against the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference this season when it faces St. Mary's Saturday at Resch Olympic Pavilion.

St. Norbert is 17-11-2 all-time against the MIAC. The Green Knights are 7-0 against St. Benedict, 2-0 against St. Catherine, 3-1 against Augsburg, 3-4-1 against Mary's, 1-0-1 against Concordia-Moorhead, 1-1 against Bethel, 0-1 against Hamline and 0-4 against Gustavus Adolphus.

The Green Knights have not faced MIAC schools St. Olaf and St. Thomas.
